44,178 voluntary IDP returns facilitated by UNHCR and regional authorities



65,600 women and girls received dignity kits



48,490 IDPs benefitted from UNHCR emergency shelter kits (9.695 families)



38,980 IDPs relocated to selected IDP sites



3,360 IDPs received legal assistance and counseling
