Refugees & Asylum-Seekers

At the end of September 2023, there were 37,241 refugees and asylum-seekers registered in Somalia, mainly from Ethiopia (24,768 asylum seekers and refugees), Yemen (10,582 refugees and asylum seekers) and Syria (1,493 refugees and asylum seekes). The remaining 398 persons of concerns were from other countries.

Refugee Returnees (2020 - 2023)

Since January 2020, 7,885 Somali refugees have returned to Somalia. This figure includes Voluntary Repatriation from Kenya (923) and Assisted Spontaneous Returnees (ASR) from Yemen (1,226) and other countries (372). Approximately 5 364 Somalis were monitored as arriving spontaneously from Yemen since January 2020.





Number of returnees (with assistance from UNHCR) since 2020









2023 displacement reasons






August 2023 displacement reasons
