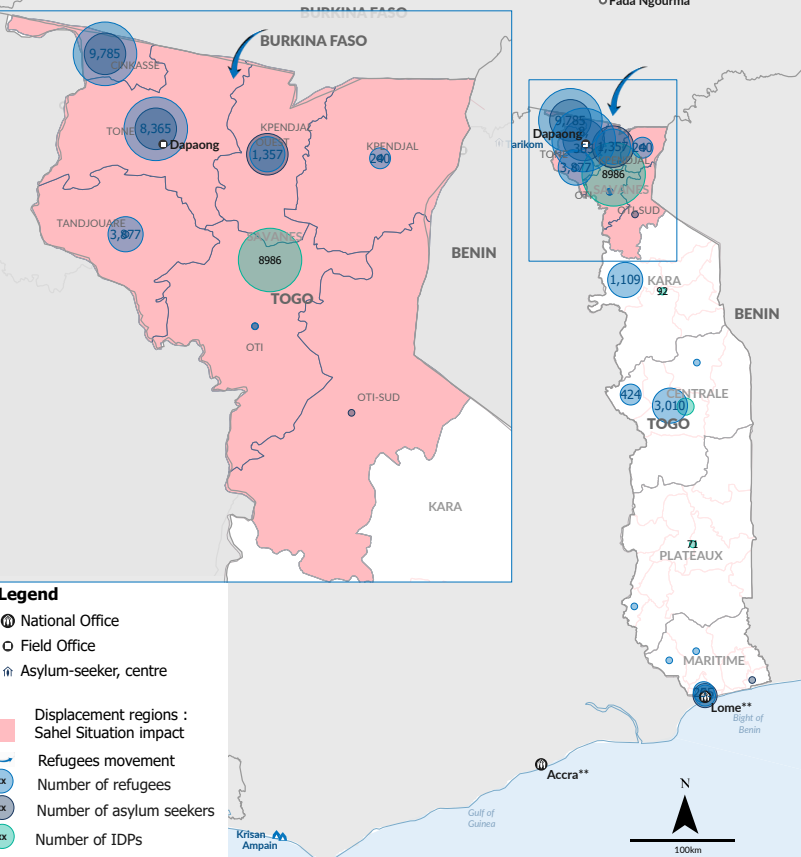
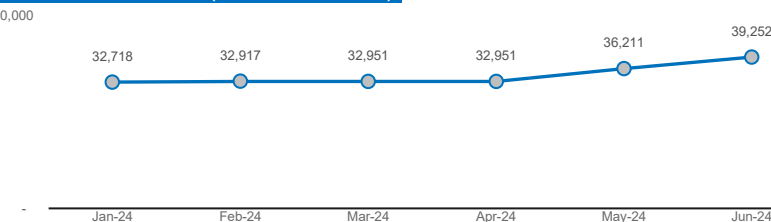

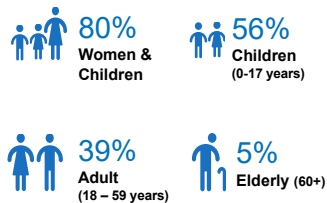


POPULATION TREND (SINCE JANUARY 2024)

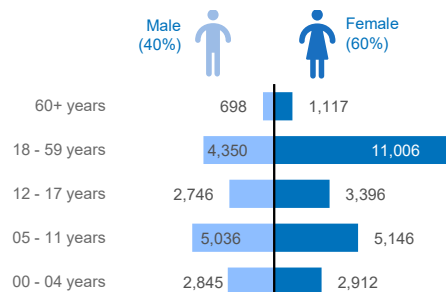

POPULATION BREAKDOWN AGE/GENDER*

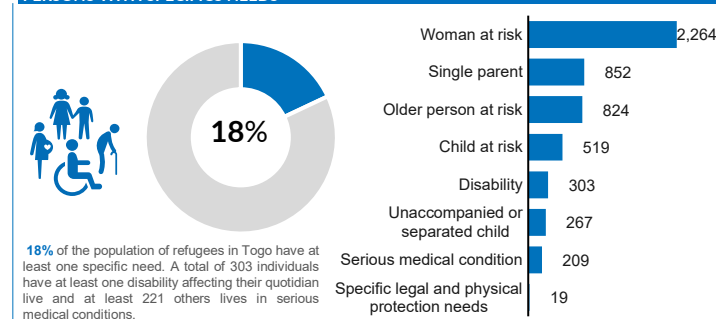

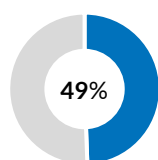

CHILDREN AT SCHOOL AGE BY REGION

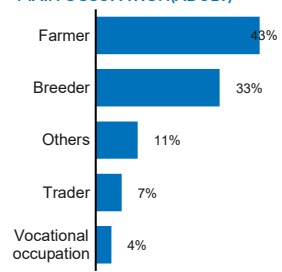

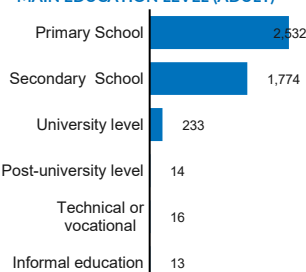
49% of the overall refugees in Togo are children at school-age. CINKASSE and TONE are regions where more than 69% of refugee's children at school age live.

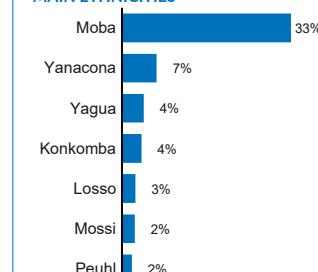
MAIN OCCUPATION(ADULT)*



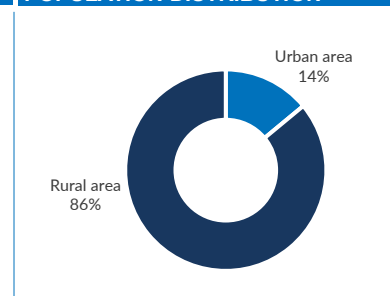
MAIN EDUCATION LEVEL (ADULT)
