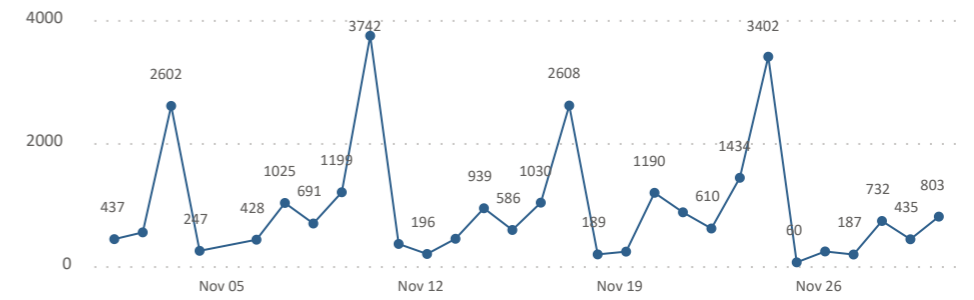

MONITORING METHODOLOGY

Under the lead of the Protec on Sector North-East Nigeria (PSNE), a total of 11 partner(s) of the North-East Nigeria Protec on Monitoring System (NEN-PMS) collected household level data through 767 household assessment in 14 LGA(s) in Borno, 9 LGA(s) in Adamawa, and 6 LGA(s) in Yobe. Protec on Monitoring under the NEN-PMS follows an area-based approach that focuses on understanding the protec on environment at the level of a camp, informal site or within the host community and includes all status groups among the popula on, i.e. displaced, returned, non-displaced people. NEN-PMS partners have used community-based networks to serve as entry points into communi es for the selec on of households to undergo household assessments. The selec on of households was targeted and aimed at predominantly including households with high levels of vulnerability, having likely been exposed to protec on threats and likely in need of protec on services or assistance. Partners have provided an adequate protec on response and/or ensured safe referrals to service providers from across other sectors, if households were assessed to require assistance and protec on, thereby linking the understanding of the protec ve environment to service provision.

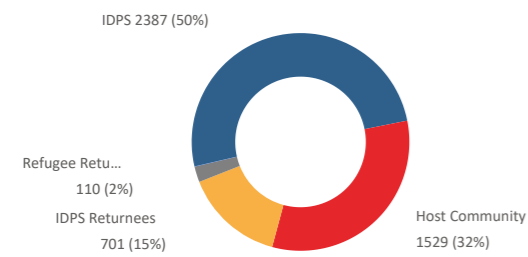
Individuals Reached per Time



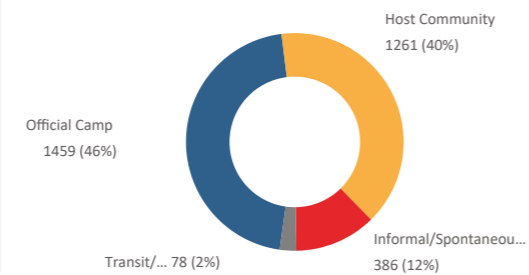

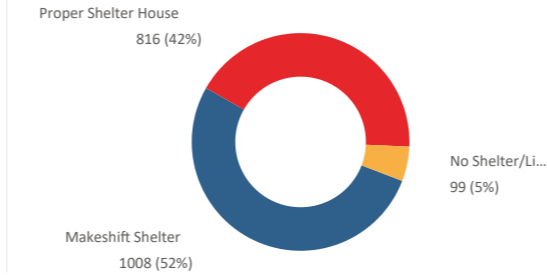

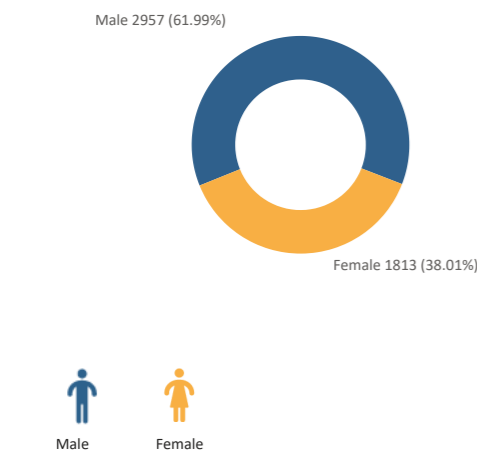

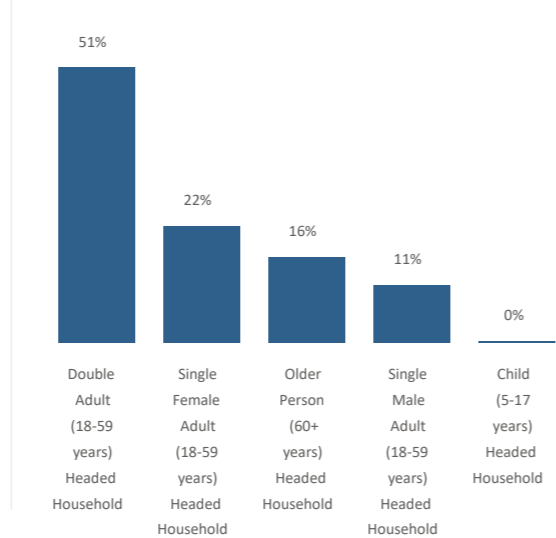
Household Shelter Type



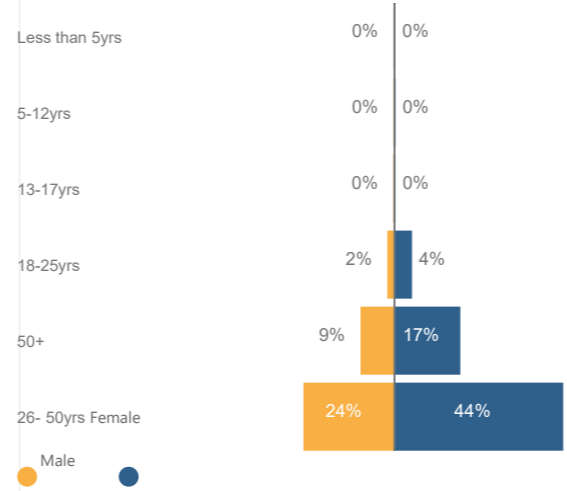
Gender of Heads of Households



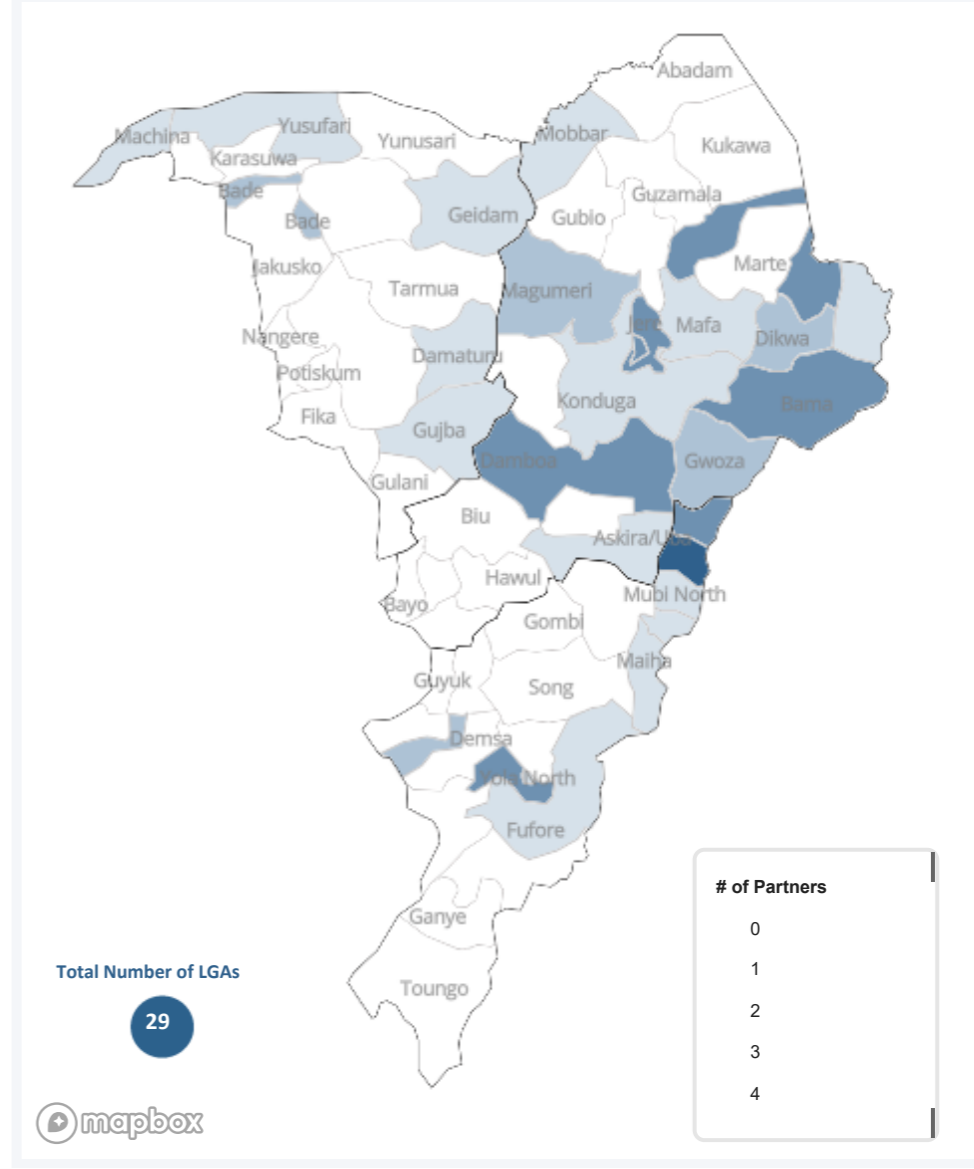
Status of Heads of Household

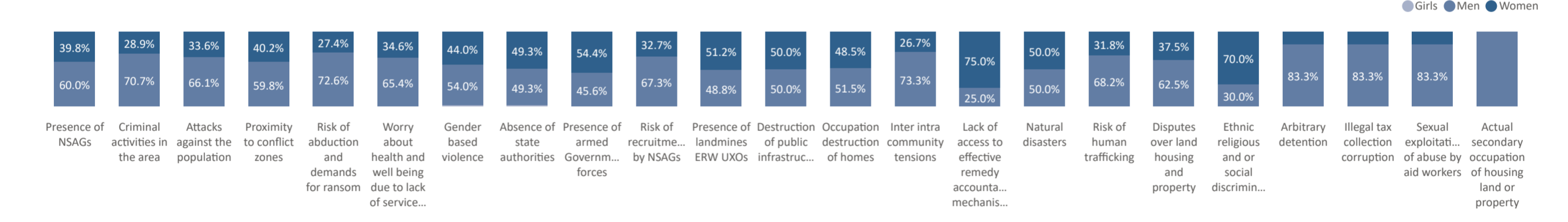

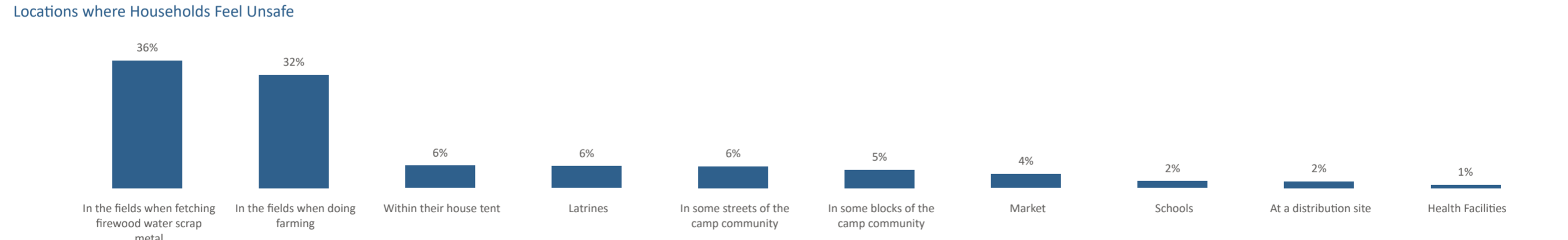
Reasons for Feeling Unsafe



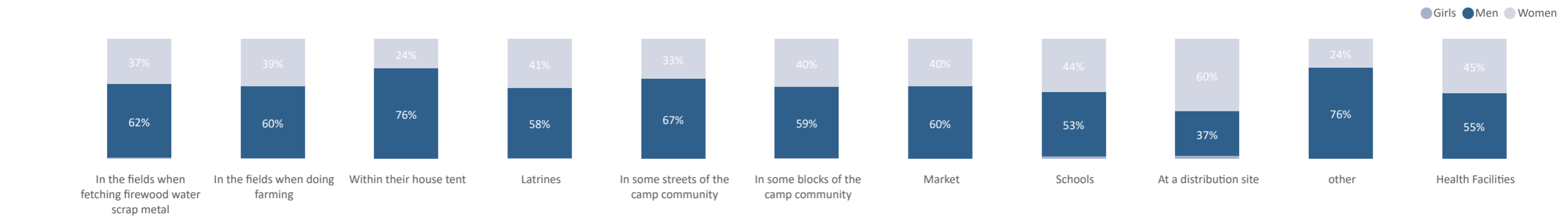
Gender Breakdown of Reasons to Feel Unsafe

