

Council of Ministers Resolution No (5) for 1995
Concerning the Establishment of the Permanent Committee for Recruitment

The Council of Ministers,

Having reviewed the amended Provisional Constitution, articles (23), (34) thereof in particular,

Law No (3) for 1963 concerning the regulation of entry and residence of aliens in Qatar and its amendments,

Law No (5) – 1970 concerning powers of the Ministers and Function & Competence of the Ministries and other government organs and its amending laws,

The Council of Ministers Resolution No (9) of 1993 concerning the Regulation of the joint and specialized committees,

And based on the recommendations of the Minister of Interior,

Decides as follows :-

Article (1)

A committee shall be set up within the Ministry of Interior called “The Permanent Committee for Recruitment” and shall be annexed to the Office of the Minister of Interior.

Article (2)

Amended in accordance with Council of Ministers Resolution No (16) for 1999 – Official Gazette, Issue No (8) for 1999.

The Committee shall be composed of a chairman and five members as follows:

- 1- Three representatives of the Ministry of Interior one of whom will be the Chairman.
- 2- One member of each of the following ministries: Ministry of Civil Service and Housing, Ministry of Energy, Industry, Electricity and Water, Ministry of Finance, Economy and Trade.

Any party will select its representative.

Nomination of Chairman, Secretary and Members will be issued by a decree by the Ministry of Interior.

Article (3)

Amended in accordance to the decree of the Council of Ministers No (16), the Committee will have the following functions:

1. Taking decisions on applications for recruitment of workforce from abroad for companies, corporations, associations and private establishments after reviewing the following aspects:
 - a. Type of labors to be recruited, their nationalities and qualifications to perform the required works.
 - b. The need of the applicant entity for the recruited labors.
 - c. Size of applicant entity, its financial position and the projects which it is executing.
 - d. Availability of housing for the required labors.
2. Taking decision on applications from resident expatriates who are intending to bring their families to live with them.
3. Providing suitable recommendations regarding simplifications of the procedures for granting entry visas and work permits for businessmen and investors.

Article (4)

Period of membership in the Committee is three years, commencing on the date on which the decree of the Minister of Interior enters into force and may be renewed for similar period or periods.

Article (5)

Monthly allowances for the Chairman, members and secretary of the Committee will be Two Thousand (2000) Riyals for each.

Article (6)

Any provision contradicting the provisions of this decree shall be nullified.

Article (7)

All concerned parties shall implement this Act and shall enter into force on the date of issuance and shall be published in the Official Gazette.
