

Somalia

1 - 31 March 2021

In March, 18,000 new internal displacements were monitored by the UNHCR-led Protection and Returns Monitoring Network (PRMN). The main drivers include drought-related (12,000) and conflict and insecurity (6.000).

Banadir region received the highest number of displaced persons (3,000), while Gedo (2,000), Middle Juba (2,000) and Bari (1,500) regions also received relatively high numbers.



refugees & asylum-seekers

At the end of March 2021, there were 25,307 refugees and asylum-seekers registered in Somalia, mainly from Ethiopia (13,211 asylum seekers and 4,182 refugees) and Yemen (6,860 refugees). The remaining 1,074 persons were from Syria (779), Tanzania (125), Eritrea (90) and other countries (80).



refugee returnees (2014 - 2021)


Since December 2014, 92,150 Somali refugees have voluntarily returned to Somalia with UNHCR assistance from different countries of asylum including Kenya, Yemen, Djibouti, Libya, Sudan and Eritrea. In addition, some 39,974 Somalis were monitored as arriving from Yemen since March




Returnees, refugee and asylum seekers map










Somalia Internal DISPLACEMENT Monthly internal displacement (2020-2021)
