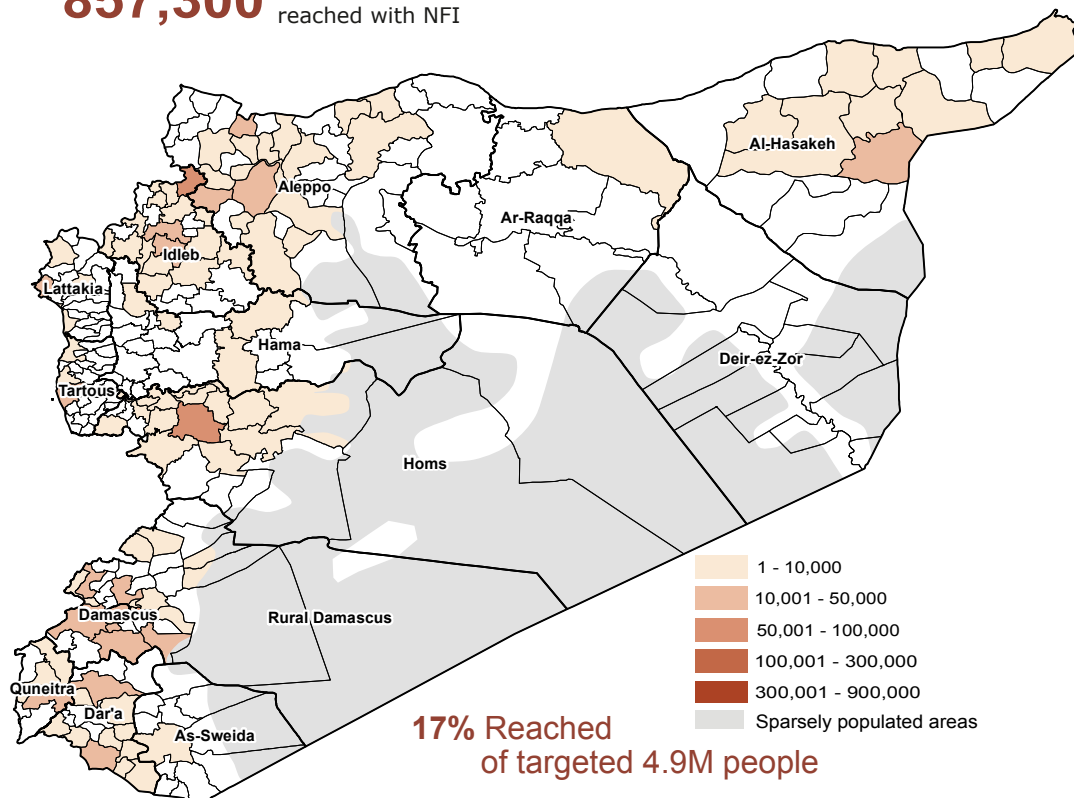

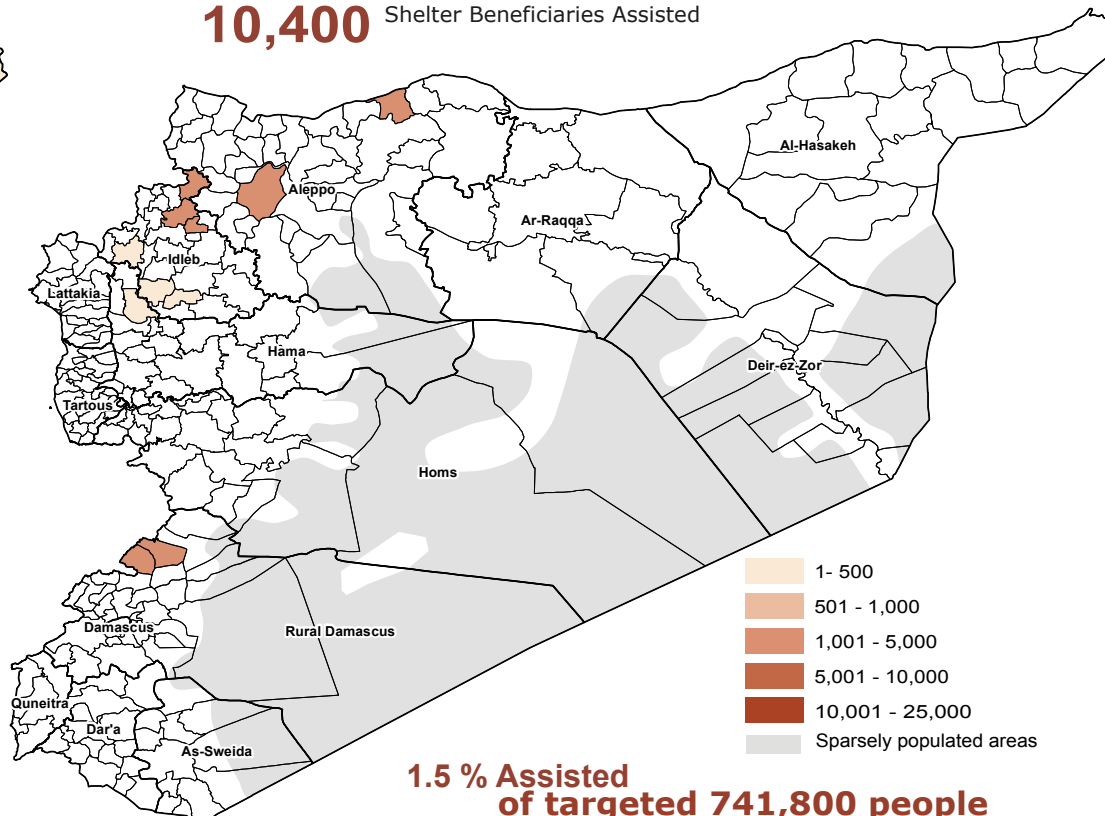

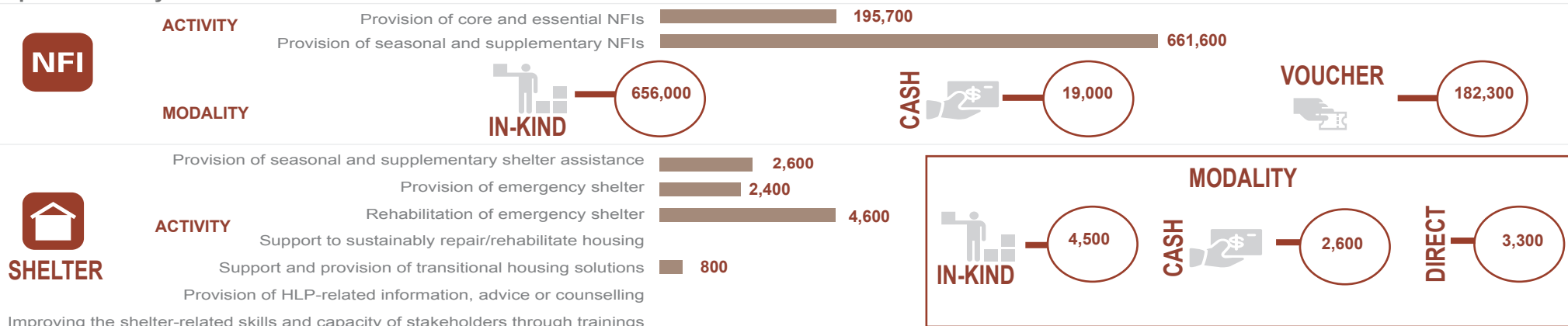

