Number of people displaced in South East since Feb 2021 and remain displaced

WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of IDPs increased from 371,300 last week to 380,300 this week.

In Bago Region (East), intense fighting and heavy artillery shelling displaced about 630 people from Kyaukkyi Township to areas within the same township and towards Phyu Township. Among them, 110 IDPs were verified in Phyu Township as having been displaced again.

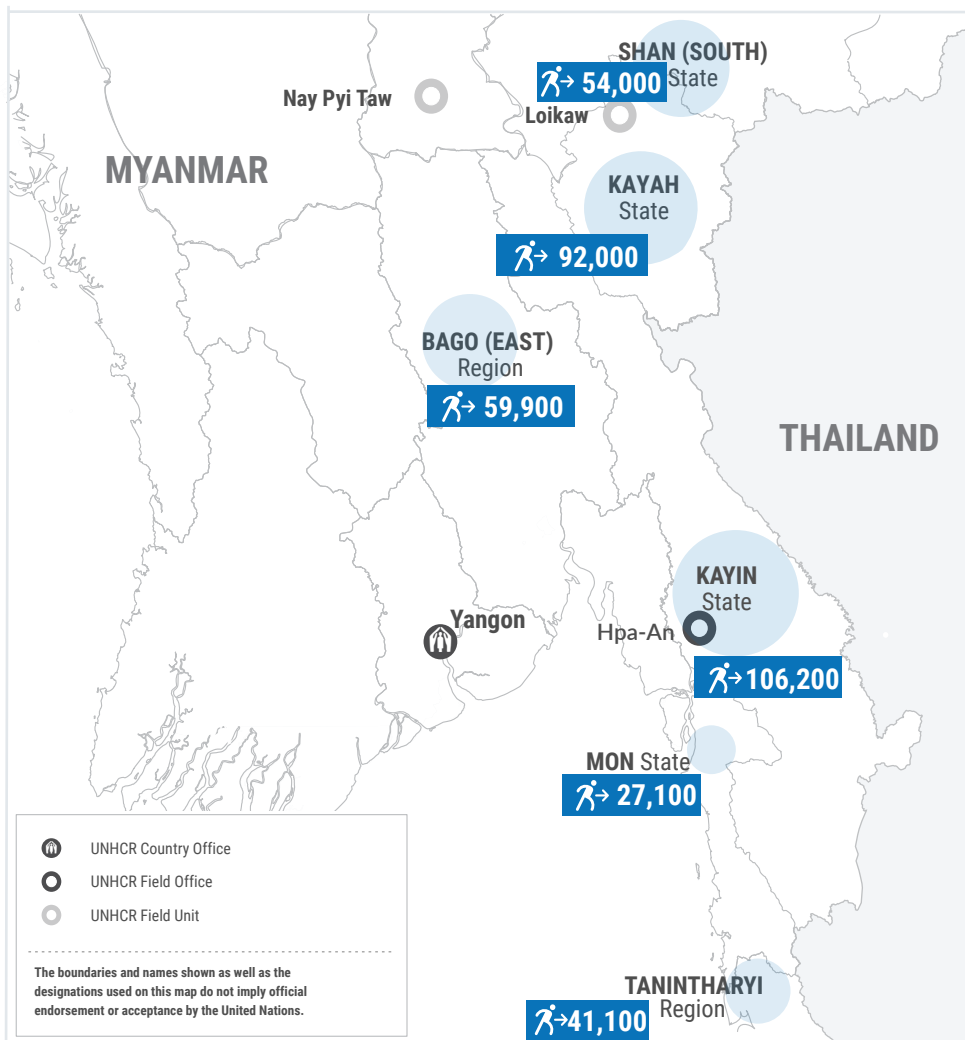
In Kayah State, 5,400 IDPs from Demoso, Hpruso, and Loikaw Townships were verified in Loikaw Town. This displacement occurred in 2022 but was only verified recently.

In Kayin State, intensified clashes and airstrikes near villages displaced 580 people from Myawaddy Township to other areas within the township. In Tanintharyi Region, insecurity and reported threats to civilian safety displaced about 2,500 people from Dawei and Palaw Townships to jungle areas within the respective townships.

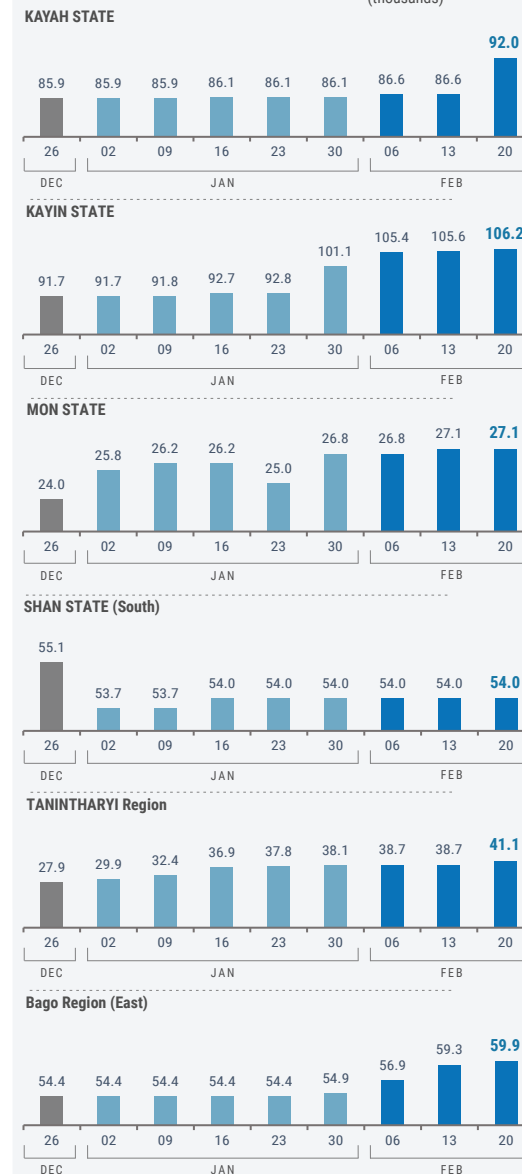
