Land violations committed during June 2017

1 June	0900	The Israeli enemy continued construction begun on 27 April 2017 of a dirt road from Jabal Shahal towards the Radar position inside the occupied Shab'a Farms. The enemy used five trench-diggers and two D9 bulldozers, which were escorted by an enemy foot patrol comprising approximately 30 soldiers. Two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction. During the road construction, Israeli enemy trucks transported gravel into occupied territory and the enemy raised earthen berms on the aforementioned road. At 1700 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work. Some of the soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory, while the rest stayed at the location with the engineering vehicles.
4 June	0900	The Israeli enemy continued construction begun on 27 April 2017 of a dirt road from Jabal Shahal towards the Radar position inside the occupied Shab'a Farms. The enemy used five trench-diggers and two D9 bulldozers, which were escorted by an enemy foot patrol comprising approximately 30 soldiers. Two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction. During the road construction, Israeli enemy trucks transported gravel into occupied territory and the enemy raised earthen berms on the aforementioned road. At 1700 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work. Some of the soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory, while the rest stayed at the location with the engineering vehicles.
	1630	At Ruwaysat al-Alam-Kafr Shuba, while Muhammad Abdul'azim, a Syrian herder, was herding livestock belonging to citizen Isma'il Nasir, members of an Israeli enemy patrol hiding in the occupied Shab'a Farms in the area around the enemy's Ruwaysat al-Alam position fired into the air over the herd, without injury.
5 June	0900	The Israeli enemy continued construction begun on 27 April 2017 of a dirt road from Jabal Shahal towards the Radar position inside the occupied Shab'a Farms. The enemy used five trench-diggers and two D9 bulldozers, which were escorted by an enemy patrol comprising approximately 40 soldiers. They deployed in the vicinity while two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction. During the road construction, Israeli enemy trucks transported gravel and unloaded it on the dirt road, and the enemy raised earthen berms along the side facing liberated Lebanese territory. At 1830 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work. Some of the soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory, while the rest stayed at the location with the engineering vehicles.
	1030	Inside occupied territory, opposite the Kafr Killa highway, near crossing point B-82, a white Rapid vehicle appeared. Two journalists got out with cameras. They yelled "Come on over, we're journalists" at civilian passersby on the Lebanese side. They got no response. At 1045 hours, they left in the direction of occupied territory.

6 June	0900	The Israeli enemy continued construction begun on 27 April 2017 of a dirt road from Jabal Shahal towards the Radar position inside the occupied Shab'a Farms. The enemy used five trench-diggers and two D9 bulldozers, which were escorted by an enemy foot patrol comprising approximately 40 soldiers. They deployed in the vicinity while two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction. During the road construction, Israeli enemy trucks transported gravel and unloaded it on the dirt road, and the enemy raised earthen berms along the side facing liberated Lebanese territory. At 1830 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work. Some of the soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory, while the rest stayed at the location with the engineering vehicles.
7 June	0900	The Israeli enemy continued construction begun on 27 April 2017 of a dirt road from Jabal Shahal towards the Radar position inside the occupied Shab'a Farms. The enemy used five trench-diggers and two D9 bulldozers, which were escorted by an enemy foot patrol comprising approximately 30 soldiers. They deployed in the vicinity while two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction. During the road construction, Israeli enemy trucks transported gravel and placed it on the dirt road. At 1730 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work. Some of the soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory, while the rest stayed at the location with the engineering vehicles.
11 June	0900	The Israeli enemy continued construction begun on 27 April 2017 of a dirt road from Jabal Shahal towards the Radar position inside the occupied Shab'a Farms. The enemy used five trench-diggers and two D9 bulldozers, which were escorted by an enemy foot patrol comprising approximately 30 soldiers. They deployed in the vicinity while two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction. The enemy raised earthen berms along the side facing liberated Lebanese territory. At 1745 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work. Some of the soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory, while the rest stayed at the location with the engineering vehicles.
12 June	0900	The Israeli enemy continued construction begun on 27 April 2017 of a dirt road from Jabal Shahal towards the Radar position inside the occupied Shab'a Farms. The enemy used five trench-diggers and two D9 bulldozers, which were escorted by an enemy foot patrol comprising approximately 25 soldiers. They deployed in the vicinity while two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction. The enemy raised earthen berms along the side facing liberated Lebanese territory. At 1630 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work. Some of the soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory, while the rest stayed at the location with the engineering vehicles.
	0900 1125	In the Bastrah area on the outskirts of the town of Kafr Shuba (at the gate to the occupied Shab'a Farms), the Israeli enemy installed five cement blocks at the entrance to the occupied Shab'a Farms road after removing the metal gate. The enemy also used a trench-digger to dig trenches and raise an earthen berm behind the second metal gate located at entrance to Bastrah Farms near position 34-4 of the Indian contingent of the United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon.

