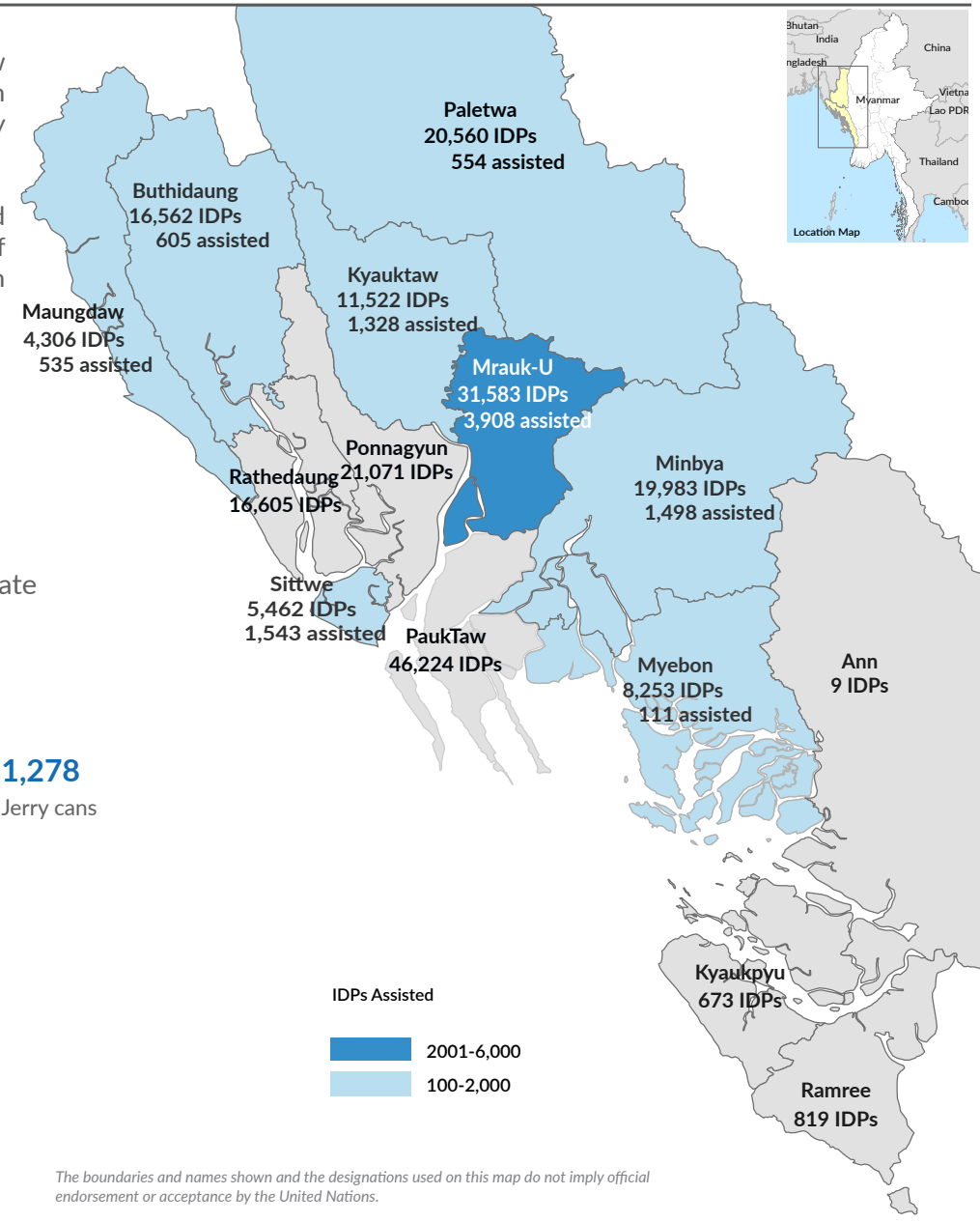


Response to displacement linked to AA-Tatmadaw conflict (Jan - Mar 2024)

In Rakhine State, 183,978 individuals have been displaced across 13 townships due to the ongoing AA-Tatmadaw conflict that started in 2019. Additionally, 20,560 individuals have been displaced in Paletwa township in Chin State, bringing the total number of displaced persons to 204,538. Out of them, 159,913 individuals are newly displaced since the escalation of armed conflict on 13 November as of 28 March.

In collaboration with partners and other UN agencies, UNHCR is responding to the humanitarian needs and continues to provide assistance to affected communities. Since January 2024, UNHCR has provided core relief items, emergency shelter support, dignity kits, hygiene kits and solar lamps to some 10,082 individuals in Mrauk-U, Kyauktaw, Minbya, Myebon, Sittwe, Paletwa, Buthidaung and Maungdaw townships.