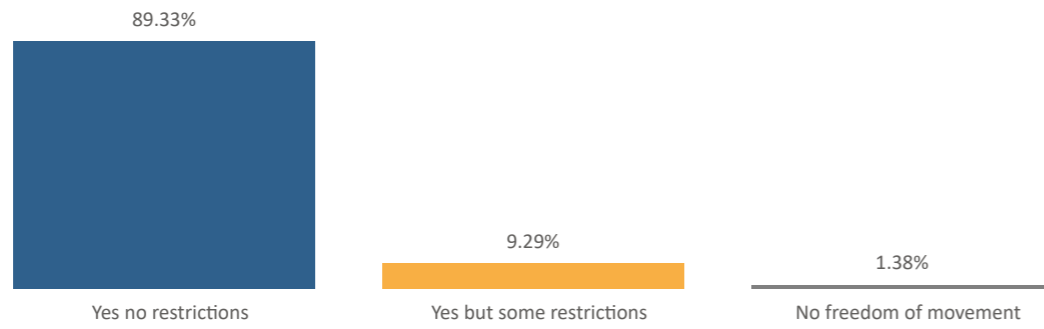

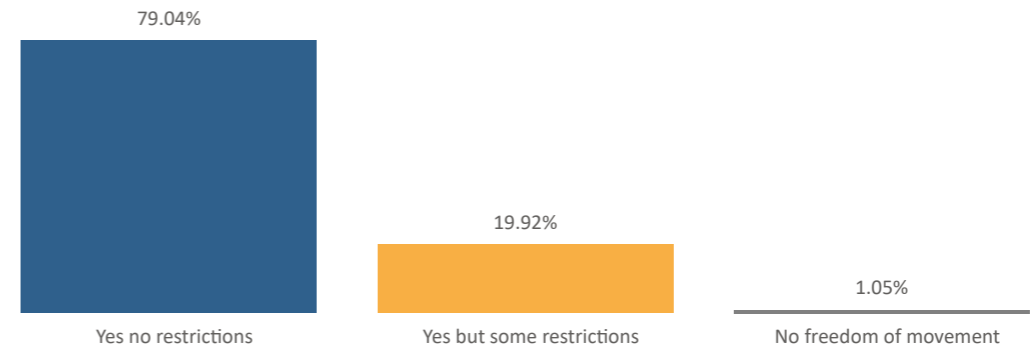

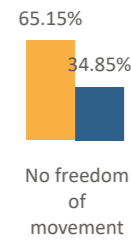
Limitations to Freedom of Movement Within Current Location



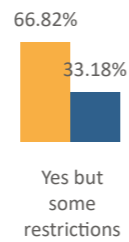
Limitations to Freedom of Movement Out of Current Location



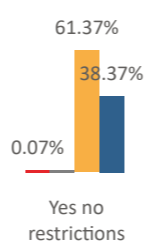

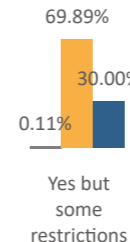

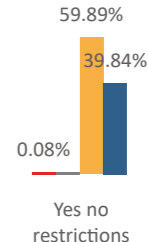

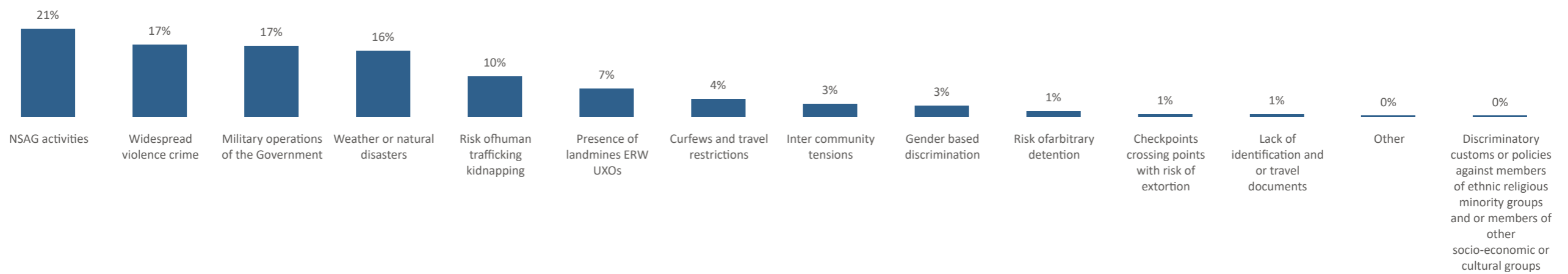

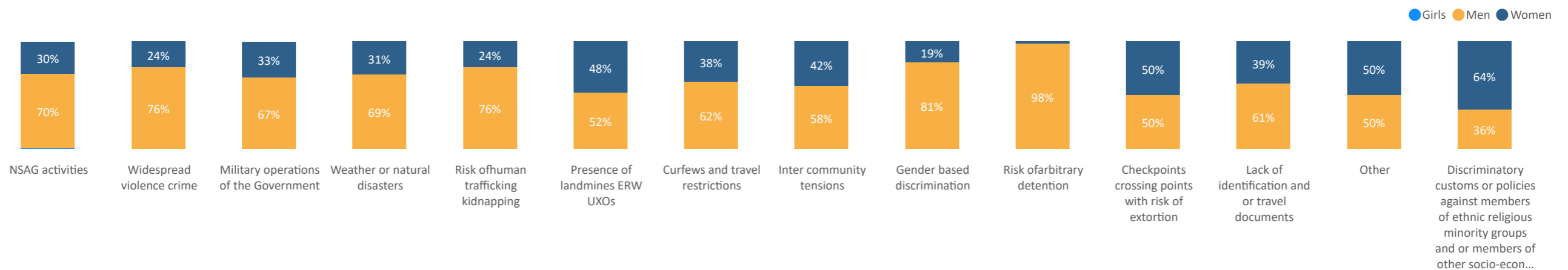

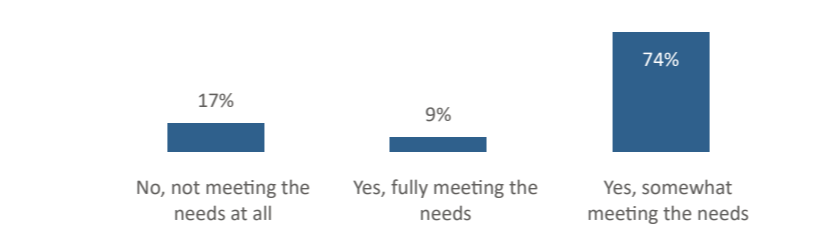

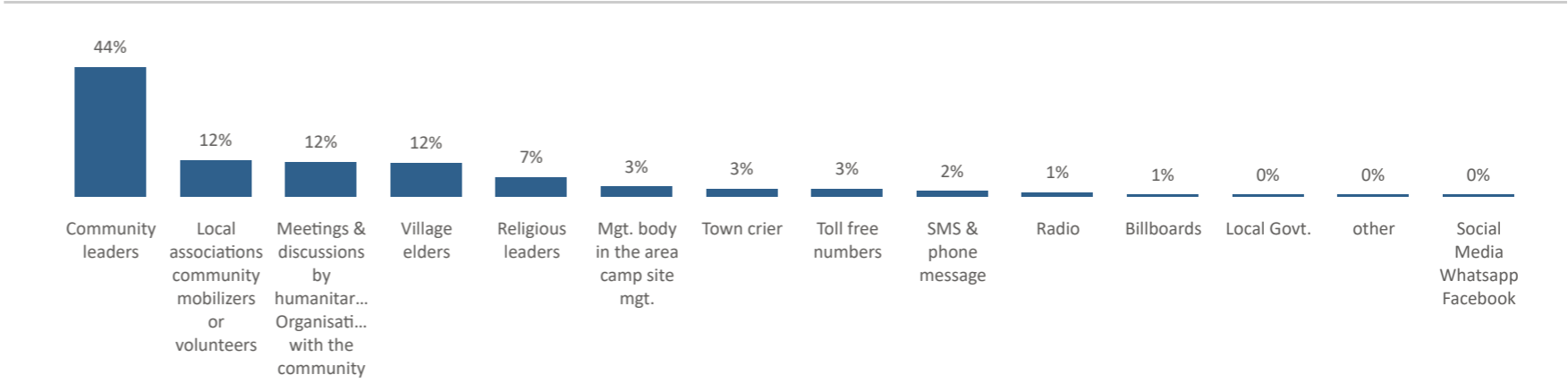
Level of Perceived Awareness of Humanitarian Services



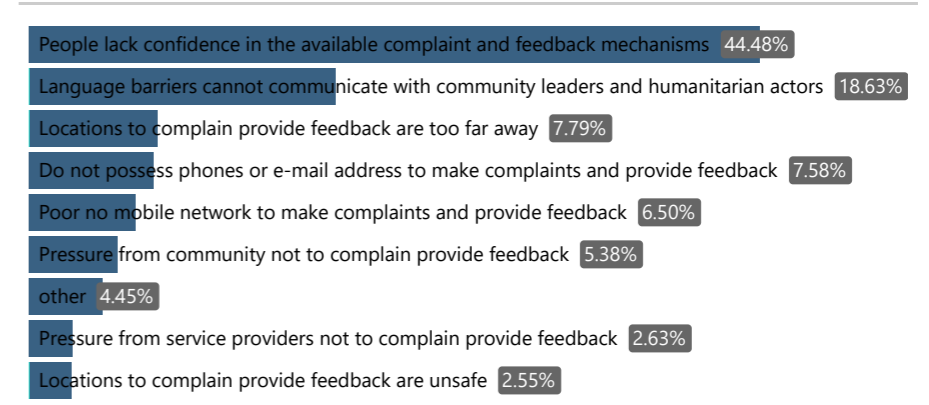
Extent to which Humanitarian Services are Responding to Household Needs