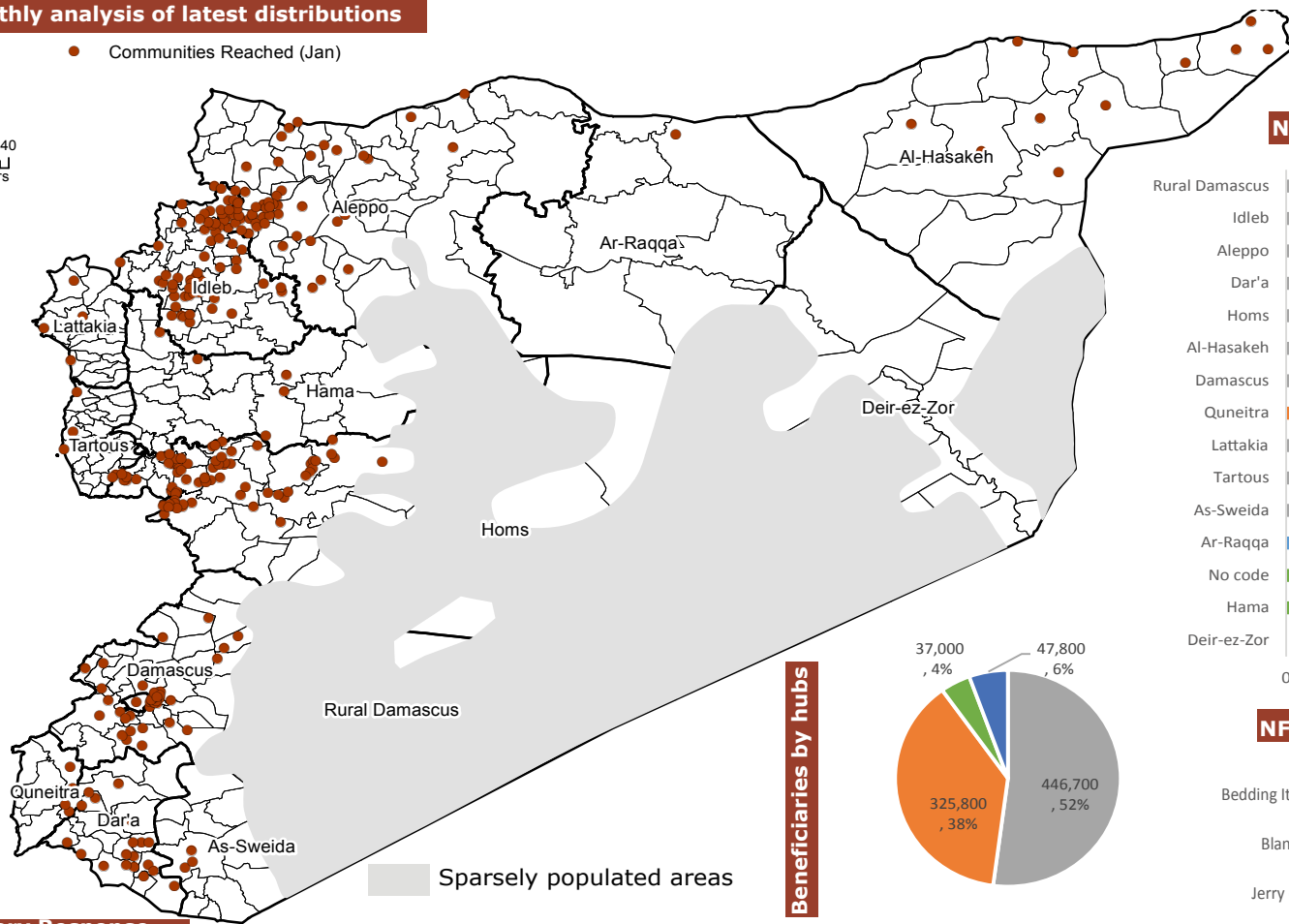

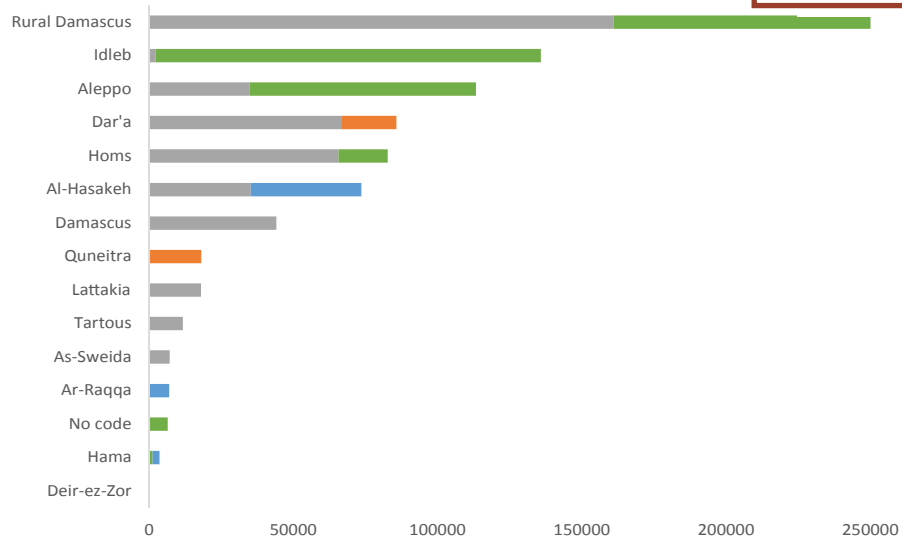

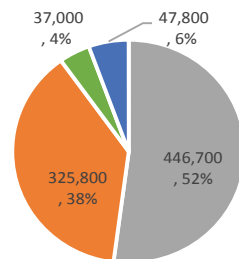

