WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of IDPs increased from 441,600 from last week to 446,800 this week.

In Bago Region (East), 4,200 people from five villages in Kyaukkyi Township were displaced within the township due to shelling on 30 May.

In Kayin State, 10 IDPs were verified in Hlaingbwe Township. They were displaced because of security concerns in the area.


In Mon State, 500 people from Thaton Township were displaced within the township because of armed conflict in their village on 17 May. However, 100 IDPs returned to their village on 23 May.

In Tanintharyi region, 610 people from at least five villages in Dawei Township were displaced within the township due to fighting near their villages on 28 May. Among them, 90 IDPs were displaced secondarily.







