The total of 1.6 million refugees represent a 10% increase from April 2021. Chad hosts the largest number or refugees with 68% from Sudan. Cameroon hosts the second largest number of refugees mainly from the Central African Republic (72%) and Nigeria (27%).

The number of internally displaced persons rose to an estimated 7.6 million, up from 6.6 million at the end of May 2021, Nigeria hosts 41% of the IDP population in the region. Burkina Faso host the second largest number of IDP (24%) with and increase of 48%

The Lake Chad Basin hosts 36% of forcibly displaced population in West and Central Africa. Central Sahel hosts the second largest number (31%) with the majority being Internally Displaced Persons in Burkina Faso (64%).




