




Ages and Gender Ratio in Family




Age and Gender Breakdown










Average Monthly Income by Household






Intentions for Next 6 Months







Households with at least one member with legal and/or physical protection needs




Households by Shelter Type



Families residing in rented house / apartment and paying the rent regularly.






