



## REGIONAL COVERAGE



UNHCR's Regional Bureau for the East and Horn of Africa and the Great Lakes Region (EHAGL) is located in **Nairobi, Kenya** and covers **11 operations**: Burundi, Djibouti, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Kenya, Rwanda, Somalia, South Sudan, Sudan, Tanzania and Uganda. It currently manages **4 regional situations** (Burundi, Ethiopia, Somalia and South Sudan).

The Bureau has accountability for **strategic decision-making, regional prioritization, oversight of integrity issues, and quality assurance**, and possesses the technical capacity to support country operations in a wide range of sectors such as education, child protection, economic inclusion and durable solutions.

### DROUGHT RESPONSE

**1.52 million** priority populations targeted for assistance in Ethiopia, Kenya and Somalia, including 943,000 IDPs and 576,000 refugees.

**\$ 42.6 M** overall regional financial requirements, requested by UNHCR's regional drought appeal for 2022, including \$22 million in Ethiopia, \$11.1 million in Kenya and \$9.5 million in Somalia.




