


















## ACHIEVEMENTS

-  **2.1M** Internally Displaced Persons (IDPs) benefitted from UNHCR protection interventions in Northern Ethiopia
-  **493,510** IDPs received core relief items (CRIs) (98,700 families)
-  **841,910** IDPs received other non-food items (NFIs) (168,380 families)
-  **44,178** voluntary IDP returns facilitated by UNHCR and regional authorities
-  **65,600** women and girls received dignity kits
-  **48,490** IDPs benefitted from UNHCR emergency shelter kits (9,695 families)
-  **38,980** IDPs relocated to selected IDP sites
-  **3,360** IDPs received legal assistance and counseling
-  **7,010** persons with specific needs identified and supported
-  **408,660** IDPs assisted in UNHCR managed sites (81,730 families)
-  **107,140** IDPs reached with awareness raising sessions on GBV prevention, mitigation and response
-  **85,970** IDPs & IDP returnees received counselling services
-  **5,886** IDPs referred to adequate services in 55 Protection Desks
-  **37,440** IDPs & IDP returnees received cash assistance
-  **85,355** IDPs received solar lamps (17,070 families)
-  **9,375** IDPs received Mental Health and Psychosocial Services (MHPSS) through protection desks and Child Friendly Spaces (CFSs)
-  **5,995** partners and local authorities benefitted from capacity building and training on protection, GBV prevention and advocacy