13 June	0900	The Israeli enemy continued construction begun on 27 April 2017 of a dirt road from Jabal Shahal towards the Radar position inside the occupied Shab‘a Farms. The enemy used five trench-diggers and two D9 bulldozers, which were escorted by an enemy foot patrol comprising approximately 30 soldiers. Two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction. During the road construction, Israeli enemy trucks transported gravel and unloaded it on the dirt road, and the enemy raised earthen berms along the side facing liberated Lebanese territory. At 1700 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work. Some of the soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory, while the rest stayed at the location with the engineering vehicles.
13 June	1500	Inside occupied territory, at the Himayri post opposite the town of Wazzani, an Israeli enemy engineering vehicle appeared and pointed a pole-mounted camera at Lebanese territory.
14 June	–	A Lebanese Army team travelling towards Bastrah on the outskirts of the town of Kafr Shuba discovered that the Israeli enemy had violated the Blue Line in that area on 12 June 2017. The enemy had installed two cement blocks inside Lebanese territory. The first was 0.72 metres and the second 1.17 metres north of the aforementioned line.
	0900	The Israeli enemy continued construction begun on 27 April 2017 of a dirt road from Jabal Shahal towards the Radar position inside the occupied Shab‘a Farms. The enemy used five trench-diggers and two D9 bulldozers, which were escorted by an enemy foot patrol comprising approximately 40 soldiers. Two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction. Earthen berms were raised along the side facing liberated Lebanese territory. At 1800 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work. Some of the soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory, while the rest stayed at the location with the vehicles.
15 June	0900	The Israeli enemy continued construction begun on 27 April 2017 of a dirt road from Jabal Shahal towards the Radar position inside the occupied Shab‘a Farms. The enemy used five trench-diggers and two D9 bulldozers, which were escorted by an enemy foot patrol comprising approximately 40 soldiers. Two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction. Earthen berms were raised along the side facing liberated Lebanese territory. At 1700 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work. Some of the soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory, while the rest stayed at the location with the vehicles.
	1130	Inside occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Udaysah (at the Panorama point), an Israeli enemy patrol comprising two Hummer vehicles, three soldiers, a bulldozer and a gravel spreader appeared. They levelled and cleaned the road along the technical fence. The soldiers in the patrol pointed their weapons at members of a Lebanese Army patrol. At 1800 hours, the work ended and the patrol and vehicles left in the direction of occupied territory.

18 June	0900	The Israeli enemy continued construction begun on 27 April 2017 of a dirt road from Jabal Shahal towards the Radar position inside the occupied Shab'a Farms. The enemy used five trench-diggers and two D9 bulldozers, which were escorted by an enemy foot patrol comprising approximately 30 soldiers. Two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction. Earthen berms were raised along the side facing liberated Lebanese territory. At 1700 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work. Some of the soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory, while the rest stayed at the location with the vehicles.
19 June	0900	The Israeli enemy continued construction begun on 27 April 2017 of a dirt road from Jabal Shahal towards the Radar position inside the occupied Shab'a Farms. The enemy used five trench-diggers and two D9 bulldozers, which were escorted by an enemy foot patrol comprising approximately 30 soldiers. Two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction. Earthen berms were raised along the side facing liberated Lebanese territory. At 1730 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work. Some of the soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory, while the rest stayed at the location with the vehicles.
	1400	On the outskirts of the town of Shab'a at Wadi Daysharah, while a civilian, Yusuf Zahrah, was herding livestock, an Israeli enemy patrol violated the line of withdrawal (the Blue Line that demarcates territory with respect to which Lebanon maintains a claim) and led some 400 goats into occupied territory. At 0700 hours on 20 June 2017, the Israeli enemy returned the aforementioned herd of goats.
21 June	0830	The Israeli enemy continued construction begun on 27 April 2017 of a dirt road from Jabal Shahal towards the Radar position inside the occupied Shab'a Farms. The enemy used five trench-diggers and two D9 bulldozers, which were escorted by an enemy foot patrol comprising approximately 25 soldiers. Two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction. The enemy used four trucks to transport dirt and place it on the side of the road facing liberated Lebanese territory. At 1700 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work. Some of the soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory, while the rest stayed at the location with the vehicles.
	1200 1211	Opposite the town of Arab al-Wazzani near point B-93, members of a mechanized Israeli enemy patrol pointed a machine gun mounted on their vehicle in the direction of an Observer Group Lebanon patrol stationed inside Lebanese territory.
22 June	0900	The Israeli enemy continued construction begun on 27 April 2017 of a dirt road from Jabal Shahal towards the Radar position inside the occupied Shab'a Farms. The enemy used five trench-diggers and a D9 bulldozer, which were escorted by an enemy foot patrol comprising approximately 30 soldiers. Two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction. During the road construction, Israeli enemy trucks transported gravel and unloaded it on the dirt road, and earthen berms were raised along the side facing liberated Lebanese territory. At 1820 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work. Some of the soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory, while the rest stayed at the location with the vehicles.

