Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to transmit herewith the records of violations of the ceasefire by the Republic of Armenia in March 2019 (see annex).\*

During the reported period, the armed forces of Armenia violated the ceasefire regime 738 times, continuing to use large-calibre guns and heavy weaponry from their positions in the occupied territories of the Republic of Azerbaijan and from the territory of the Republic of Armenia.

The military occupation by the armed forces of Armenia of the territory of Azerbaijan is a result of the explicitly annexationist agenda of Armenia and is the major obstacle to achieving peace, security, stability and socioeconomic development in the region.

The sooner Armenia withdraws its armed forces from the Nagorno-Karabakh region and other occupied territories of Azerbaijan, the sooner the conflict will be resolved and both countries and their people will benefit from the prospects of cooperation and economic development.

I should be grateful if you would have the present letter and its annex circulated as a document of the General Assembly, under agenda items 35 and 41, and of the Security Council.