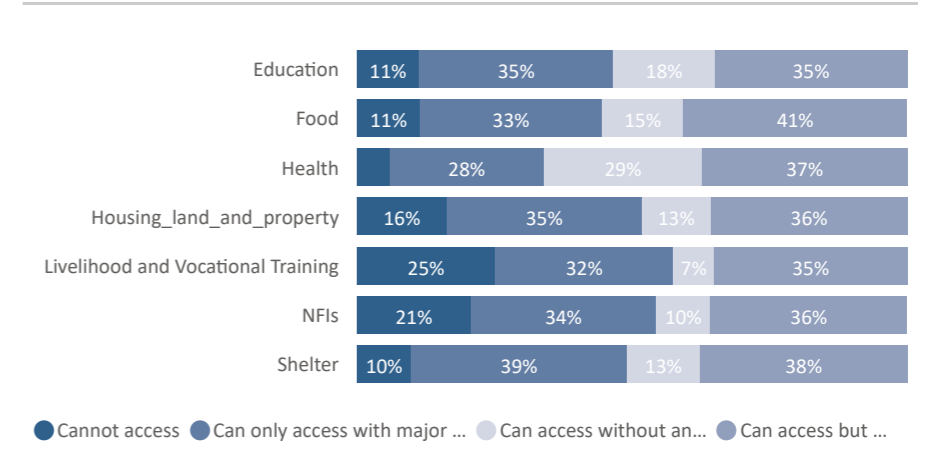
Households Preferred Channel to Receive Information

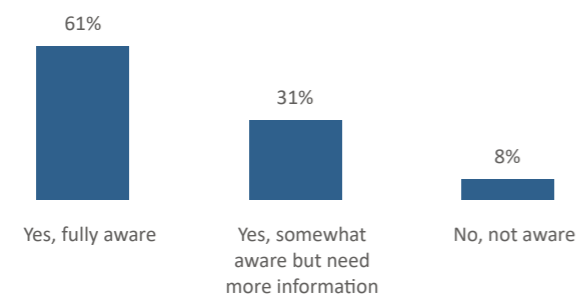

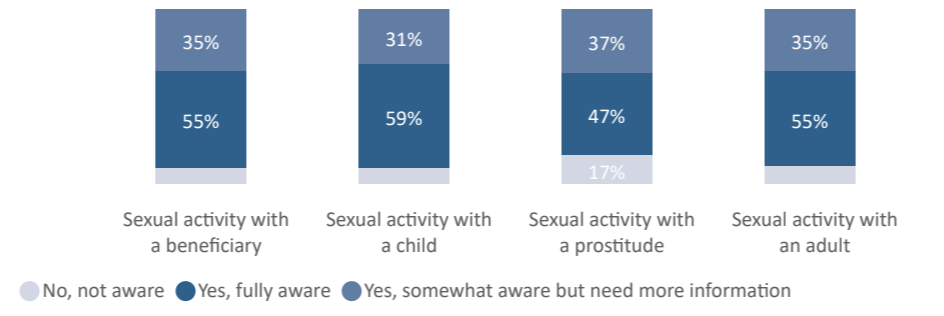

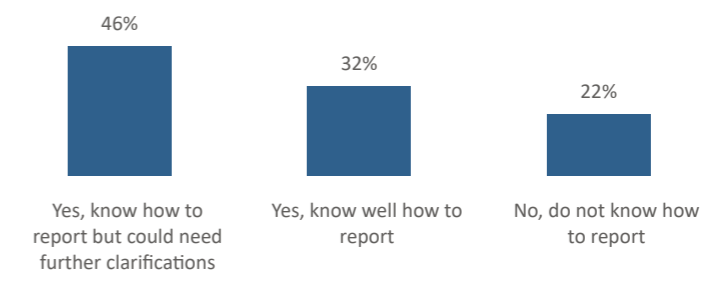
Level of Awareness that Humanitarian Aid is not Transactional



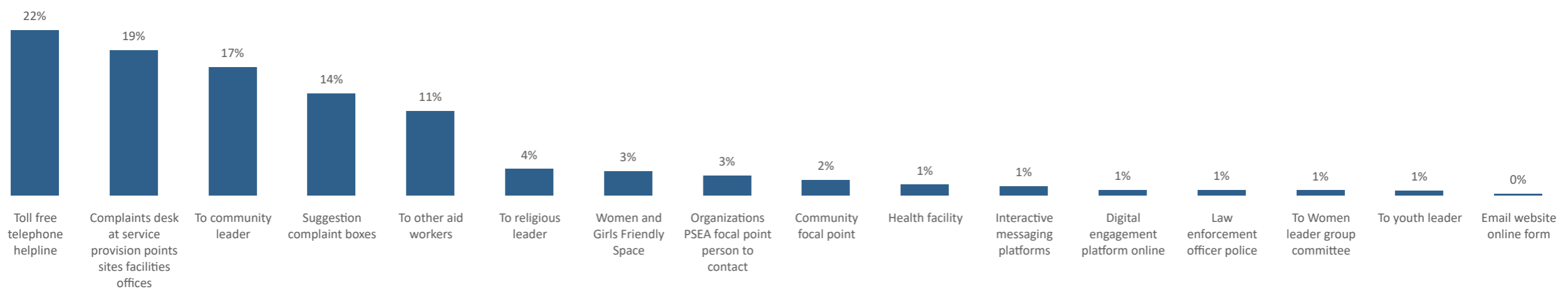
Level of Awareness of Unacceptable Behaviour of Humanitarian Aid Workers



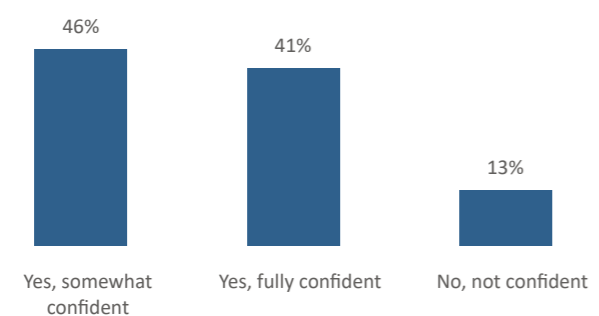
Level of Awareness on Mechanisms to Raise Complaints on Sexual Exploitation and Abuse by Humanitarian Workers



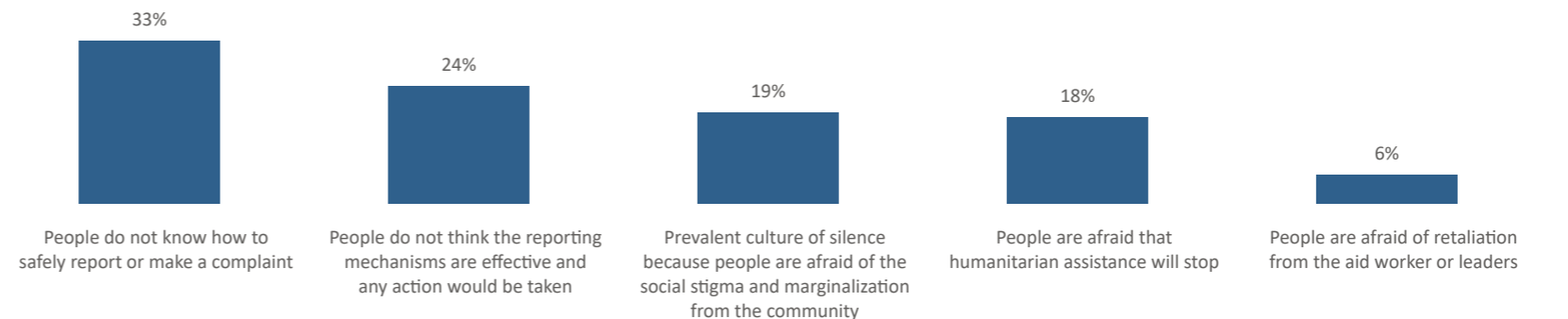
Available Reporting Mechanisms on Sexual Exploitation and Abuse by Humanitarian Workers

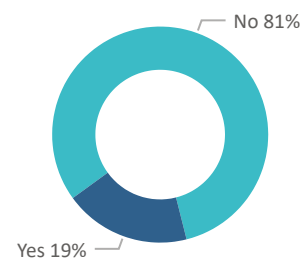

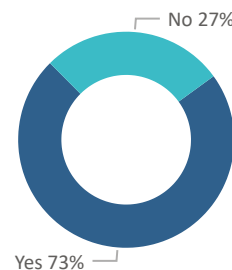
Women among Household Members Possessing Civil Documentation



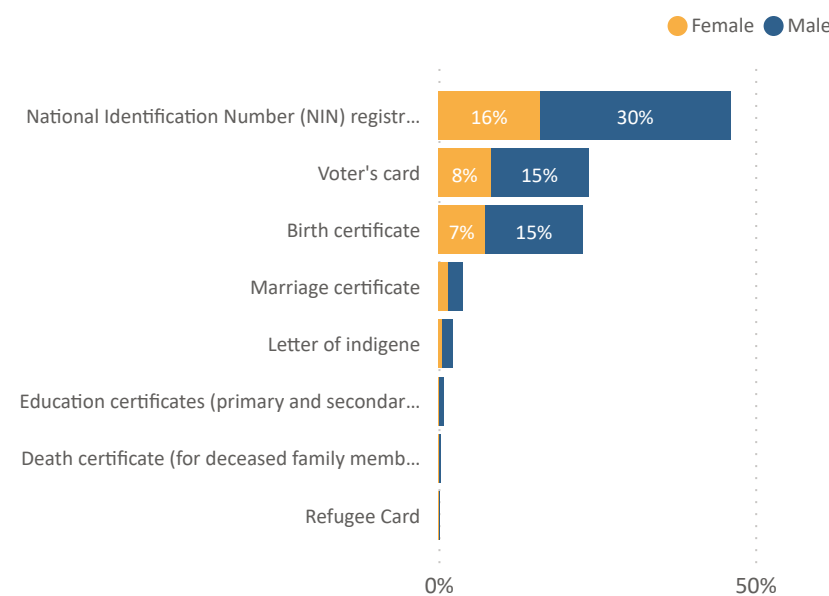
Household Members in Possession of HLP Documentation



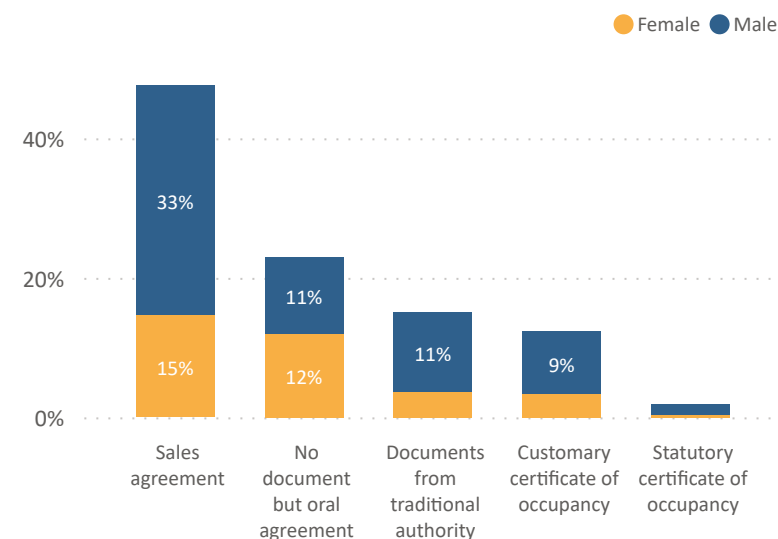

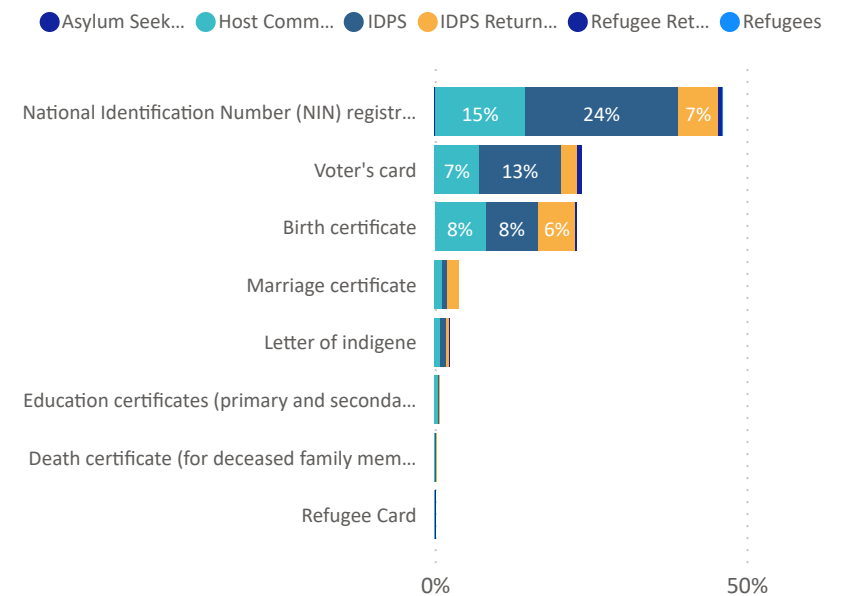
Types of Civil Documentation in Possession of Household Members by Gender



