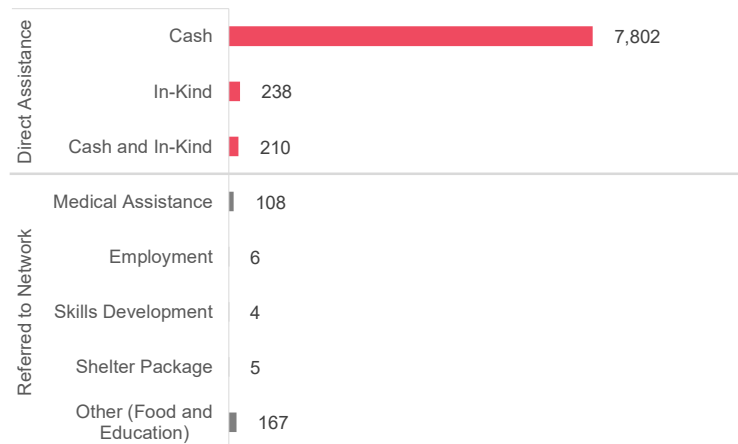

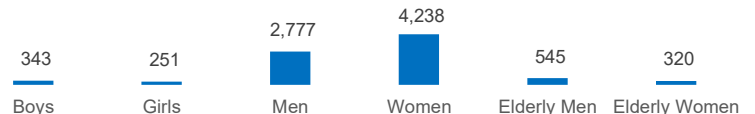

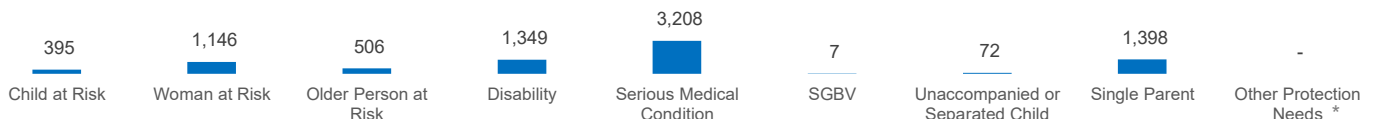
BENEFICIARIES BY ACTIVITY

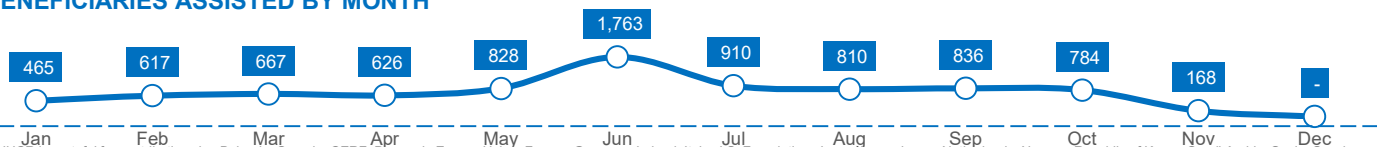


BENEFICIARIES BY VULNERABILITY
