







## **SECTOR ACHIEVEMENTS**

In the first quarter of 2022, Basic Needs sector partners in Turkey reached approximately 2 million beneficiaries through cash-based interventions (CBIs) and the provision of assistance pertaining to shelter, food and NFIs. Almost 1.9 million individuals received monthly cash assistance under the country-wide framework of the Emergency Social Safety Net (ESSN) and the Complementary ESSN (C-ESSN). Additionally, nearly 28 thousand individuals were assisted through complementary one-time cash support provided by the sector partners.

With respect to food assistance, the number of beneficiaries reported in the first quarter was over 43 thousand, marking 28% progress against the related sectoral target for 2022, which is less compared to that of the same period of 2021 (66%). However, it should be noted that the 2022 target of the number of food assistance beneficiaries is almost 19% higher than in 2021, reflecting the increasing needs observed in this area due to the worsening economic situation of persons of concern and in turn their higher adoption of negative coping mechanisms regarding their food consumption patterns as corroborated by the relevant sectoral needs assessments as well.

The number of beneficiaries receiving non-food items (NFIs) including gender-appropriate hygiene, dignity and sanitary items and core relief items (CRIs) in the first quarter was almost 17 thousand. Only 15% of these were those receiving CRIs, revealing decreased need for these as the Covid-19 pandemic has been slowing down. Likewise, the target for the number of hygiene kit beneficiaries for 2022 is almost half of what it was in 2021.


In the first quarter of the year, more than 7.5 thousand individuals received shelter assistance, demonstrating 21% progress against the related target. The level of progress in this regard is similar to that of the first quarter of the last year, but it should be stressed the target increased by 70% in 2022 compared to 2021. Hence, support related to this indicator showed satisfactory progress during the first quarter of 2022.