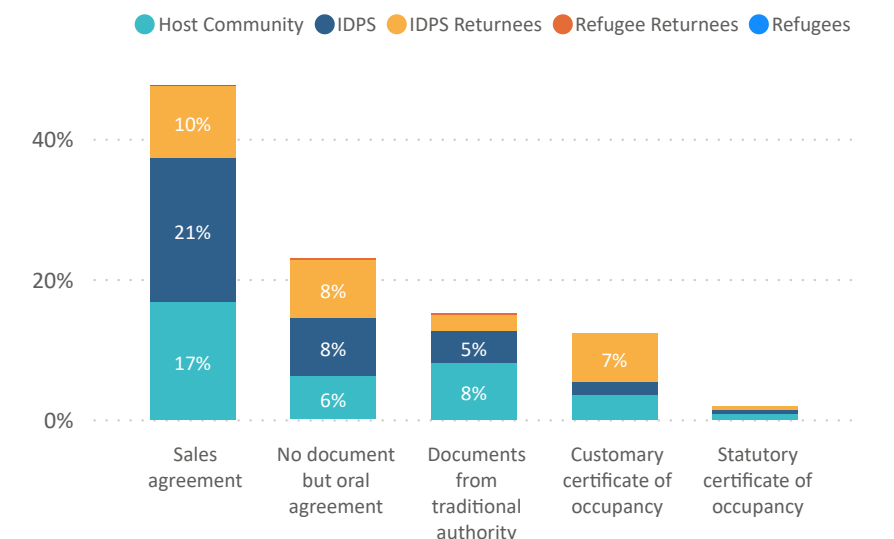
Types of HLP Documentation in Possession of Household Members by Gender

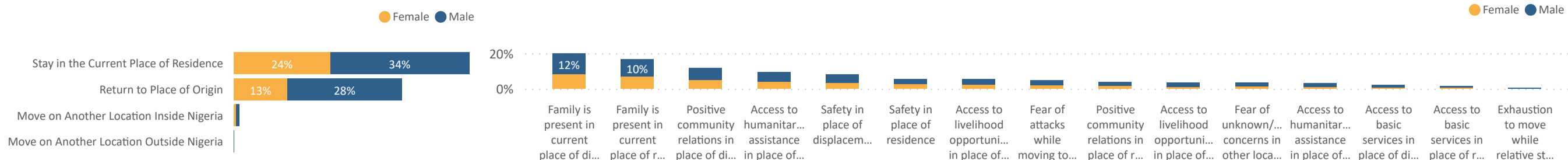

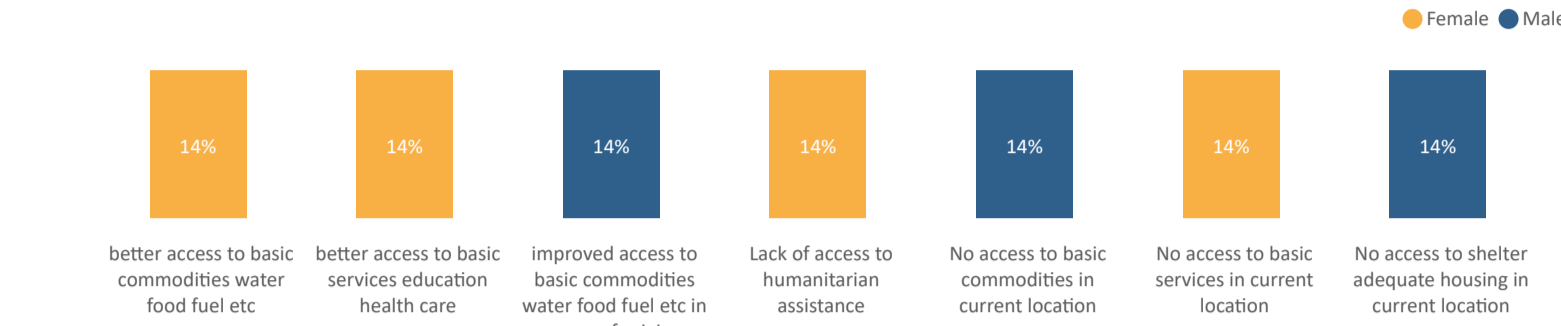

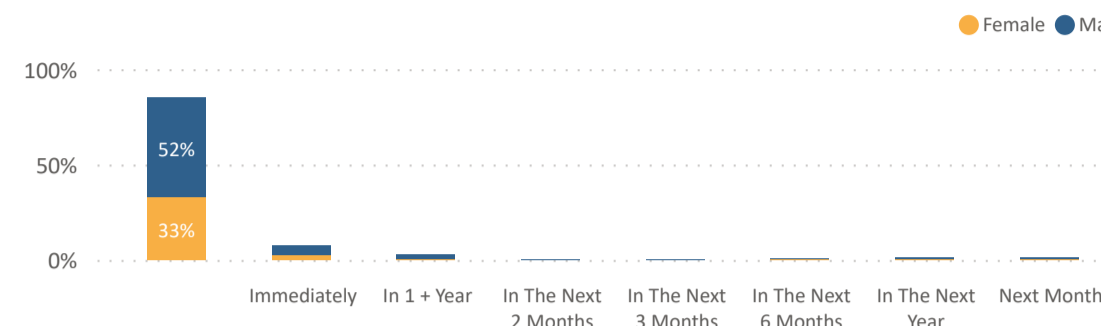
Reasons for Intention of Households to Stay in Place of Displacement



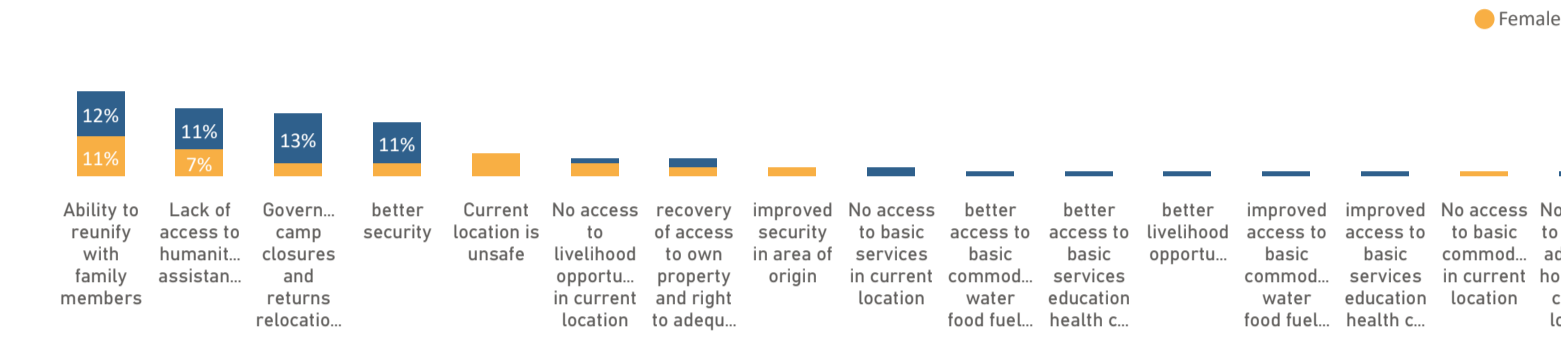
Push factors – Reasons for Intention of Households to Move due to Situation in the Current Location



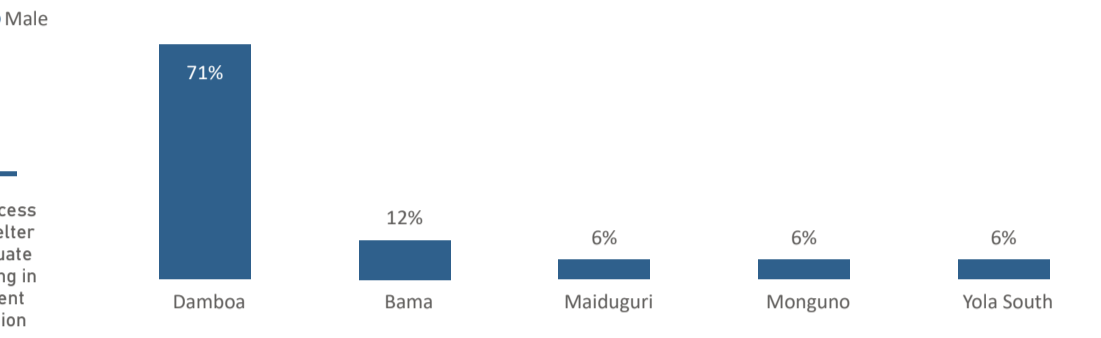
Timing of Realizing the Households' Movement Intentions



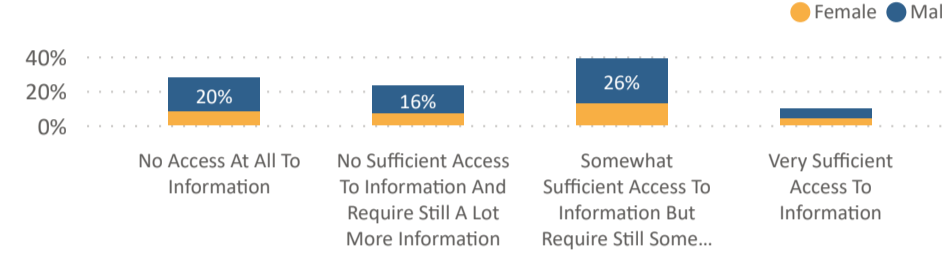
Pull factors – Reasons for Intention of Households to Move due to Situation in their Preferred Location



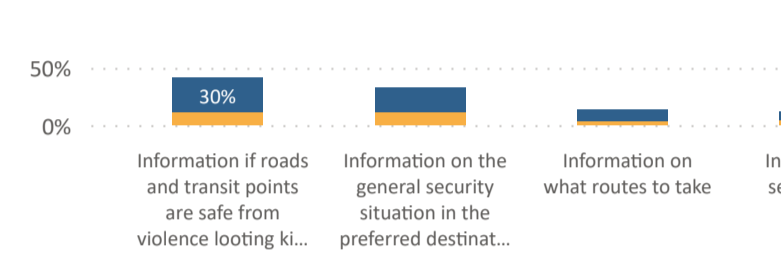

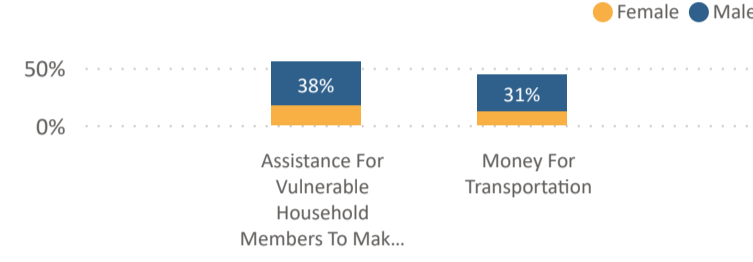
Current Access to Information to Realize the Household's Movement Intention

