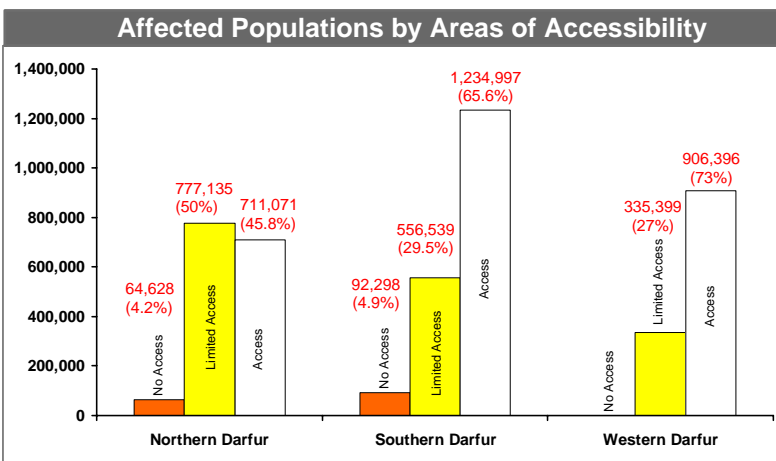

 * Connectivity by road or air
 * Staffing levels
 * Supply chain

2) Levels of Access:
 * Access: Full time humanitarian agency presence or routine programme activities.
 * Limited Access: Full time presence not possible but the area has been visited at least once by a humanitarian agency since 30 Apr. 2009.
 * No Access: No humanitarian presence in the area since 30 Apr. 2009 due to lack of access.

3) Gray background indicates:
 * No population
 * No humanitarian interventions by the UN or NGOs
