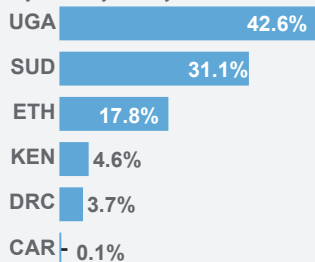

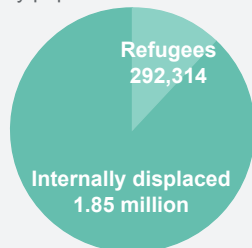

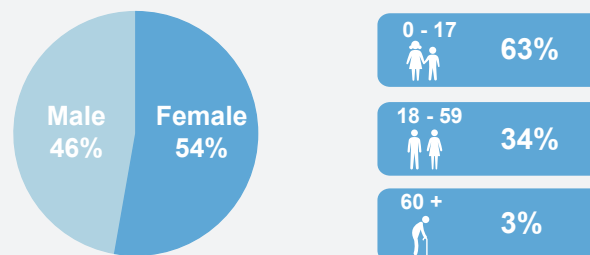

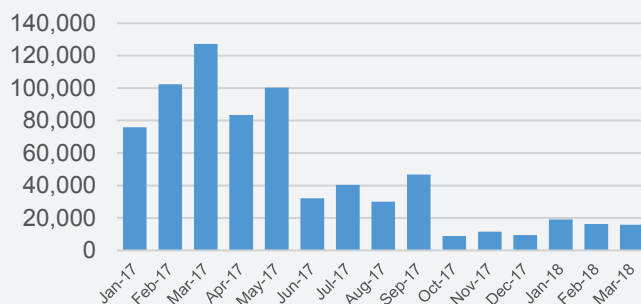

Sex and age breakdown of registered refugees in the region



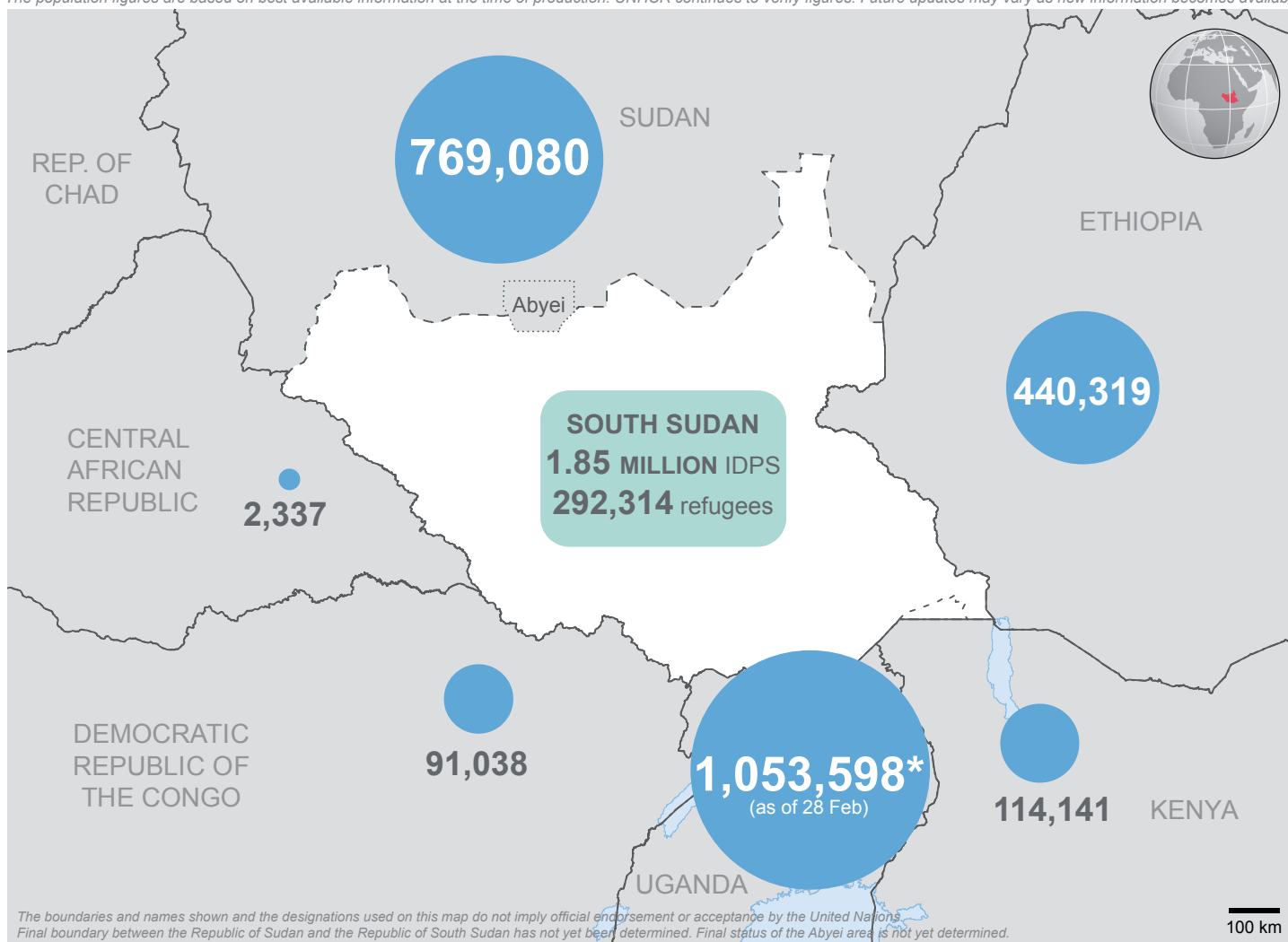
Monthly South Sudanese Refugee Arrivals into the Region