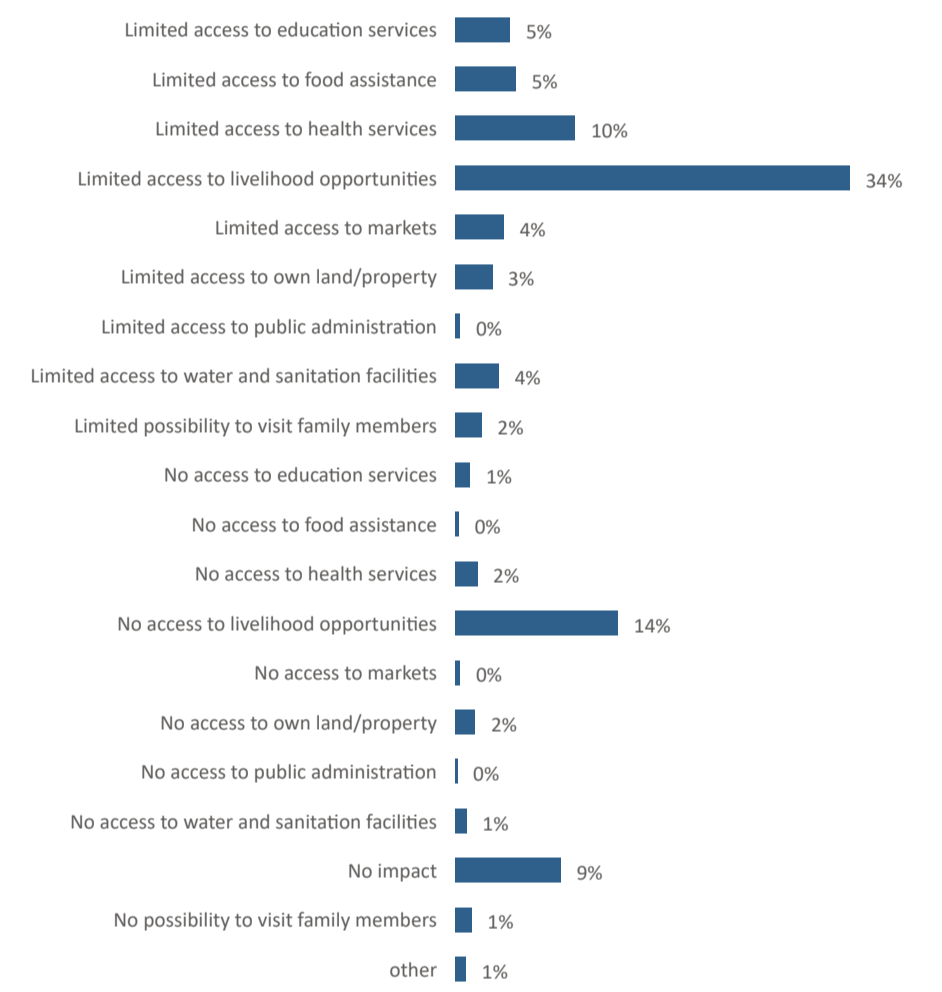

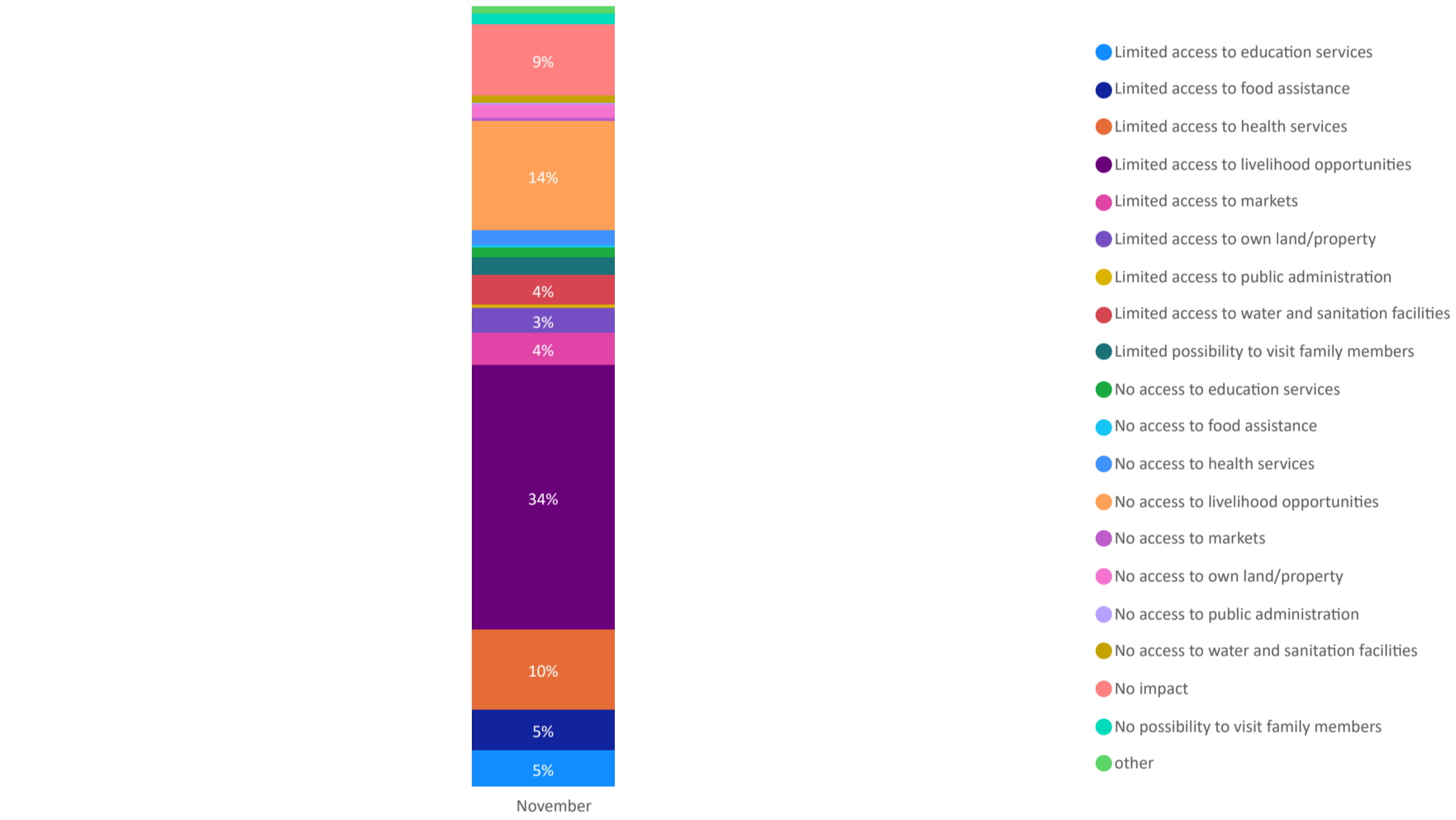

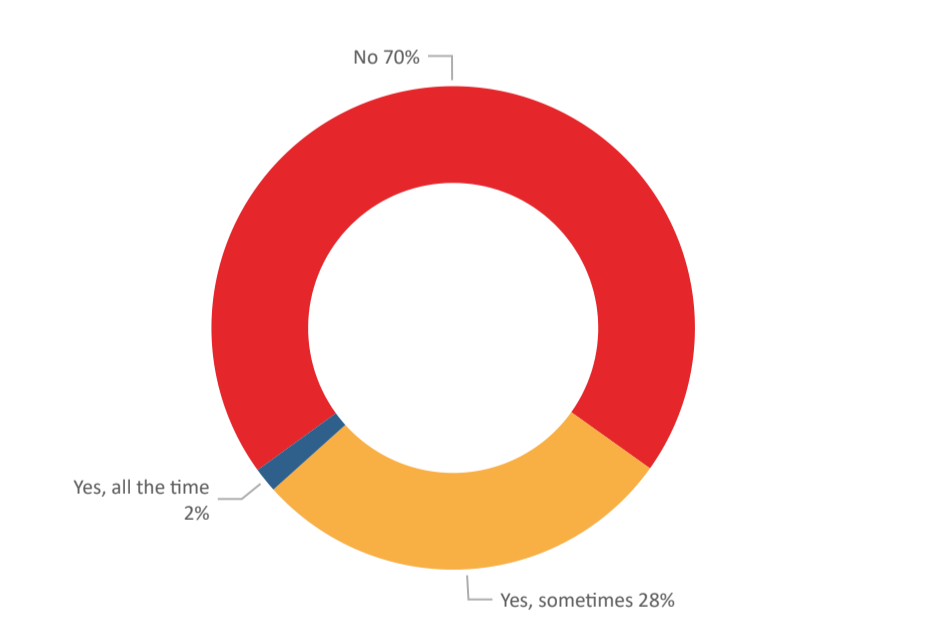


Trend of Consequences of Limitations to Freedom of Movement

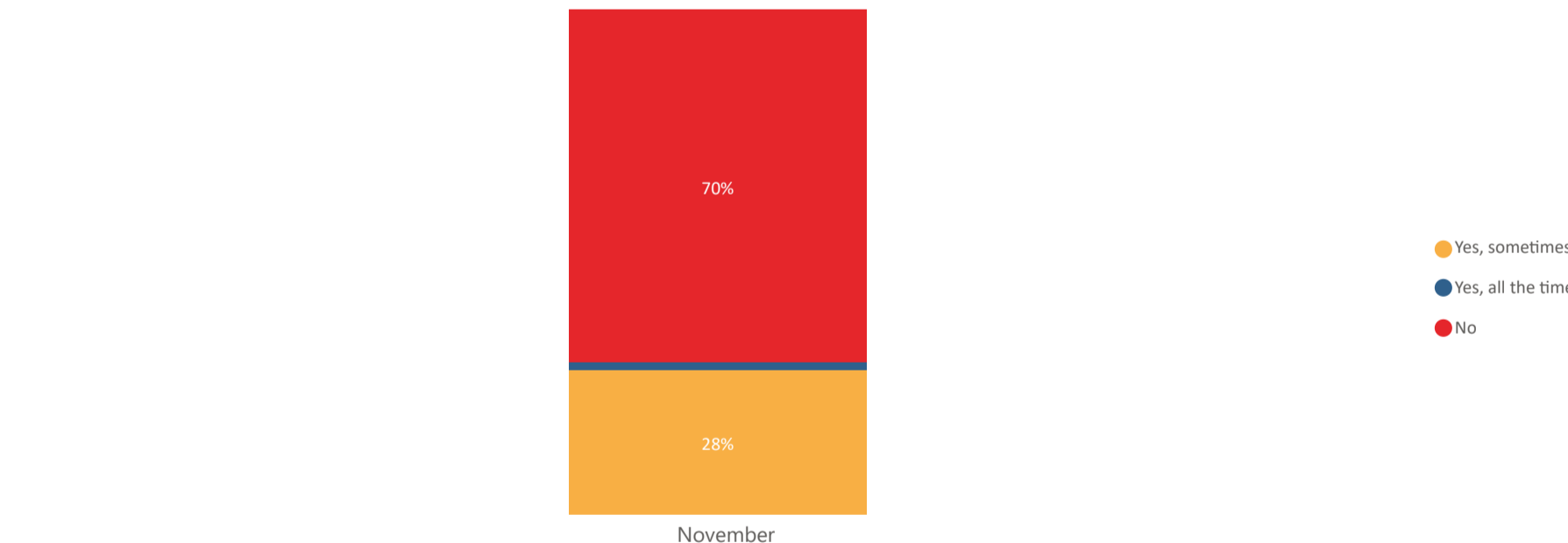

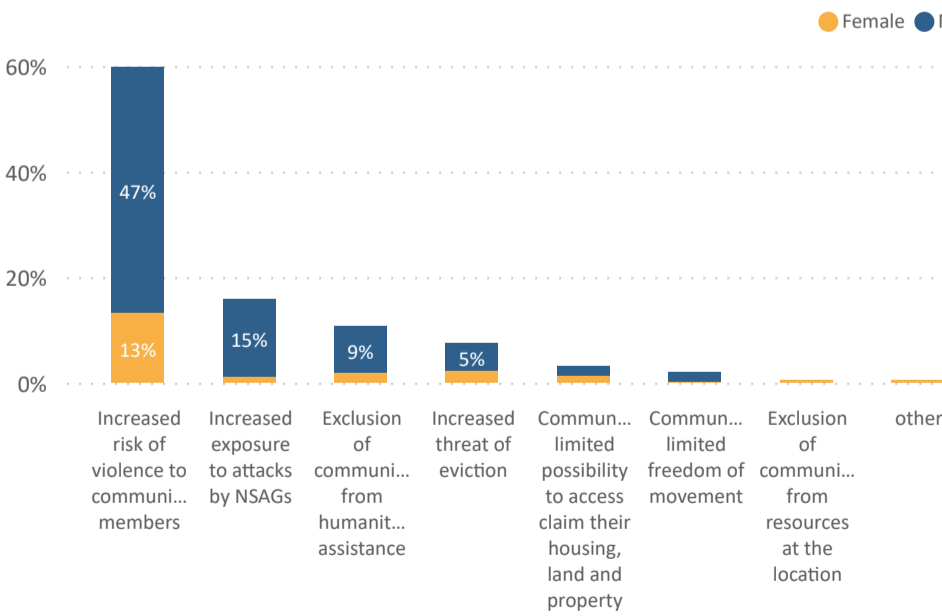


Trend of Problems Faced Because of Lack of Personal Documentation