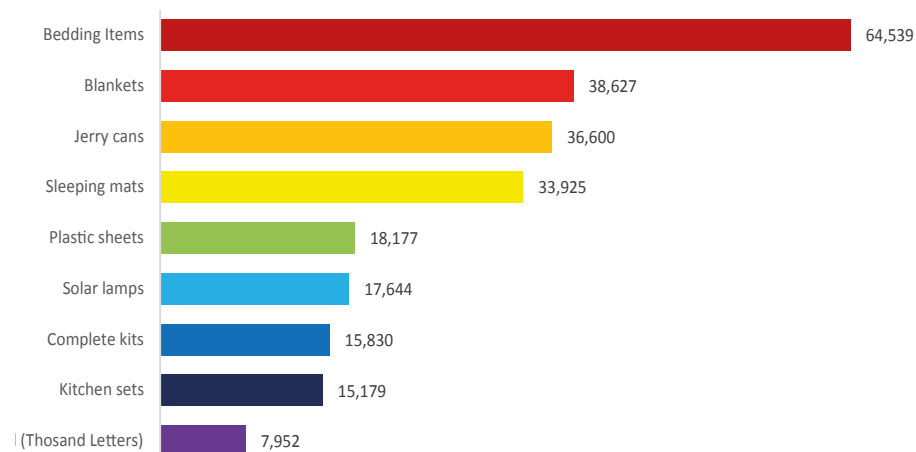
No. of Beneficiaries - Governorate



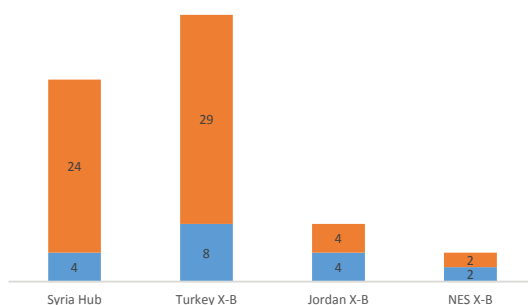
