

## Bangladesh - Researched and compiled by the Refugee Documentation Centre of Ireland on Tuesday 3 February 2014

## Information on the location of Sharkar/Sarkar Bazar in relation to Chittagong, Dhakar, Maulvi Bazar/Moulvibazaar & Sridharpur

Maps of Bangladesh lists Sarkar Bazar situated within Maulvi Bazar/Moulvibazaar stating:

"Hats and bazars are 31, most noted which are Maulvi Bazar, Digharpar, Dighirpar, Sarkar Bazar, Sherpur, Goraiya, Kamalpur and Shamserganj; fair of Shah Mostafa, Fish Mela of Sherpur, Mangalchandi Aastami Mela are notable" (Maps of Bangladesh (Undated) *Maulvi Bazar Sadar Upazila*).

Maulvi Bazar/Moulvibazaar is located on the right-hand side of a map issued in January by the *United Nations*, residing approximately 175km from Dhaka (United Nations (January 2004) *Bangladesh*); this maps also shows that Chittagong city lies approximately 250km directly south of Maulvi Bazar (ibid).