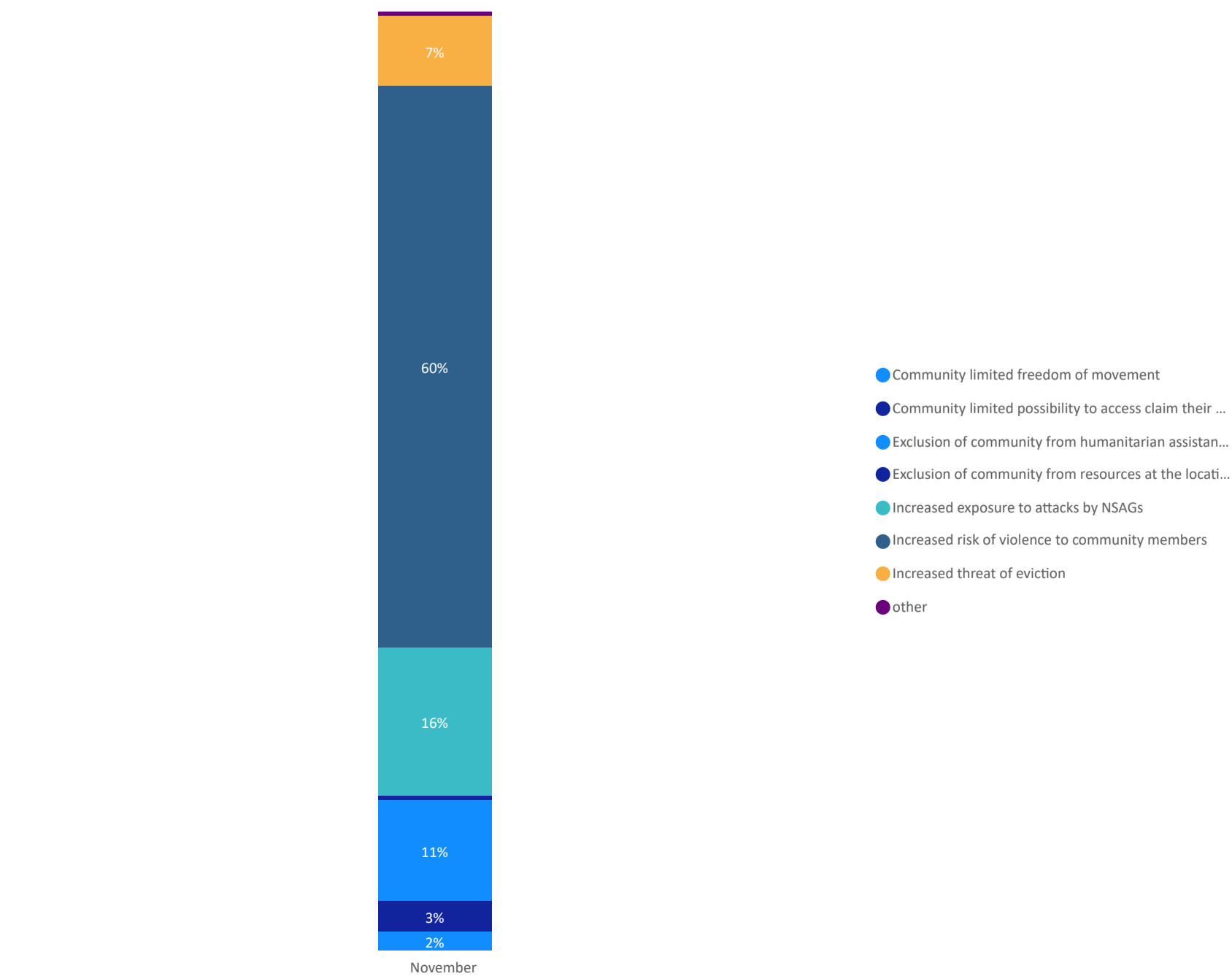

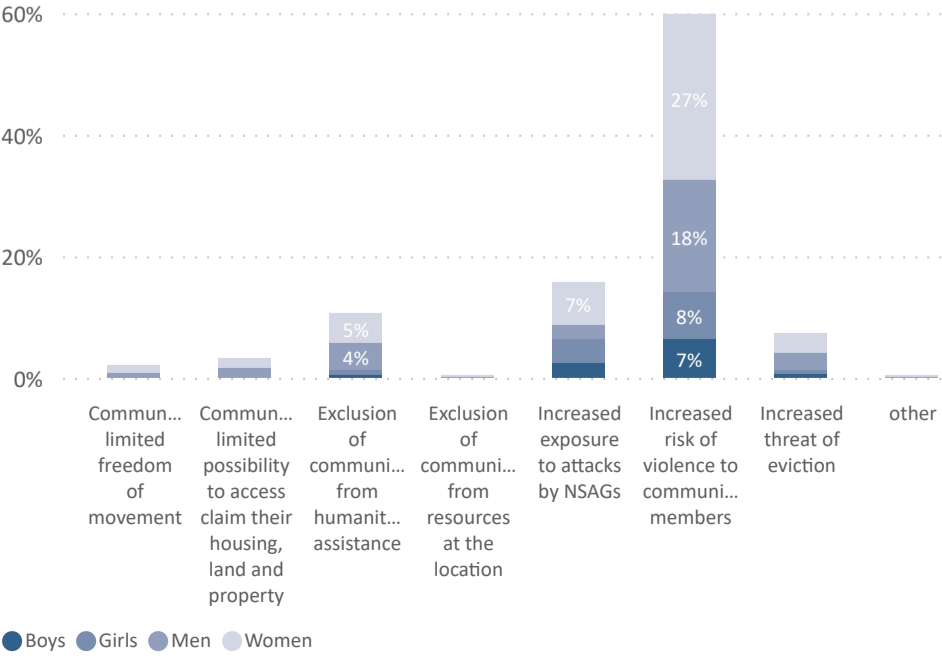
Consequences of a Lack of Social Cohesion by Gender



Trend of Consequences of a Lack of Social Cohesion



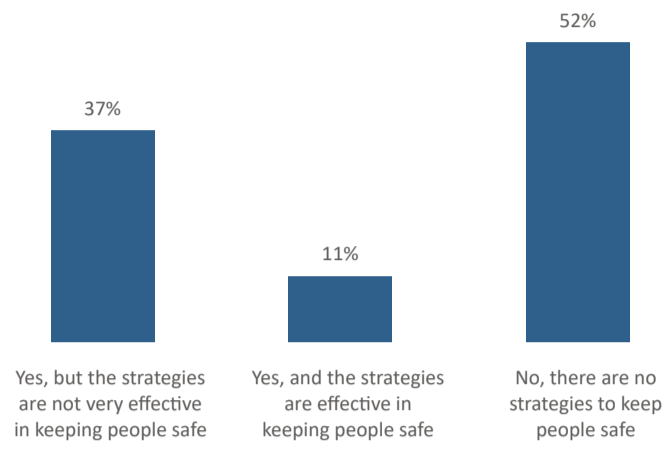
Consequences of Lack of Social Cohesion Disaggregated by Population Group



