Refugee returnees to Somalia at 30 November 2019

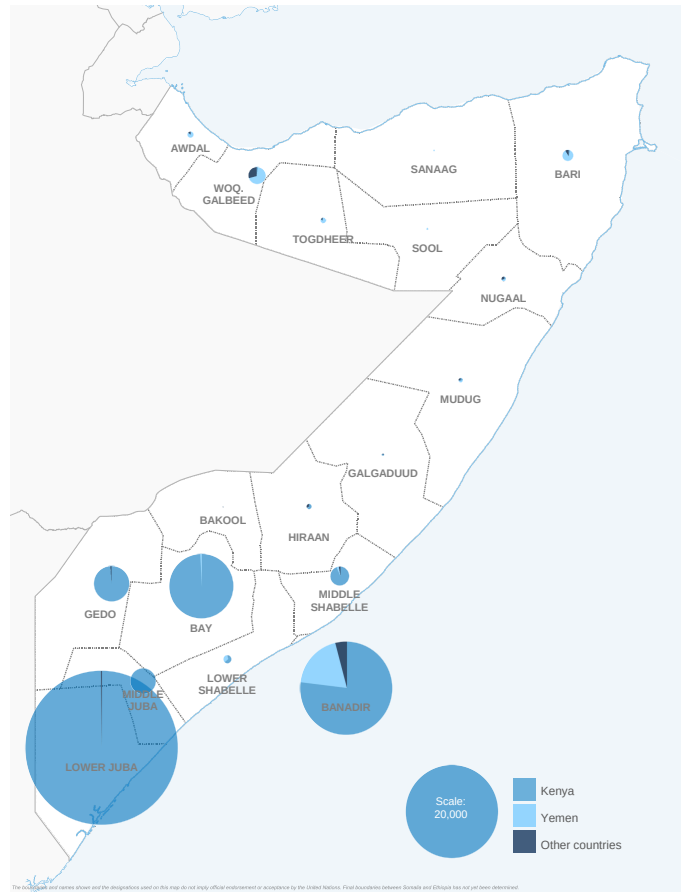

This figure includes Voluntary Repatriation from Kenya (84,820) and Assisted Spontaneous returnees from Yemen (4,942) as well as 1,470 returnees from other countries such as Djibouti (822), Libya (459), Sudan (143), Eritrea (34), Angola, Tunisia, Gambia, China, Cambodia and others. Somali refugees from these or other countries who return spontaneously without assistance from the UNHCR are not included.

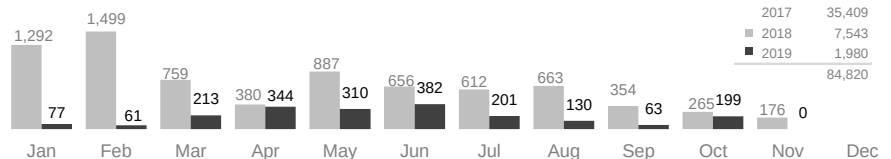

Data on destinations for returnees from Kenya is generally based on the place of initial return. In the case of arrivals by road convoy in 2017, the final destination declared on arrival is used.

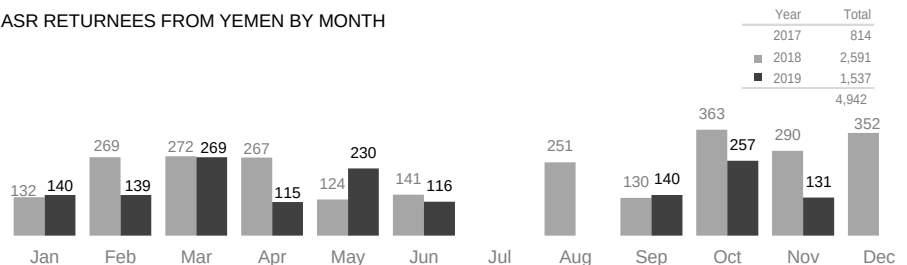
RETURNEES FROM KENYA BY MONTH

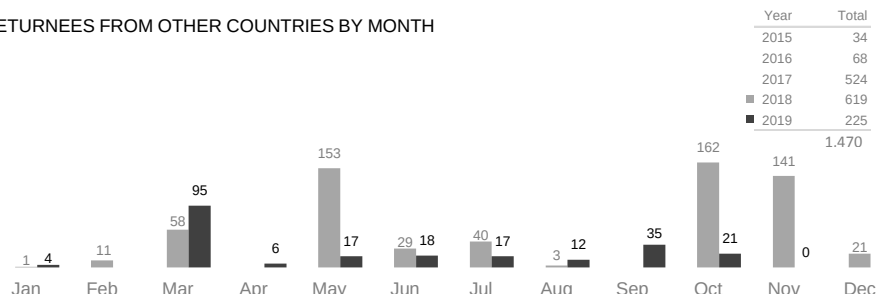
ASR RETURNEES FROM YEMEN BY MONTH