Beneficiaries by hubs



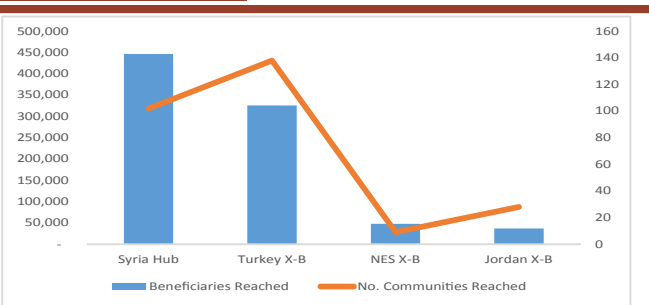
NFI distribution over the period

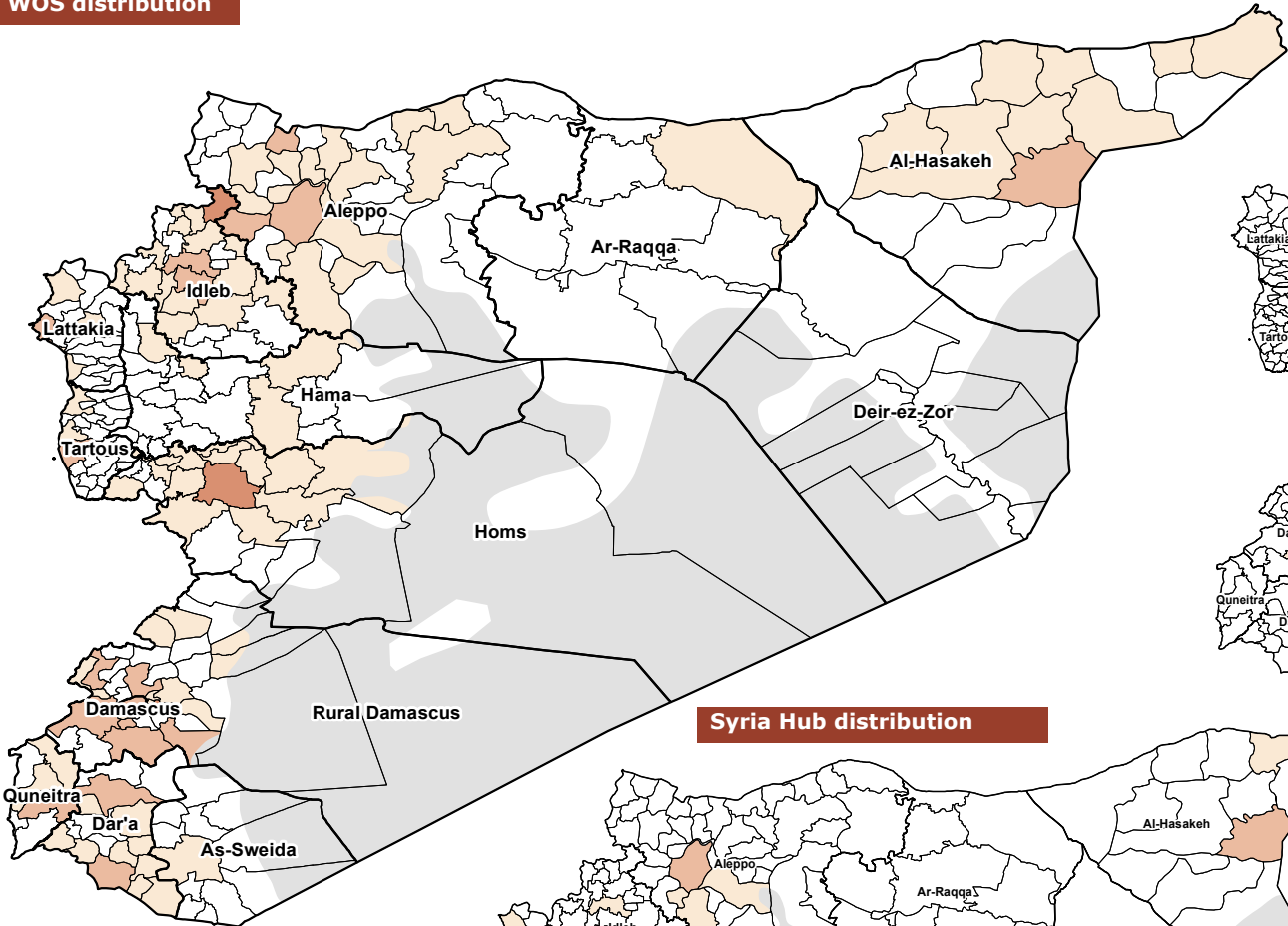

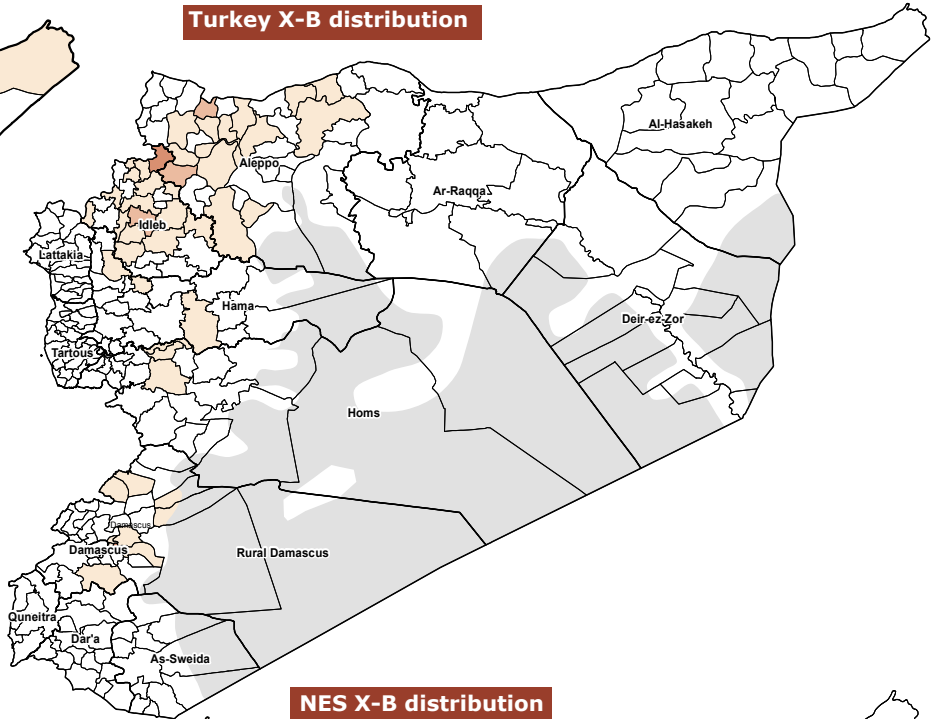

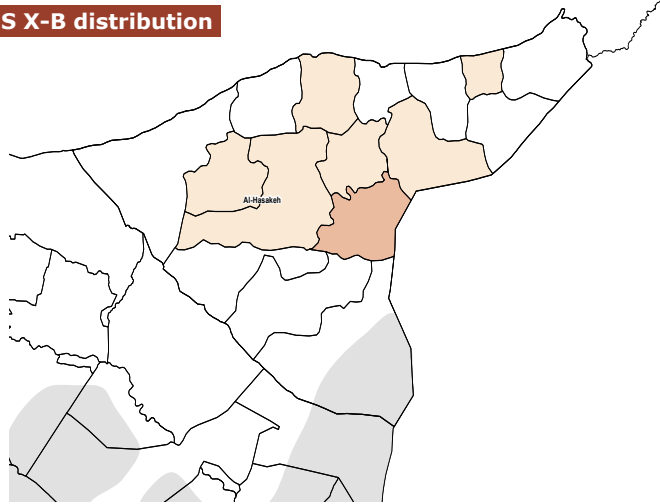
