POPULATION TRENDS




The total of 1.6 million refugees represent a 13% increase from March 2021. Chad hosts the largest number or refugees with 68% from Sudan. Cameroon hosts the second largest number of refugees mainly from the Central African

Republic (71%) and Nigeria (27%).

The number of internally displaced persons rose to an estimated 7.6 million, up from 6.5 million at the end of March 2021. Nigeria hosts 42% of the IDP population in the


The Lake Chad Basin hosts 36% of forcibly displaced in West & Central Africa. Central Sahel hosts the second largest number (27%) with the majority being Internally Displaced Persons in Burkina Faso (73%).






