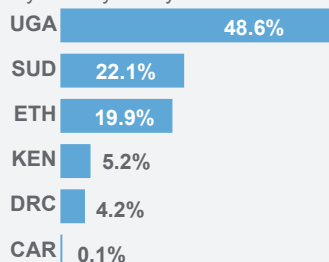

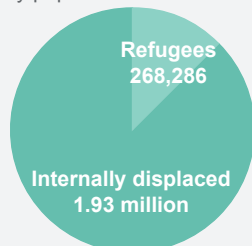

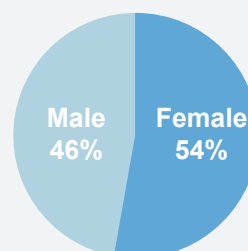

Sex and age breakdown of registered refugees in the region

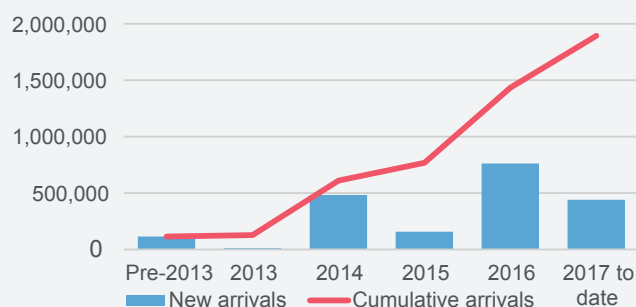

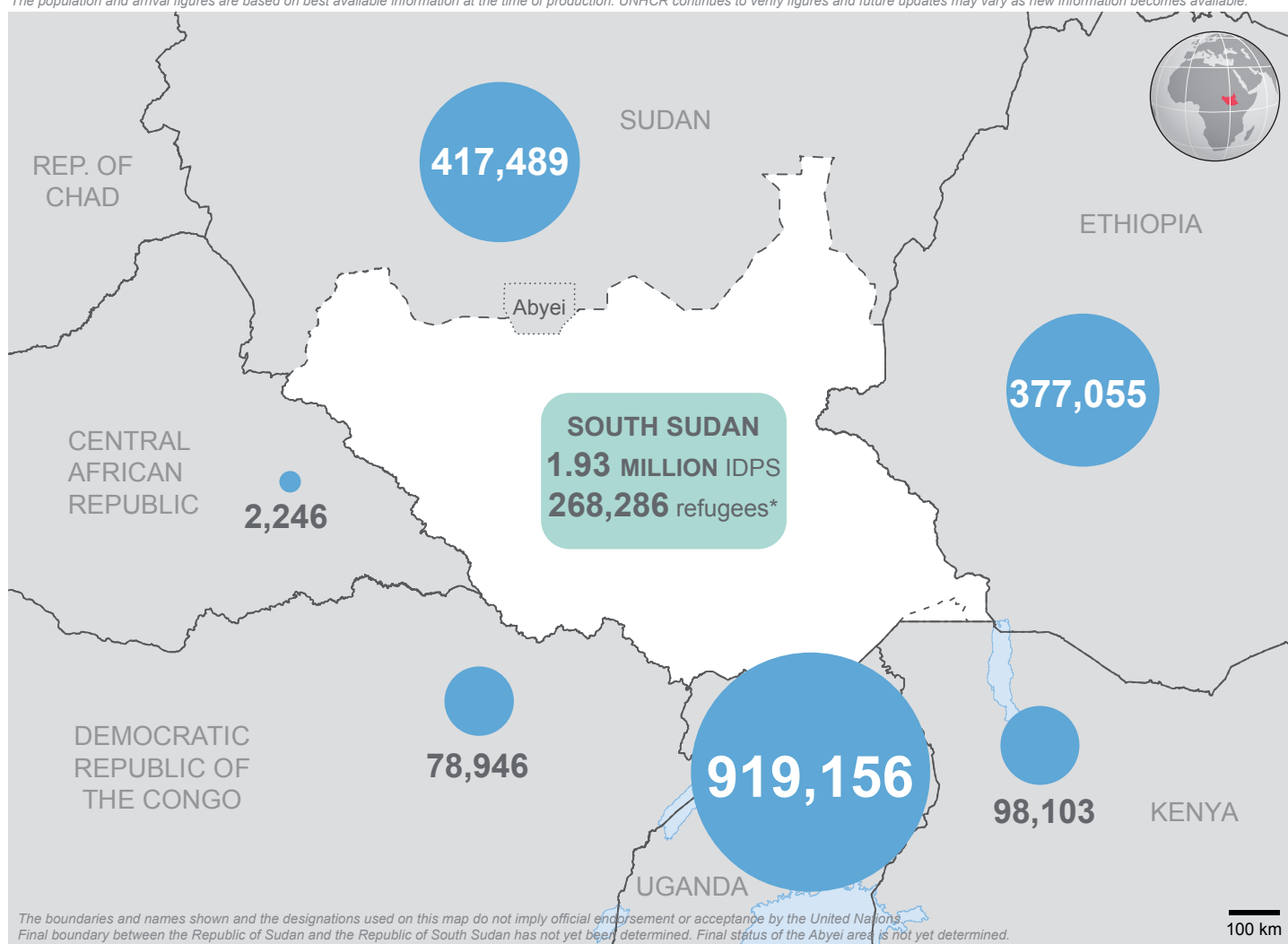
Yearly and Cumulative South Sudanese Refugee Arrivals
