On 17 February 2008, Kosovo declared its independence, but Serbia still claims it as a province.

North Kosovo
Kosovo declared independence in 2008. Its predominantly Serb-inhabited north—North Kosovo—has functioned independently from the rest of the country.

Names are Albanian/Serbian, except for Mamusa which is Albanian/Serbian/Turkish.

A municipality is named only when its name differs from that of the administrative center.

^aMitrovicë/Mitrovica is the capital of the municipalities of Mitrovicë e Jug/Južna Mitrovica (South Mitrovica) and Mitrovicë e Veriut/Severna Mitrovica (North Mitrovica).