WOS distribution



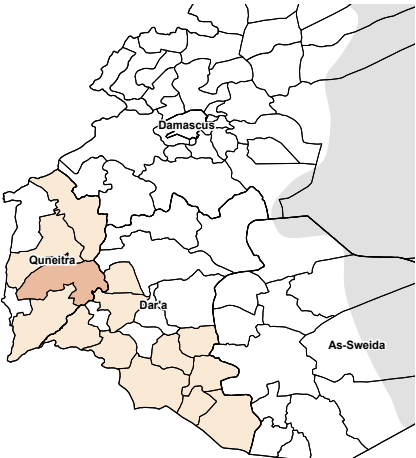
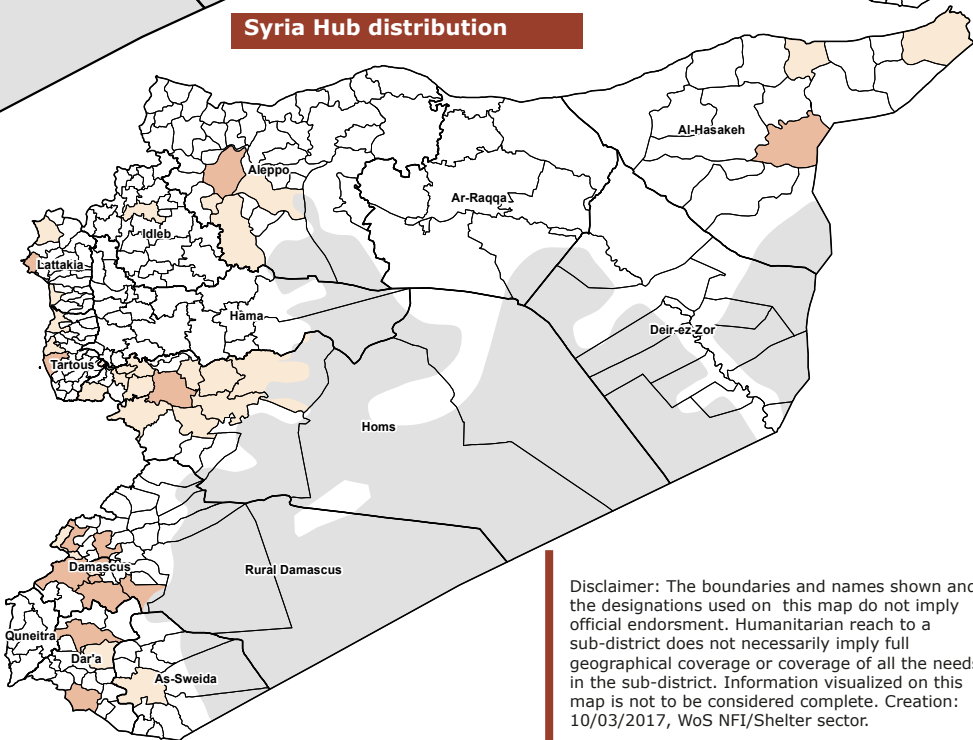
Turkey X-B distribution

