











Over **107,131** persons have arrived in Sudan from South Sudan

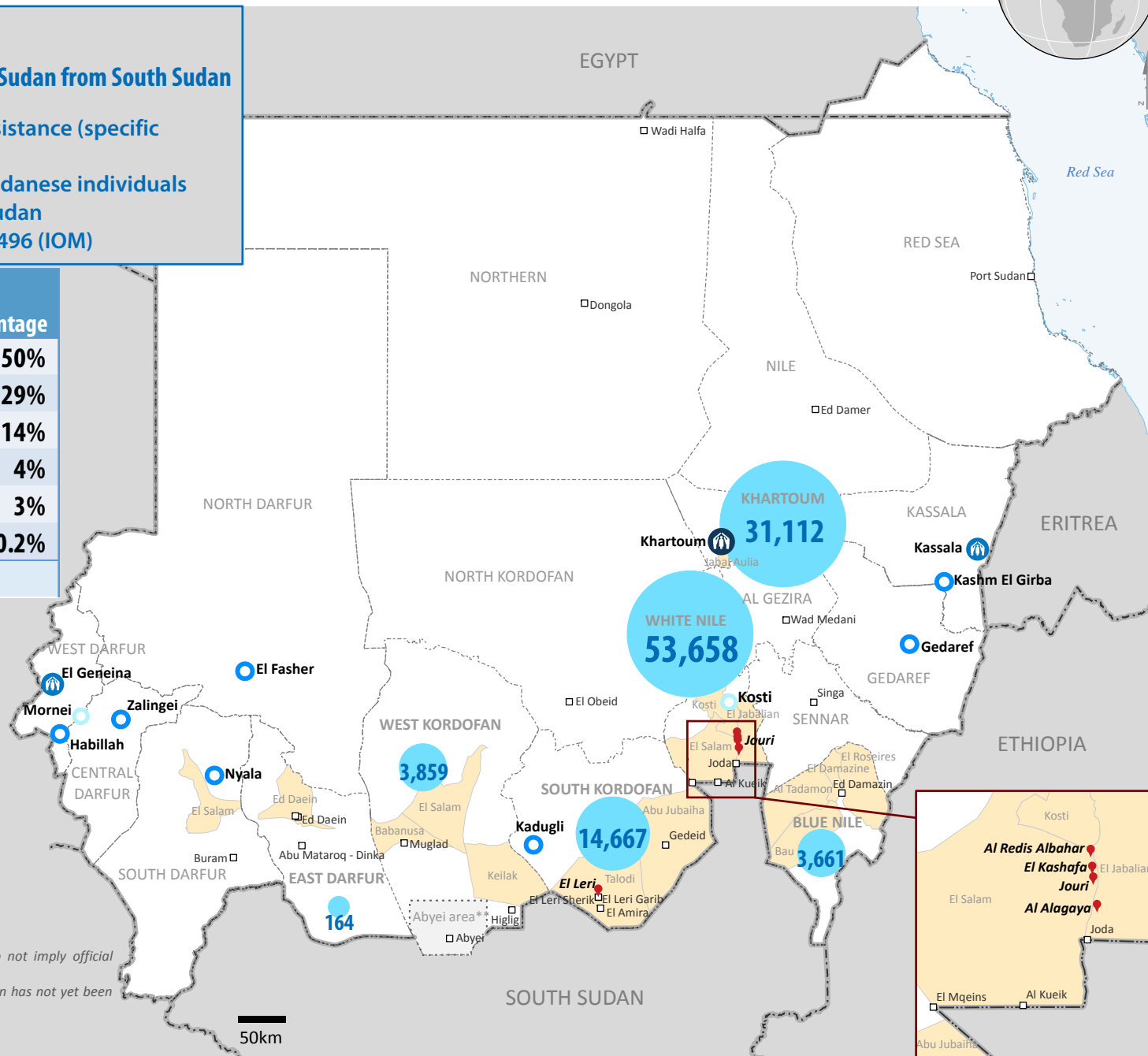
- 65,887 persons have received humanitarian assistance (specific assistance only)
