Syrian Arab Republic: Whole of Syria Protection Sector response snapshot for 2016 (as of February)



In the first two months of 2016, the Protection sector has reached 260,700 people in 123 out 272 sub-districts in Syria through one or more of its prevention/risk mitigation, response or capacity building activities. Prevention/risk mitigation activities conducted by sector members include awareness raising, risk education, community based psychosocial support, protection monitoring etc and response services like individual and group psychosocial support, case management, referrals to other services, material/cash assistance etc. Many of the beneficiaries are reached through community centres, schools, child friendly/ women safe spaces or using outreach volunteers.