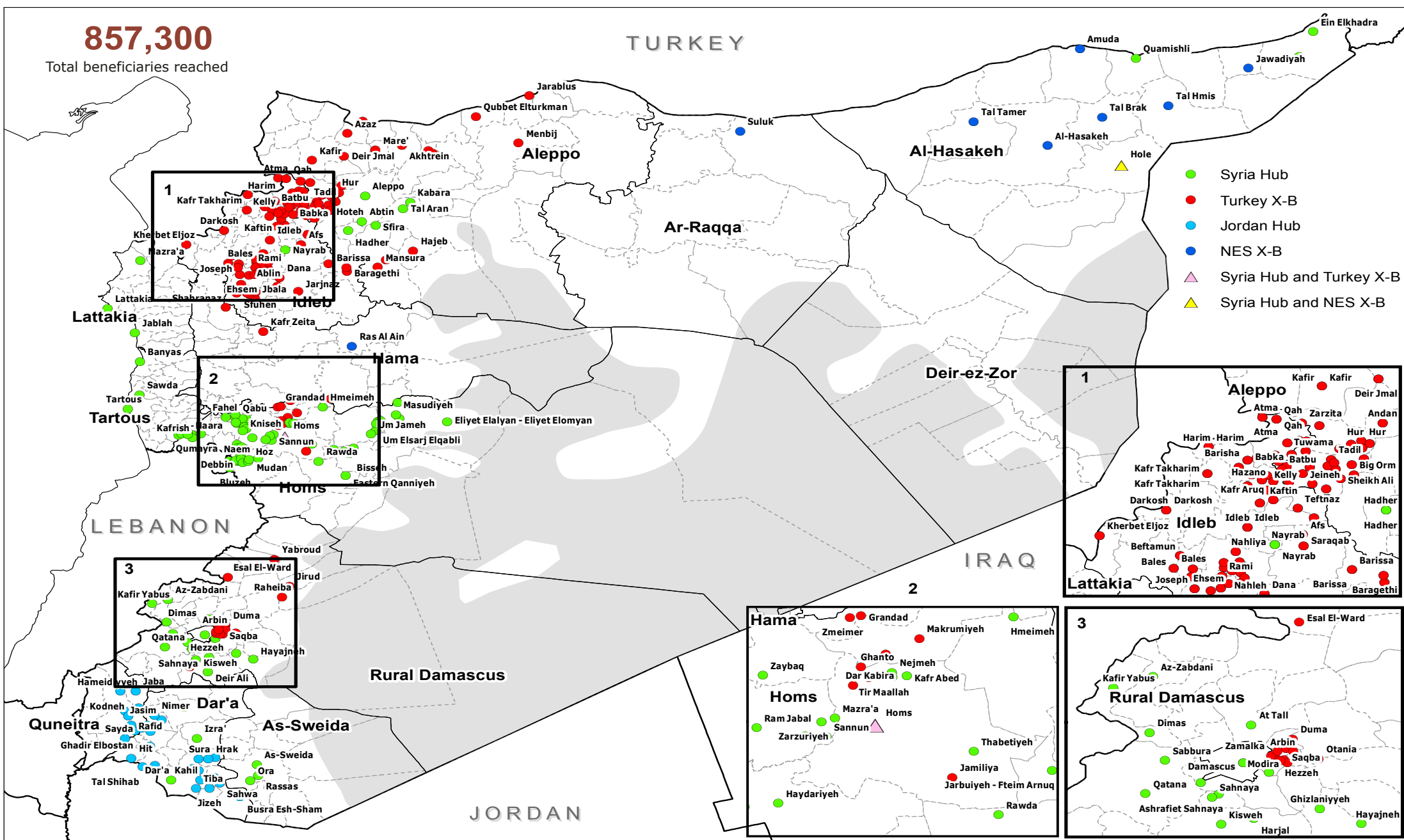

Syria Arab Republic: WOS NFI Access at Community Level Reached By hubs as of January 2017



