Regulations on the Refugee's Travel Document for the Purpose of Travelling Abroad

In accordance with the Law of Ukraine "On Refugees" Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine **RESOLVES**:

1. To approve Regulations on the Refugee's Travel Document for the Purpose of Travelling Abroad (attached).

REGULATIONS

on the Refugee's Travel Document for the Purpose of Travelling Abroad

1. Refugee's Travel Document for the Purpose of Travelling Abroad ("document" - hereafter) is the document that certifies the identity of the owner who was granted refugee status in Ukraine, gives him/her the right to exit and enter in Ukraine.

The document is the property of Ukraine.

2. The document is issued to refugees aged 16 and over if they have Refugee's certificate at their personal request or request of their legal representatives by the office of the migration service at the place of residence.

The document is registered in the registration book for the documents subjected to strict registration. Document number and the date of issue are included also in the reference and information database of the centralized information system of the State Committee for Nationalities and Migration.

The child, separated from family, who is granted refugee status, has a right at his/her legal representatives request to get travel document issued before the attainence of the age of 16.

3. If the document is lost, the refugee must inform of that occasion internal affairs office and migration service office in the place of lost immediately.

In case of damage, lost or expiration of validity of the document refugee can obtain a renewed one from the migration service office in the place of residence. In case of lost while staying abroad the refugee must turn to diplomatic representatives or consular office of Ukraine abroad for obtaining document for return to Ukraine.

4. The document is handed for the term of validity of the Refugee's certificate.

5. The order of drawing up, issue and extension of validity of the document is determined by the State Committee for Nationalities and Migration in agreement with MOI and MOE.

6. Document forms are manufactured at the request of the State Committee for Nationalities and Migration in the form of passport book or passport card in accordance with the specimen, approved by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine. The terms of the application of passport card are determined by the Cabinet of Ministers of Ukraine in accordance with the possibilities of the State Uniform Automatized Passport System.

7. The document form is a 16-page bound booklet in soft cover made of binding material, $88.0 \times 125.0 \text{ mm}$ in size. Each page has a number and depiction of the Small State Emblem of Ukraine. There are perforated series of two letters and number of six numerals in top of pages 1-16 and at the right part of the cover.

8. . In the upper part of the front cover a inscription "REFUGEE'S TRAVEL DOCUMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRAVELLING ABROAD" is printed in light gold color, below in the centre of the cover - the depiction of the Small State Emblem of Ukraine, below inscription "Ukraine".

9. There is an inscription "UKRAINE" across the top of the inner left part of the cover. Below, to the left is the name of the document "REFUGEE'S TRAVEL DOCUMENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF TRAVELLING ABROAD". Below there is space left for the photo (photograph) of the holder. To the right there must be the information on the type, code of the country, document number, surname, name, patronymic, citizenship, DOB, personal number, sex, place of birth, date of issue, issuing authority, term of validity, signature of the holder. There is a stripe across the width of the page for machine-readable information. The certain place of inscriptions and information on the holder is determined in accordance with the recommendations of International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO, Doc 9303/1) "Machine-readable documents. Part 1. Machine-readable passport". The inner left part is laminated with the protective film after inclusion of data on the holder.

10. The text: "For permitting to enter another country refugee must turn to diplomatic representatives or consular office of the proper foreign country" is printed across the page 1.

Pages 2-4 contains inscriptions concerning information on children, who are refugees and accompany the holder of the document abroad without travel documents.

The inscriptions "Special notes", "Source of information on the person", "Place of residence, phone number, blood group, rhesus".

Pages 6-16 are meant for putting down visas and notes on crossing state border by the holder.

Putting down notes that are not stipulated by law is prohibited.

11. The order of document forms custody and destroying of documents, which period of validity is expired, is determined by the State Committee for Nationalities and Migration.
