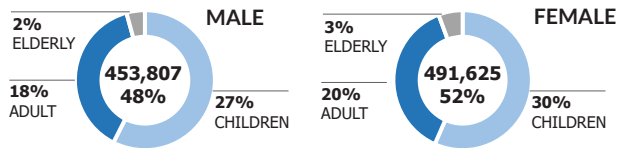

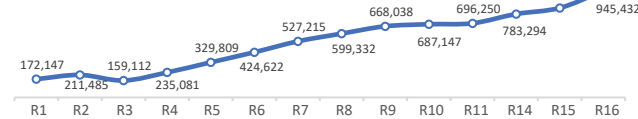

GENERAL PROTECTION

- Lack of civil documentation
- Limited psychosocial assistance
- Forced internal displacement
- Indiscriminate attack against civilians

CHILD PROTECTION

- Child marriage
- Violence against children
- abuse & neglect
- Separated & unaccompanied children

GENDER BASED VIOLENCE

- Sexual violence
- (including conflict related sexual violence)
- Denial of resources, opportunities or services
- Intimate partner violence

PSEA

- Sexual harassment
- Sexual exploitation
- Lack of community reporting mechanisms
- Discrimination against women

HOUSING, LAND AND PROPERTY

- Lack of land, housing and property tenure
- Eviction from land from exploration of natural resources without compensation