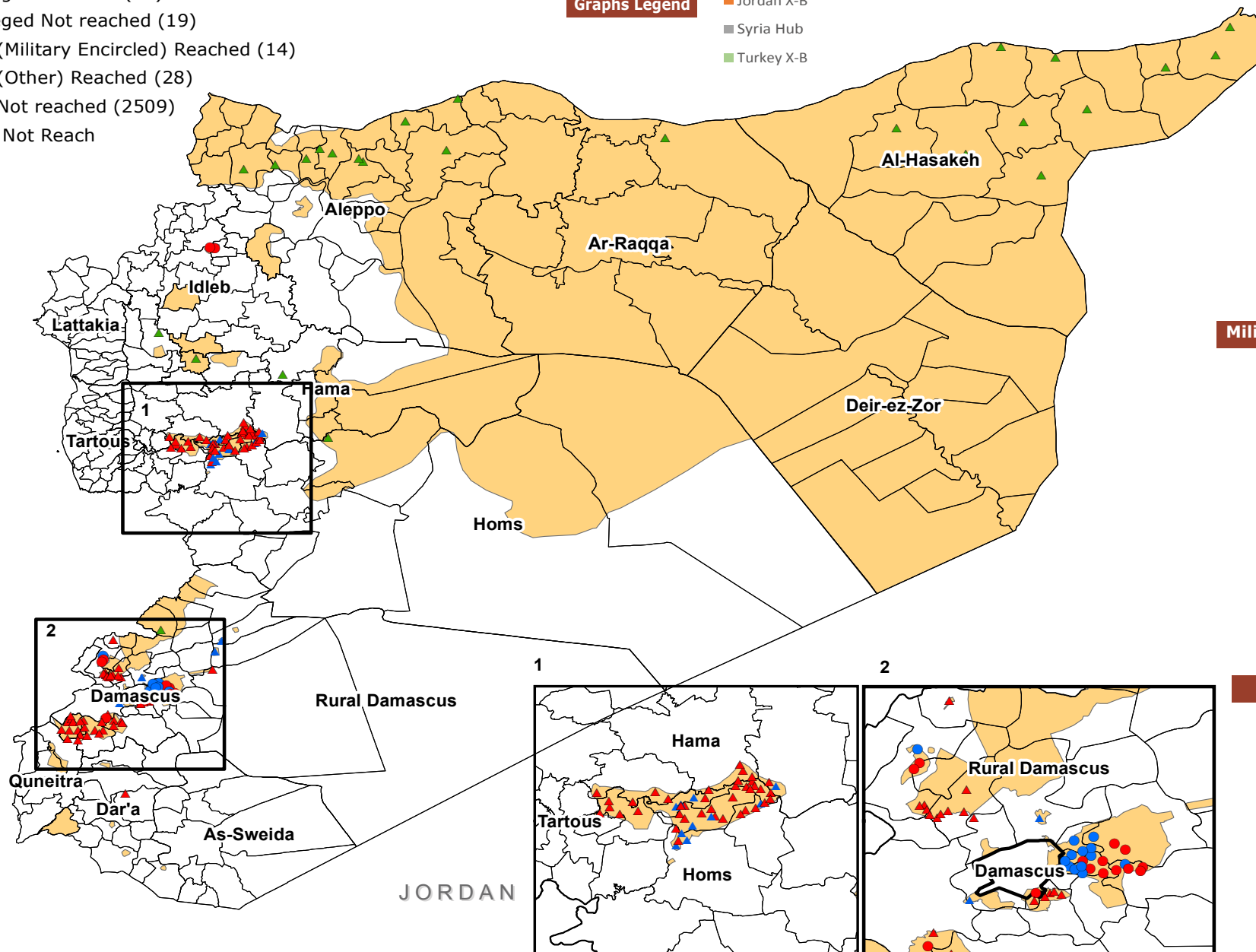

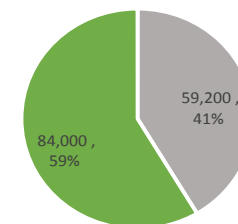

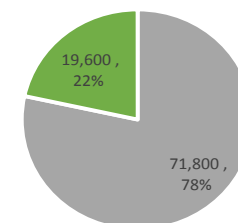
