

## NATIONALITY ACT (NO. 3)

B.E. 2535 1992)

## BHUMIBOL ADULYADEJ, REX.

Given on the 31st day of March, B.E. 2535;

Being the 47th Year of the Present Reign.

His Majesty King Bhumibol Adulyadej has been graciously pleased to proclaim that

Whereas it is expedient to amend the law on nationality,

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED BY THE KING, by and with the advice and consent of the National Legislative Assembly in the capacity of the National Assembly, as follows:

- Section 1 This Act shall be called the "Nationality Act (No. 3), B.E. 2535"
- Section 2. This Act shall come into force on and from the day following the date of its publication in the Government Gazette. (1)
- Section 3. The provisions of paragraph one of Section 14 of the Nationality Act, B.E. 2508 as amended by the Nationality Act (No. 2), B.E. 2535 shall be repealed and replaced by the followings;

"Section 14. A person of Thai nationality who was born of an alien father and has acquired the nationality of his father according to the law on nationality of his father, or a person who acquires Thai nationality under Section 12 paragraph two is

required, if he desires to retain his other nationality, to make a declaration of his intention to renounce his Thai nationality within one year after his attaining the age of twenty years, according to such form and in the manner as prescribed in the ministerial Regulations."

**Section 4.** The provisions of Section 14 paragraph one of the Nationality Act, B.E. 2508 as amended by this Act shall not apply to those who attained the age of twenty years before the enforcement of this Act. If the said persons desire to renounce their Thai nationality, they have to comply with Section 15 of the Nationality Act, B.E. 2508 as amended by the Nationality Act (No. 2), B.E. 2535.

**Section 5.** The Minister of Interior shall take charge and control of the execution of this Act.
