




Top 10 most common countries of origin




Sea Arrivals in 2024 by disembarkation site




Daily sea arrivals last week (22 Jan - 28 Jan 2024)




Sea arrivals by gender and age, Jan-Dec 2023

- ³ 'Rejection' includes all cases closed, including decisions not taken on the merits, such as inadmissibility decisions and no-shows.
