23,041 medical consultations (Disembarkation: 847 -Detention: 14,868 - Urban: 7,326)



34,023 IDPs and refugees received non-food items (IDPs: 21,003 -Refugees: 13,020)



4,301 individuals received rescue kits at disembarkation points



10,425 IDPs and returnees received shelter kits



1,643 IDP and refugee households received cash assistance (IDPs: 921 -Refugees: 722)



22 Quick Impact Projects implemented



7,368 individuals registered (3,582 in detention)



975 monitoring visits to detention centres



1,689 detained refugees/asylum-seekers released
