



A combination of communal clashes, banditry and criminality in rural areas of Zamfara, Katsina and Sokoto states, continues to cause fatalities and forced displacement within and outside Nigeria. An estimated 60,000 Nigerian refugees crossed into Niger Republic since May 2019, due to violence in the three North-West states. Leading to declaration of L2 Emergency in Niger in March 2019.






