**Land violations committed in December 2021**

1 December	1200	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Udaysah and point TP36 (2), an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of 10 individuals in military clothing approached. They conducted a patrol along the dirt road from the aforementioned point to point TP37, all the while pointing their weapons towards Lebanese territory.
2 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 30 in Arab al-Luwayzah, 14 in Amra, 20 in Yarun, 14 in Mays al-Jabal, 5 in Marwahin and 7 in Duhayrah.
	0700	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Udaysah and point TP36(2), an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of 14 individuals in military clothing approached and conducted a patrol along the dirt road from the aforementioned point to point TP37. Then, several of the patrol members opened a metal gate in the technical fence, whereupon nine patrol members took up positions inside the emplacement situated at the site, while the other five took up positions along the dirt road and pointed their weapons towards Lebanese territory.
3 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 14 in Mays al-Jabal, 3 in Alma al-Sha'b, 21 in Marwahin and 10 in Duhayrah.
5 December	0700	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Udaysah and point TP36(2), an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of 13 individuals in military clothing approached and conducted a patrol along the dirt road from the aforementioned point to point TP37. Then, several of the patrol members opened a metal gate in the technical fence, whereupon eight patrol members took up positions inside the emplacement situated at the site, while the other five took up positions along the dirt road and pointed their weapons towards Lebanese territory.
	1110	From occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Mays al-Jabal and points B70 and BP32, an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of six individuals in military clothing arrived and inspected the technical fence. As some farmers collected firewood on the Lebanese side, the patrol members took up combat positions and directed insults at the farmers. This incident occurred in the presence of a patrol from Observer Group Lebanon, which operates as part of the United Nations Interim Force in Lebanon (UNIFIL). The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1130 hours.
6 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 32 in Arab al-Luwayzah, 21 in Amra, 32 in Yarun, 18 in Marwahin, 20 in Mays al-Jabal and 2 in Alma al-Sha'b.

	0800	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Udaysah and point TP36(2), an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of 11 individuals in military clothing approached and conducted a patrol along the dirt road from the aforementioned point to point TP37. Then, several of the patrol members opened a metal gate in the technical fence, whereupon seven patrol members took up positions inside the emplacement situated at the site, while the other four took up positions along the dirt road and pointed their weapons towards Lebanese territory.
7 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 33 in Yarun, 7 in Arab al-Luwayzah, 16 in Amra, 27 in Hula, 2 in Alma al-Sha‘b and 19 in Mays al-Jabal.
	0700	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Udaysah and point TP36(2), an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of 12 individuals in military clothing approached and conducted a patrol along the dirt road from the aforementioned point to point TP37. Then, several of the patrol members opened a metal gate in the technical fence, whereupon seven patrol members took up positions inside the emplacement situated at the site, while the other five took up positions along the dirt road and pointed their weapons towards Lebanese territory.
	0720	An Israeli enemy foot patrol consisting of 26 individuals in military clothing approached from occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Mays al-Jabal and points B64 and B65. The patrol passed through a metal gate in the technical fence, opposite point B64, and searched the area between the technical fence and the Blue Line, without breaching the latter. The patrol was accompanied by a Merkava tank that was positioned behind an earthen berm and the cannon of which was pointed towards Lebanese territory. In addition, patrol members pointed their weapons towards Lebanese army troops. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 0800 hours.
8 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 27 in Yarun, 35 in Marwahin, 1 in Duhayrah, 9 in Arab al-Luwayzah, 26 in Amra, 15 in Hula and 2 in Markaba.
	0700	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Udaysah and point TP36(2), an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of 14 individuals in military clothing approached and conducted a patrol along the dirt road from the aforementioned point to point TP37. Then, several of the patrol members opened a metal gate in the technical fence, whereupon seven patrol members took up positions inside the emplacement situated at the site, while the other seven took up positions along the dirt road and pointed their weapons towards Lebanese territory.
	1240	The sound of two explosions, the cause of which is unknown, emanated from inside the occupied Shab‘a Farms.
9 December	–	Two landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated in Alma al-Sha‘b.

