The East and Horn of Africa and Great Lakes region is host to some 4.97 million refugees and asylum seekers, the majority (2.15 million) from South Sudan. A further 11.49 million people are internally displaced in the region, as a result of conflict and natural disasters. A total of 230,607 refugees have returned to their countries of origin in 2023.






