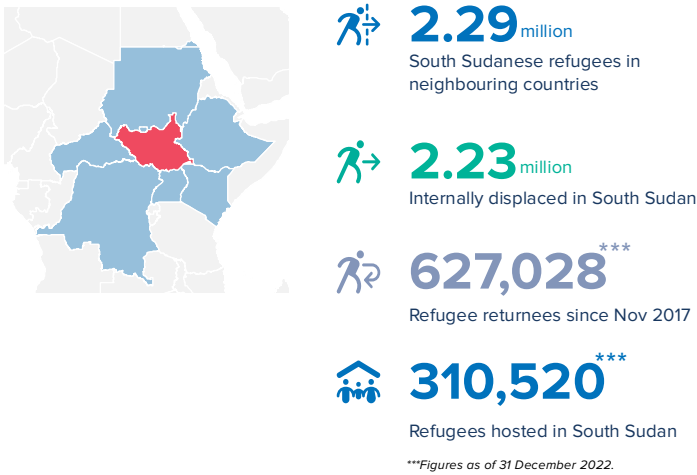


KEY POPULATION STATISTICS

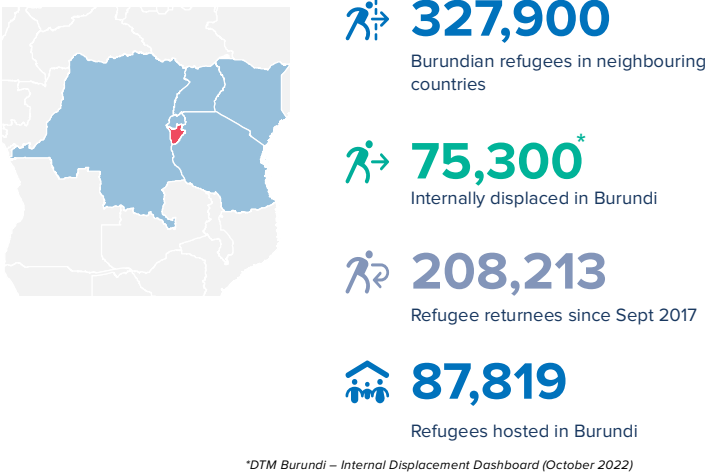


The East and Horn of Africa and Great Lakes region is host to some 4.96 million refugees and asylum seekers, the majority (2.24 million) from South Sudan. A further 11.71 million people are internally displaced in the region, as a result of conflict and natural disasters. A total of 12,500 refugees returned to their countries of origin in February 2023.

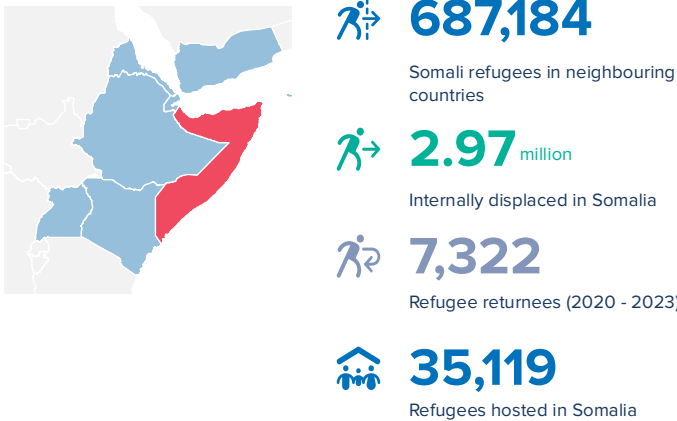
SOUTH SUDAN SITUATION



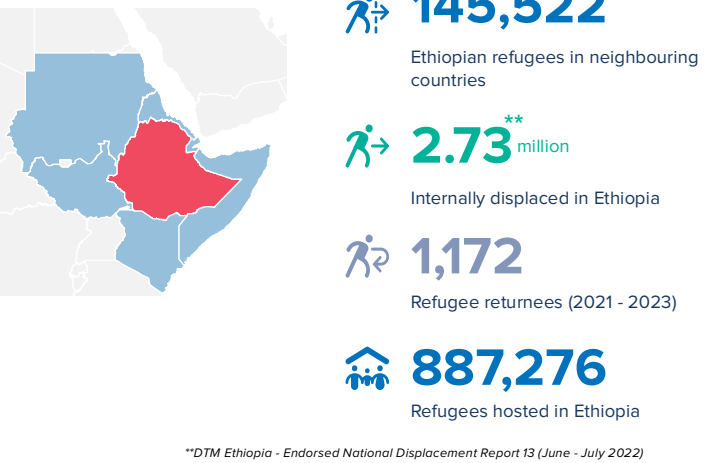
BURUNDI SITUATION



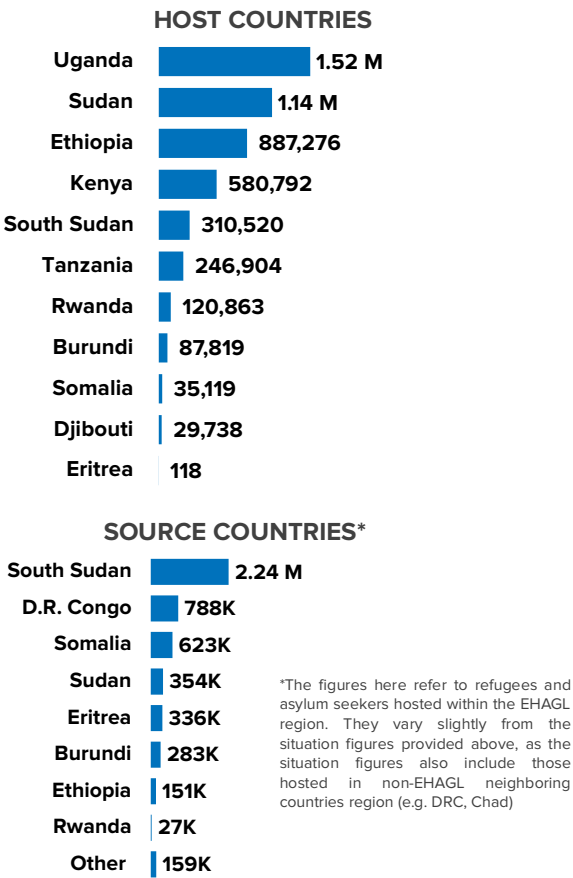
SOMALIA SITUATION



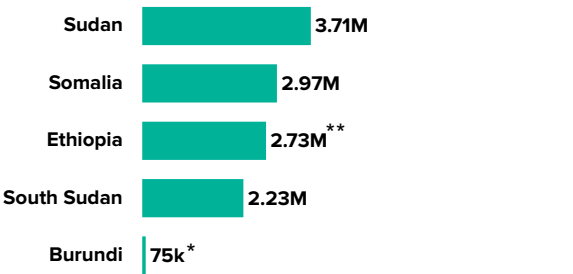

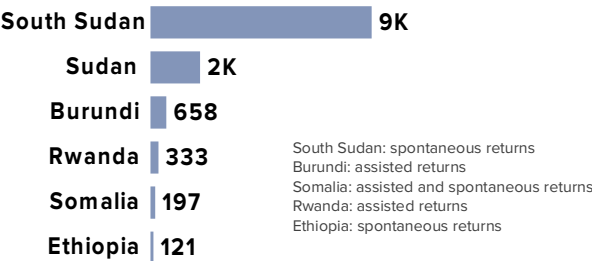