24 June	0010	An explosion was heard from inside the occupied Shab‘a farms in the area surrounding the Israel enemy’s Fashkul outpost.
27 June	0900	The Israeli enemy continued construction begun on 27 April 2017 of a dirt road from Jabal Shahal towards the Radar position inside the occupied Shab‘a Farms. The enemy used five trench-diggers and two D9 bulldozers, which were escorted by an enemy foot patrol comprising approximately 35 soldiers. Two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction. An engineering vehicle was used to lay concertina wire along the side of the road facing liberated Lebanese territory. At 1800 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work. Some of the soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory, while the rest stayed at the location with the engineering vehicles and patrol vehicles.
28 June	0900	The Israeli enemy continued construction begun on 27 April 2017 of a dirt road from Jabal Shahal towards the Radar position inside the occupied Shab‘a Farms. The enemy used five trench-diggers and two D9 bulldozers, which were escorted by an enemy foot patrol comprising approximately 30 soldiers who deployed in the surrounding area, while two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction. During the road construction, some Israeli enemy trucks transported gravel and unloaded it on the dirt road, and earthen berms were raised along the side facing liberated Lebanese territory. At 1850 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work. Some of the soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory, while the rest stayed at the location with the vehicles.
29 June	0900	The Israeli enemy continued construction begun on 27 April 2017 of a dirt road from Jabal Shahal towards the Radar position inside the occupied Shab‘a Farms. The enemy used three trench-diggers and two D9 bulldozers, which were escorted by an enemy foot patrol comprising approximately 30 soldiers who deployed in the surrounding area while two Merkava tanks positioned themselves in the hills overlooking the construction. During the road construction, three Israeli enemy trucks transported gravel and unloaded it on the side of the road facing liberated Lebanese territory. At 1800 hours, the Israeli enemy finished its work. Some of the soldiers left in the direction of occupied territory, while the rest stayed at the location with the engineering vehicles and patrol vehicles.

It fired a flare inside Lebanese territorial waters. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.

	0330	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree 6433 (2011) for a three-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 315 metres inside Lebanese territorial waters. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	0353	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree 6433 (2011) for a one-hour-and-fifty-two-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 351 metres. It fired a flare inside Lebanese territorial waters. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	0521	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree 6433 (2011) for a six-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 388 metres inside Lebanese territorial waters. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
2 June	0455	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree 6433 (2011) for a one-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 200 metres. It directed a searchlight at what is known as "the second buoy" for a 30-second period. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	0510	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree 6433 (2011) for a two-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 220 metres. It fired two flares and sounded warning sirens for approximately 40 seconds. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
4 June	0428	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree 6433 (2011) for a nine-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 370 metres. It launched three flares, and its crew directed a searchlight and gunfire at Lebanese territorial waters. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
6 June	1030	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a 40-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 140 metres. It released two divers. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	1825	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a two-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 150 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
7 June	0412	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a five-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 280 metres. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.

8 June	0835	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a 20-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 140 metres inside Lebanese territorial waters. The launch then left in the direction of occupied Palestinian territorial waters.
	0855	Off Ra's al-Naqurah, an Israeli enemy military launch violated the southern maritime boundary established by Decree No. 6433 (2011) for a 10-minute period, and proceeded on its way for some 204 metres inside Lebanese territorial waters.
