

1. Area and Population

The municipality of Mamuša/Mamushë/Mamuša is located in south-eastern Kosovo and covers an area of approximately 11 km². According to the Kosovo Population and Housing Census 2011 the total population is 5,507.

2. Governing Structures and Political Overview

The total number of voters in Mamuša/Mamushë/Mamuša registered for the last municipal elections held in November 2009 was 2,835, including out-of-Kosovo voters. The voter turnout was 65.1 per cent/1,759 voters (source: Central Elections Commission).

The election results were as follows:

a. Legislative

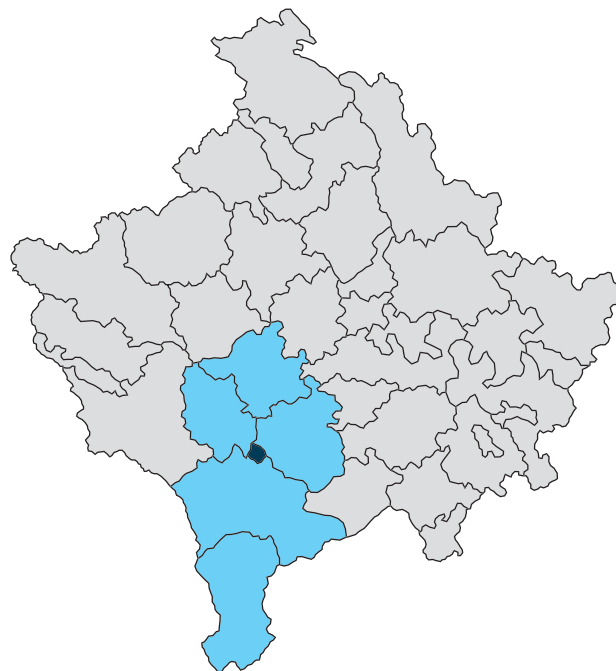
The municipal assembly has 15 seats distributed amongst four (4) political entities; 14 members are Kosovo Turk, one (1) is Kosovo Albanian, while five (5) are female. The municipal assembly chairperson is Seylan Mazrek (KDTP).

According to the law on local self-government, a municipality with more than ten (10) per cent of residents belonging to communities not in majority in that municipality is required to appoint a deputy municipal assembly chairperson for communities. Nonetheless, Mamuša/Mamushë/Mamuša municipal assembly appointed Ganimete Sadiku (PDK) as the deputy chairperson for communities.

b. Executive

Mamuša/Mamushë/Mamuša municipality is headed by the mayor Arif Bütüç (KDTP) and the deputy mayor Abdulhadi Krasniç (KDTP). It has six (6) departments and

department directors; general administration and joint affairs (KDTP); budget and finance (KDTP); education (KDTP); health and social welfare (KTB); planning urbanism, cadastre and geodesy (KDTP); and public services (KDTP) (source: municipal web site).

3. Judiciary

There are no courts in Mamuša/Mamushë/Mamuša municipality. Prizren basic court covers the municipality (source: Prizren basic court).

Additional information

Prizren basic prosecutor's office covers the municipality.

4. Security Presence

Mamuša/Mamushë/Mamuša police station was established in September 2011; previously, there was only a sub-station of Prizren police station which is since closed. The newly-established police station has 15 police officers twelve (12) are Kosovo Albanian and three (3) are Kosovo Turk; while three (3) are female. Mamuša/Mamushë/Mamuša police station is the only station in the region which is managed by a female lieutenant.

As for the international military presence, the Turkish KFOR covers the area (source: Kosovo police).

5. Economy

The economy of the Mamuša/Mamushë/Mamuša municipality is mainly based on small scale farming and trade activities. There are some 70 registered private businesses operating in the municipality. There is no reliable data on the number of people employed in the private sector in Mamuša/Mamushë/Mamuša (source: municipal directorate of planning urbanism, cadastre and geodesy).

6. Public Services

a. Infrastructure

The overall infrastructure status in the municipality is assessed as poor. There is one main road in the municipality, which is in very poor conditions. The water supply system is improving following many problems, but there is no sewage system. Power supply is still a problem, especially in the winter (source: municipal development plan).

b. Health

Mamuša/Mamushë/Mamuša has one (1) municipal family health centre with 17 employees, including doctors, nurses and support staff. For more complex health issues, the residents go to Prizren Regional Hospital.

Access: All communities have access to health care and all health facilities (source: municipal directorate of health and social welfare).

c. Education

There is one (1) primary school in the municipality with 891 pupils and 47 teachers and one (1) secondary school with 188 students and 10 teachers (source: municipal directorate of education).

7. Religious and Cultural sites

Mamuša/Mamushë/Mamuša has two (2) mosques. The original mosque was not renovated after the 1999 conflict (Source: municipal development plan).