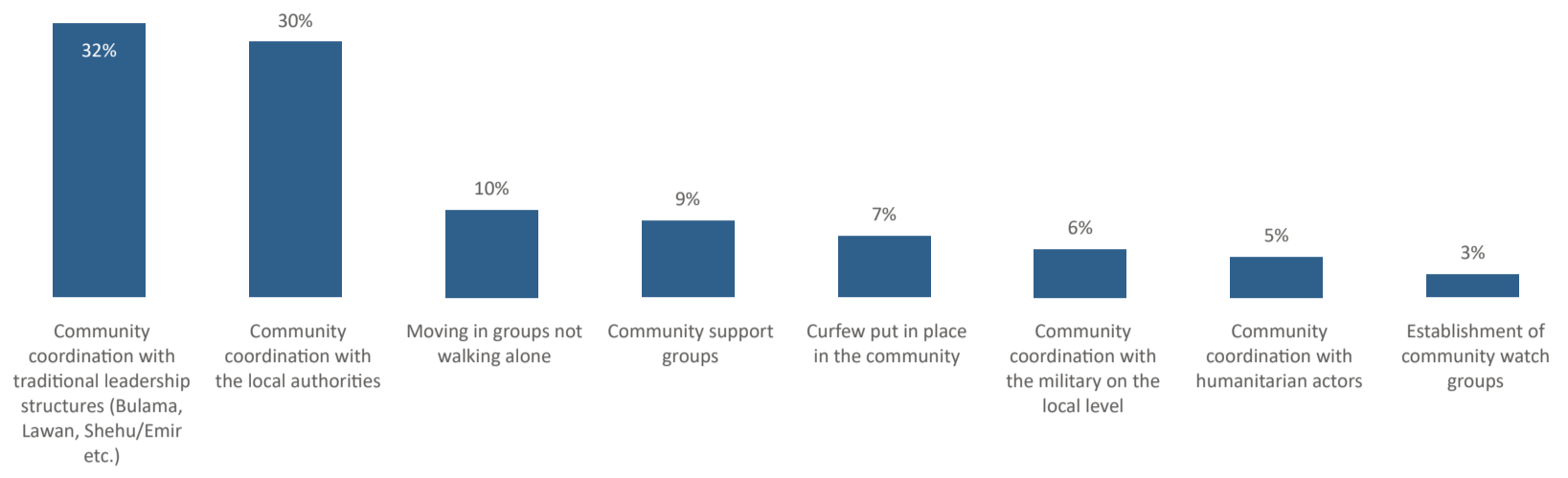

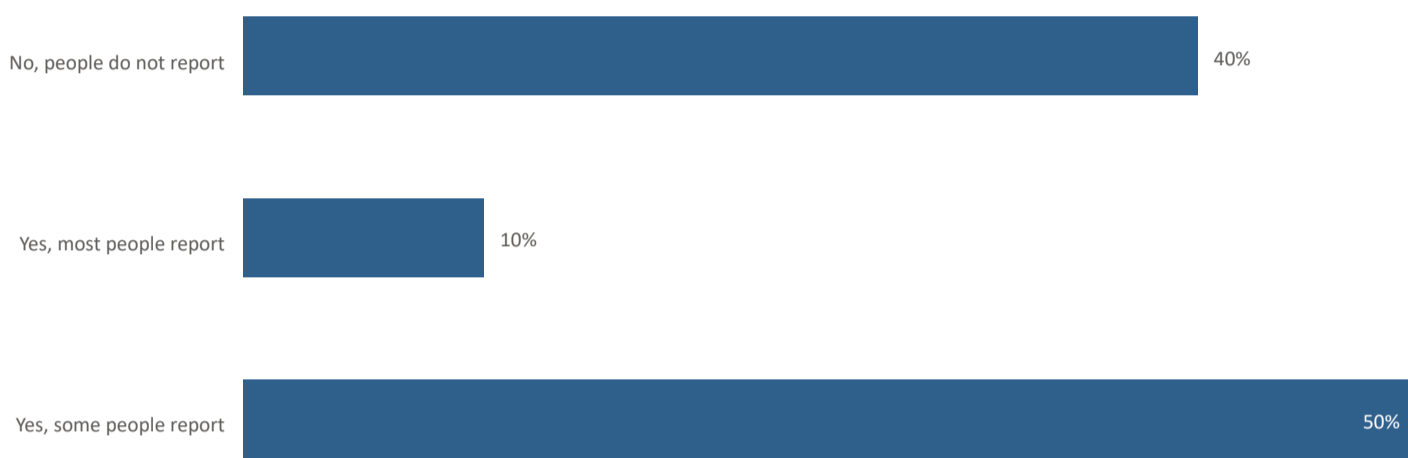

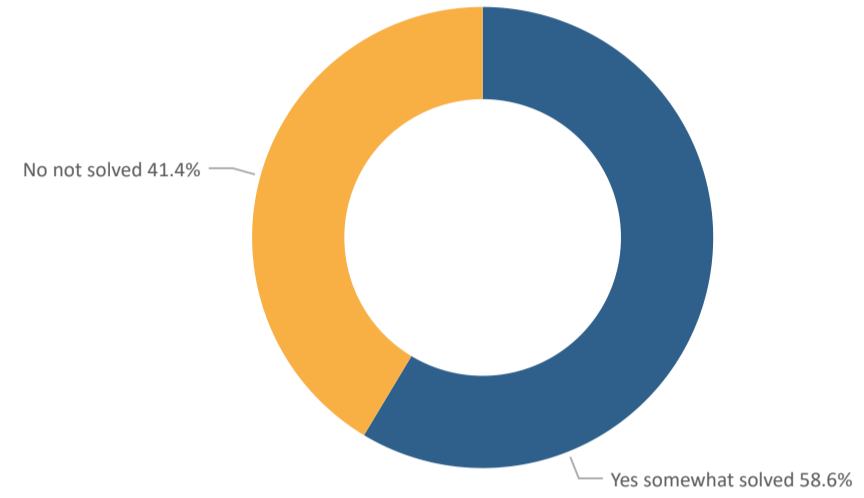

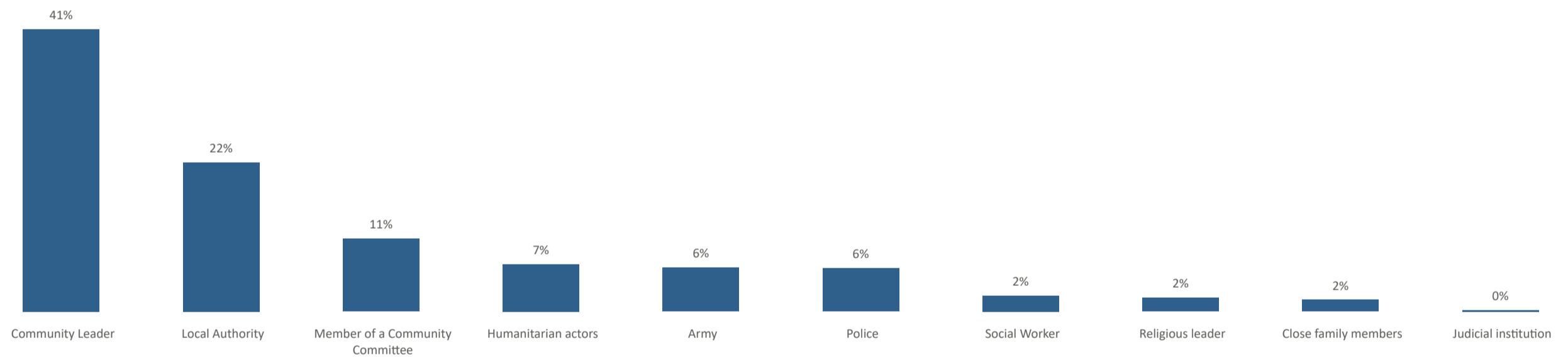

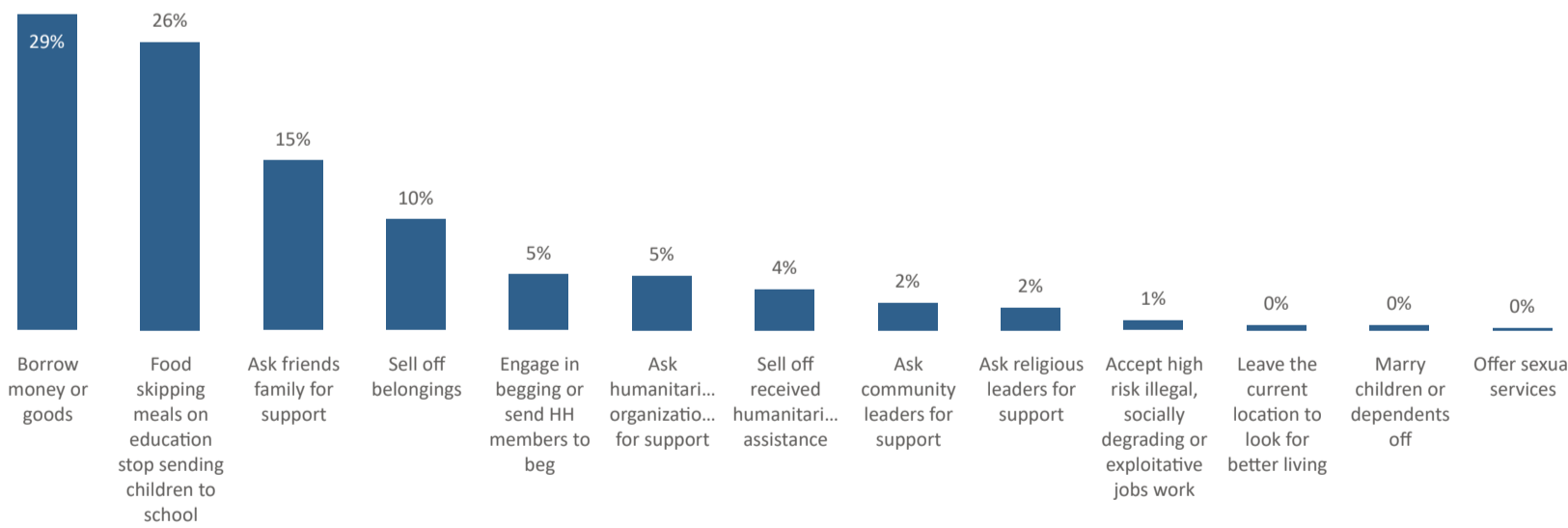

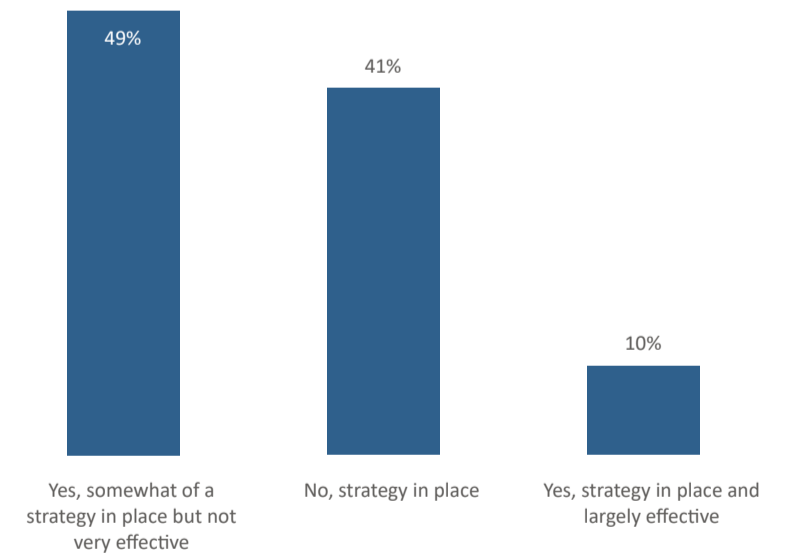

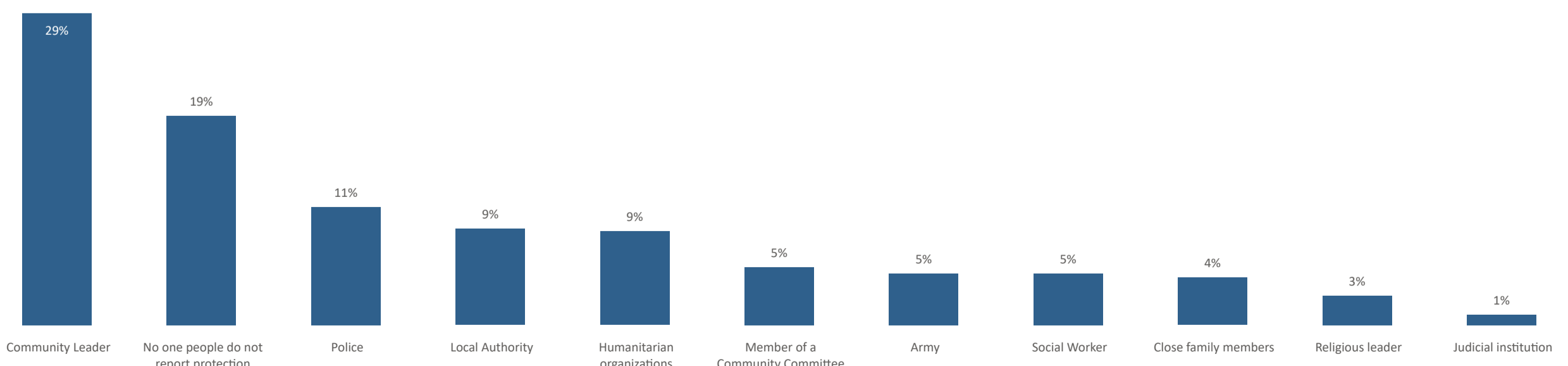

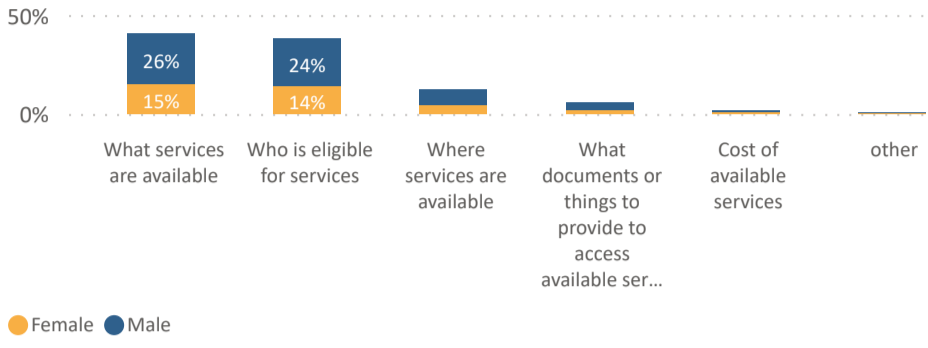

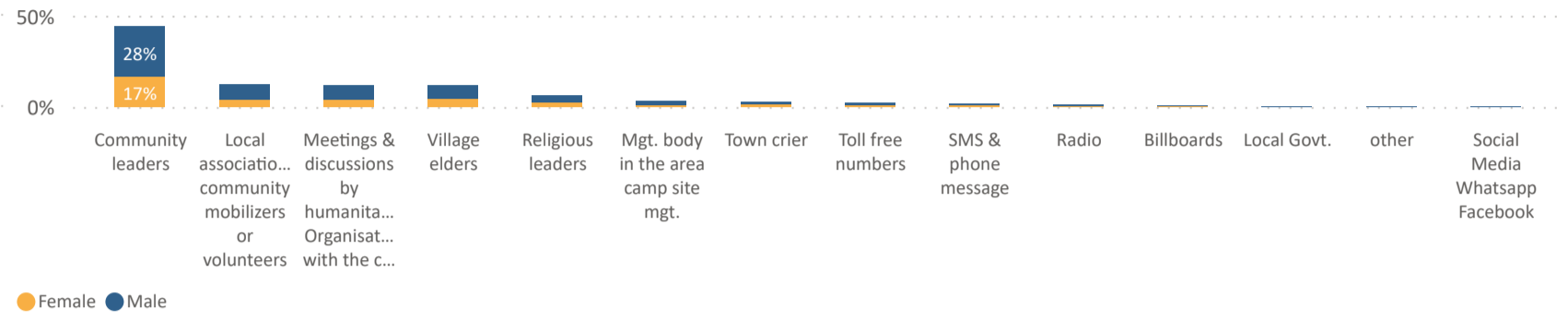

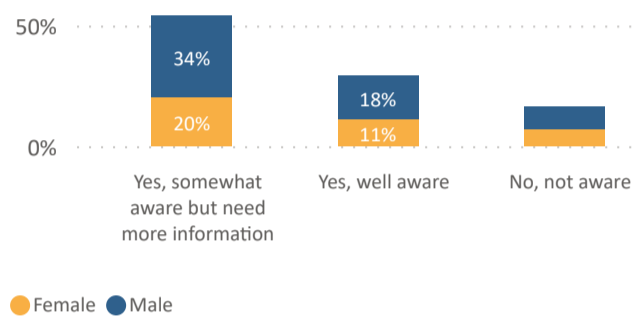


Preferred Channels for Households to Receive Information on Humanitarian Services