11 December	0830	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Udaysah and point TP36(2), an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of 25 individuals in military clothing approached and conducted a patrol along the dirt road from the aforementioned point to point TP37. Then, several of the patrol members opened a metal gate in the technical fence, whereupon seven patrol members took up positions inside the emplacement situated at the site, while another 10 took up positions along the dirt road and pointed their weapons towards Lebanese territory.
12 December	0700	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Udaysah and point TP36(2), an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of 13 individuals in military clothing approached and conducted a patrol along the dirt road from the aforementioned point to point TP37. Then, several of the patrol members opened a metal gate in the technical fence, whereupon seven patrol members took up positions inside the emplacement situated at the site, while the other six took up positions along the dirt road and pointed their weapons towards Lebanese territory.
13 December	–  0700	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 66 in Hula, 1 in Markaba, 18 in Marwahin and 10 in Duhayrah.  In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Udaysah and point TP36(2), an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of 13 individuals in military clothing approached and conducted a patrol along the dirt road from the aforementioned point to point TP37. Then, several of the patrol members opened a metal gate in the technical fence, whereupon seven patrol members took up positions inside the emplacement situated at the site, while the other six took up positions along the dirt road and pointed their weapons towards Lebanese territory.
14 December	–  0700	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 25 in Amra, 2 in Markaba, 11 in Marwahin and 24 in Yarun.  Israeli enemy soldiers used a JCB bulldozer to uproot two trees in occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Udaysah. At 0724 hours, the bulldozer breached the Blue Line and uprooted two trees that were 10 m and 12 m, respectively, inside Lebanese territory. The Israeli enemy continued work until 0809 hours, its soldiers uprooting most of the trees in occupied Lebanese territory. The violations were documented by a team from Observer Group Lebanon, which operates as part of UNIFIL.
15 December	2333	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Aytarun and point B55(1), the Israeli enemy fired three flares, one of which fell in Lebanese territory.
19 December	2140	In occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Sardah, near point B93, an Israeli enemy patrol comprising a Humvee vehicle approached. Two soldiers disembarked and fired four rounds into the air towards Lebanese territory. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 2205 hours.

21 December	0430	From occupied territory opposite the town of Wazzani, the Israeli enemy fired 10 flares, three of which fell in Lebanese territory: two in the locality of Sulayyib, on the outskirts of the town of Mari, and one outside the town of Wazzani.
22 December	1130	An Israeli enemy patrol comprising a Humvee vehicle, a Defender vehicle and a civilian van approached from occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Ramiya and point BP10/1. Approximately 15 individuals in military clothing disembarked and created an opening in the technical fence, through which 10 of those individuals then passed. They then deployed themselves behind the earthen berms and pointed their weapons towards Lebanese territory and a Lebanese Army patrol. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1200 hours.
23 December	–	Three landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated in Alma al-Sha‘b.
25 December	–	Outside the town of Hula, a civilian came across 52 mm mortar flare shell that the Israeli enemy had fired previously. Lebanese Army personnel detonated the shell in the presence a patrol from the Nepalese contingent of UNIFIL.
26 December	1000	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Udaysah and point TP36(2), an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of 10 individuals in military clothing approached and conducted a patrol along the dirt road from the aforementioned point to point TP37. Then, several of the patrol members opened a metal gate in the technical fence, whereupon six patrol members took up positions inside the emplacement situated at the site, while the other four took up positions along the dirt road and pointed their weapons towards Lebanese territory.
28 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 6 in Mays al-Jabal and 3 in Alma al-Sha‘b.
	0800	In occupied Lebanese territory, opposite the town of Udaysah and point TP36(2), an Israeli enemy patrol consisting of 12 individuals in military clothing approached and conducted a patrol along the dirt road from the aforementioned point to point TP37. Then, several of the patrol members opened a metal gate in the technical fence, whereupon seven patrol members took up positions inside the emplacement situated at the site, while the other five took up positions along the dirt road and pointed their weapons towards Lebanese territory.
	0815	An Israeli enemy patrol comprising two military vehicles approached from occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Wazzani, at the Maysat point. Approximately six patrol members in military clothing disembarked, opened the metal gate in the technical fence and proceeded about 100 m beyond it. They then hurled three red smoke bombs. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 0825 hours.
	0930	An Israeli enemy patrol consisting of 21 individuals in military clothing approached from occupied Palestinian territory, opposite the town of Wazzani and pillar No. 40. They opened the metal gate in the technical fence and conducted a foot patrol along the Wazzani River, stopping opposite the Maysat point. Meanwhile, the cannon of a Merkava tank

Meanwhile, the cannon of a Merkava tank was pointed at Lebanese territory. The patrol left in the direction of occupied territory at 1150 hours.
30 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 10 in Mays al-Jabal and 3 in Alma al-Sha‘b.
31 December	–	Landmines left behind by the Israeli enemy were detonated as follows: 8 in Mays al-Jabal and 4 in Alma al-Sha‘b.
