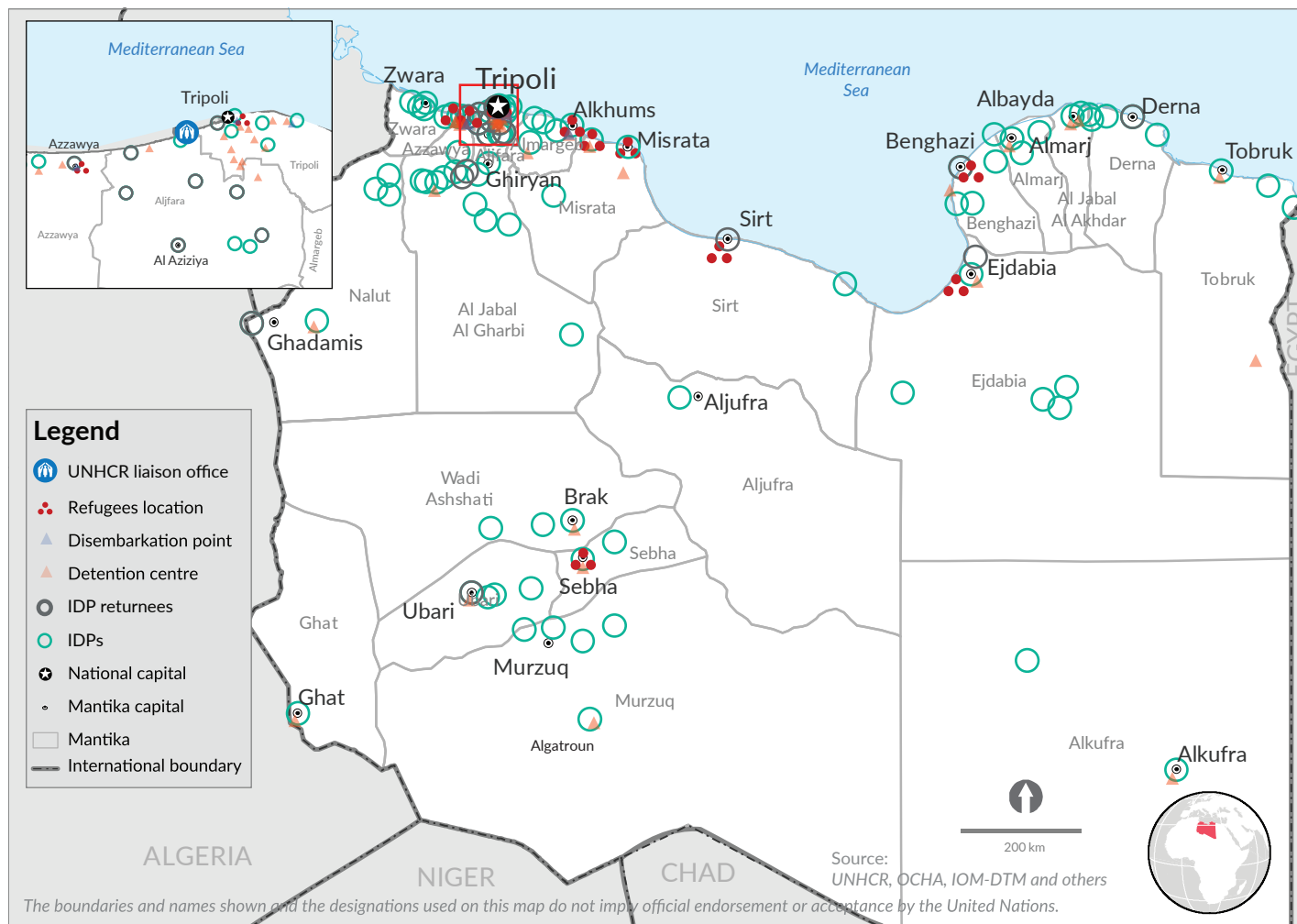

## Key Achievements in 2018

-  **33,563** medical consultations (Disembarkation: **1,604** -Detention: **22,907** -Urban: **9,052**)
-  **104,441** IDPs and refugees received non-food items (IDPs: **68,246** -Refugees: **36,195**)
- QIP 115** Quick Impact Projects implemented in 2018
-  **6,402** IDP and refugee households received cash assistance (IDPs: **4,076** -Refugees: **2,326**)
-  **20,926** individuals registered since 2016 (**12,765** in 2018)
-  **9,723** rescue kits and **1,604** medical consultations provided at disembarkation points
-  **1,374** monitoring visits to detention centres
-  **2,709** detained refugees/asylum-seekers released
-  **220** refugees departed via the Gathering and Departure Facility
-  **3,857** refugees and asylum-seekers reached with solutions since Sept 2017: **1,064** resettlement submissions to third countries and **2,793** individuals evacuated from Libya (**2,202** to Niger, **415** to Italy and **176** to Romania)
