 - * Curative services: GP and medical specialist.
 - * Laboratory.
 - * Health education
- MOH Level (4) provides:**
- * Preventive services: mother and child health care, immunization, family planning and dental.
 - * Curative services: GP and medical specialist care and dental care.
 - * Gynecology and obstetric
 - * Laboratory.
 - * Radiology.

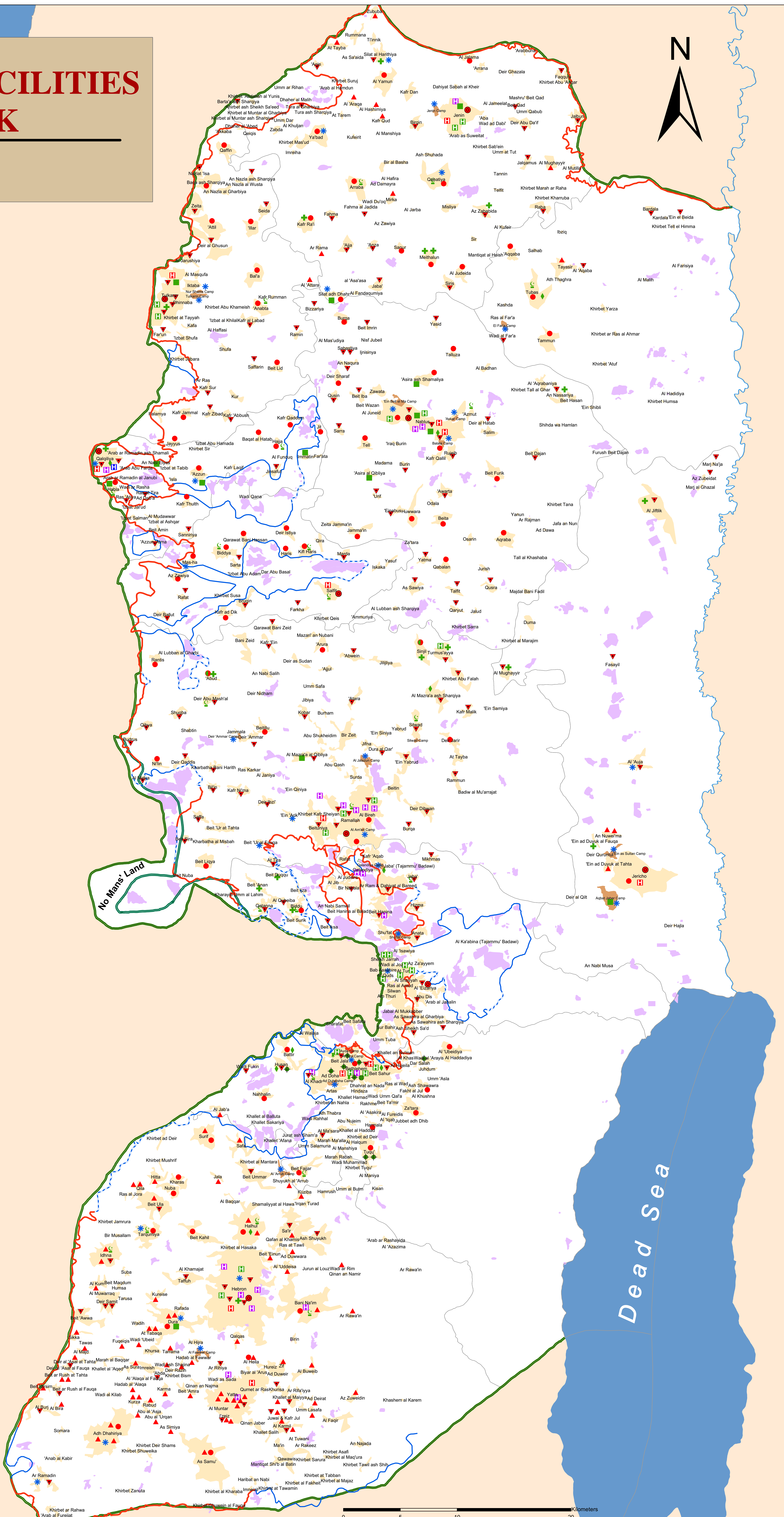
