




**BURUNDI REFUGEES AND ASYLUM SEEKERS
BY COUNTRY OF ASYLUM**




RETURNEES SINCE 2017 BY COUNTRY OF ASYLUM










Population of concern to UNHCR in Burundi

By the end of August 2022, Burundi was host to 376,180 persons of concern. This includes 204,301 returnees mainly from Tanzania, Rwanda, DRC and Uganda and a further 87,088 refugees and asylum-seekers, as well as 84,791 IDPs.
