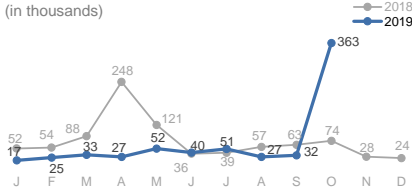

**832,000** Jan - Oct 2018

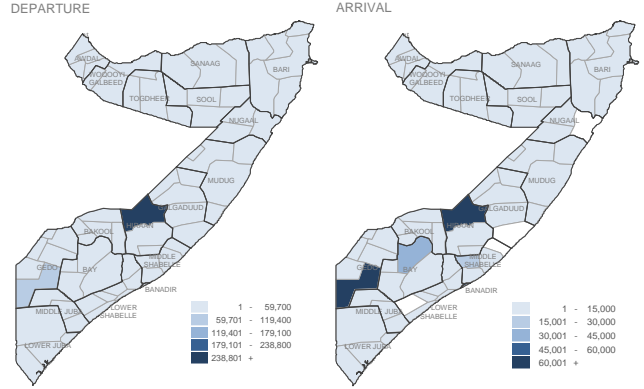
The UNHCR-led PRMN implemented in partnership with NRC reported 363,000 new internal displacements in the month of October 2019. Of these, 333,000 were triggered by flood, 18,000 by conflict /insecurity and 10,000 were drought related.

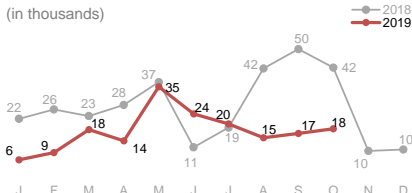

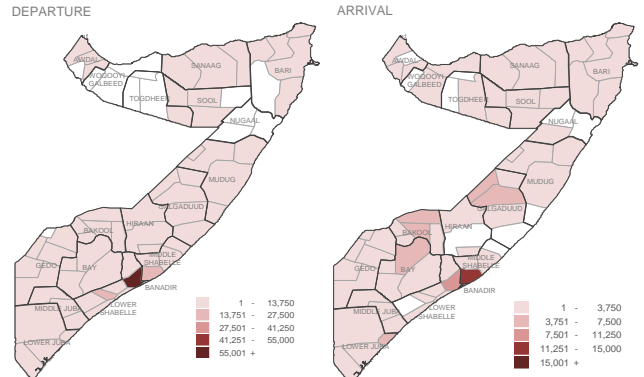
In Lower Shabelle region 14,000 persons were reported as newly displaced as a result of military operations against armed militia groups.

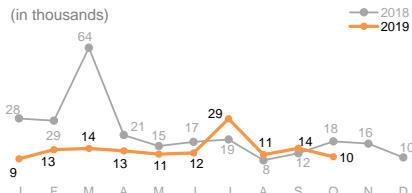

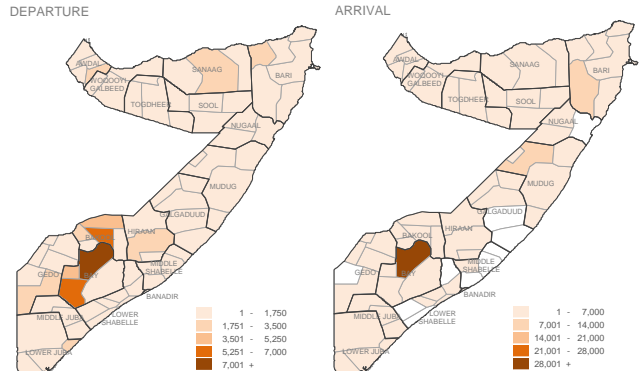
During the month of October, Sanaag (1,200) and Bari (1,200) regions were the most affected by new displacements where the main reason given was drought or related lack of livelihoods.

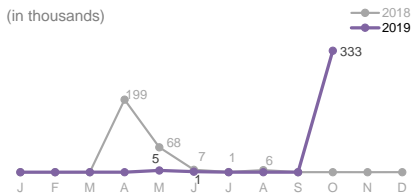

**FLOOD DISPLACEMENTS**

**333,000** in October

At least 231,000 have been displaced in Belet Weyne district and 63,000 in Baardheere district due to floods caused by heavy rains and rivers flooding. In Belet Weyne and surrounding areas, river levels reached its maximum carrying capacity on 24 October 2019 leading to overflow which left most of the town flooded



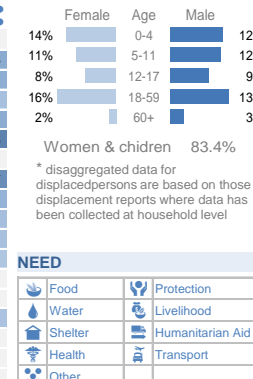

**About PRMN**

The PRMN (Protection & Return Monitoring Network) is a UNHCR-led project which identifies and reports on displacements (including returns) of populations in Somalia. The network also identifies and reports on protection risks and incidents underlying such movements. Only figures collected by PRMN are reported above. Not all displacements in Somalia are captured. This dashboard should be read in conjunction with the Notes on PRMN Methodology (<https://data2.unhcr.org/en/documents/details/53888>) which outline the approach and certain limitations. The figures shown are for numbers of individuals and are based on interviews with key informants and/or displaced households at destination (unless otherwise noted).