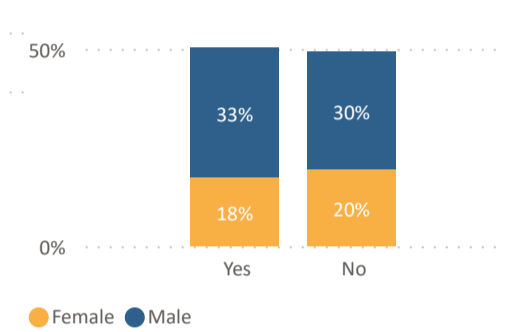
Level of Awareness on Feedback and Complaint Mechanisms

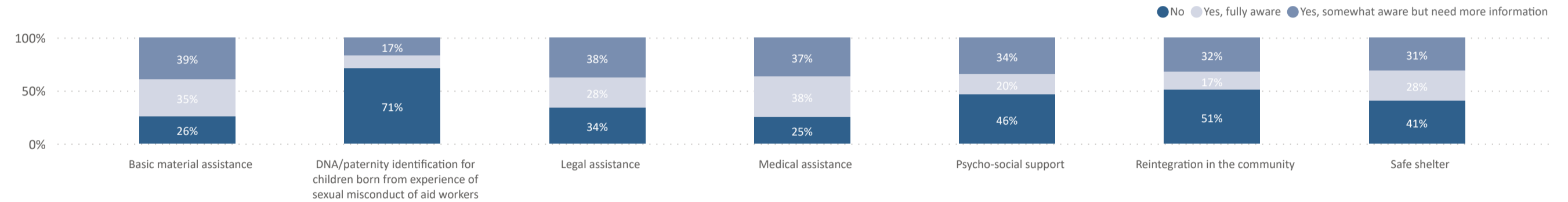


Level of Usage of Feedback and Complaint Mechanisms

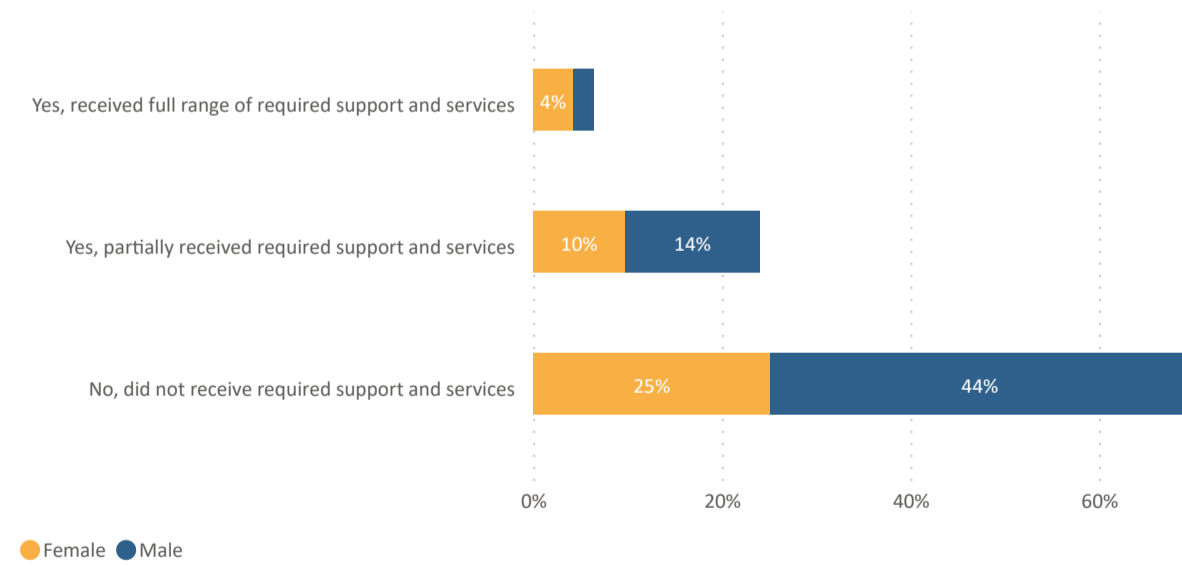
Level of Awareness on Service Providers when Sexual Exploitation and Abuse is Experienced from Humanitarian Workers



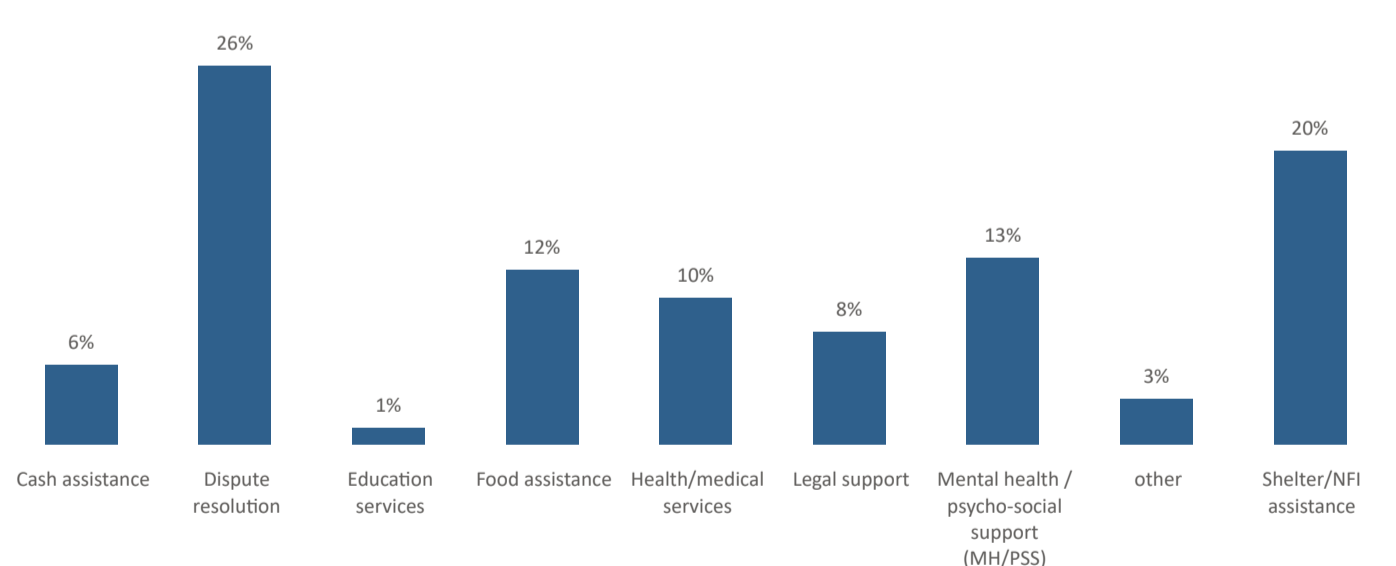

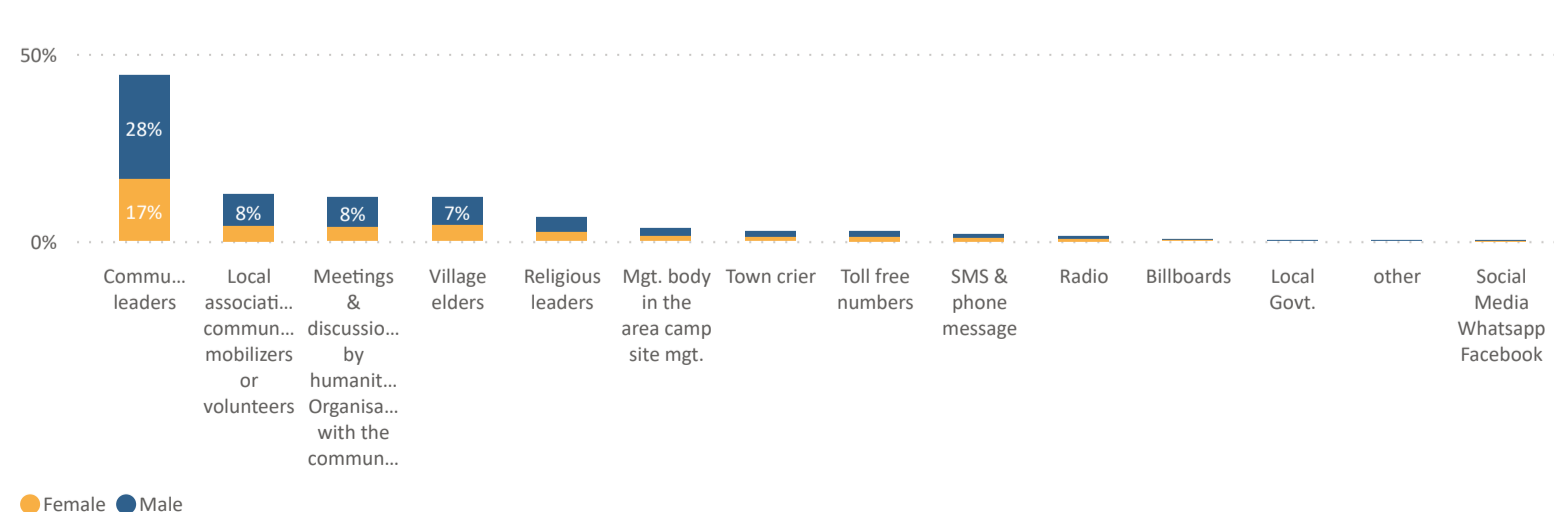


Type of Support or Services Received in Response to Reported Protection Incidents
