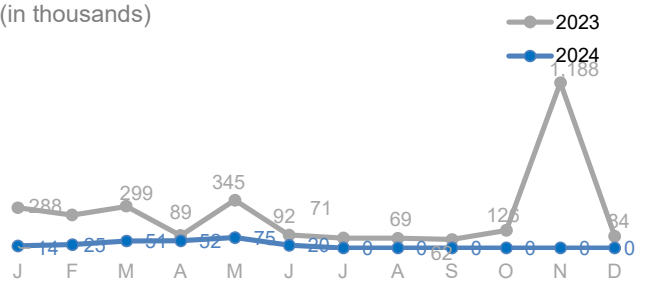

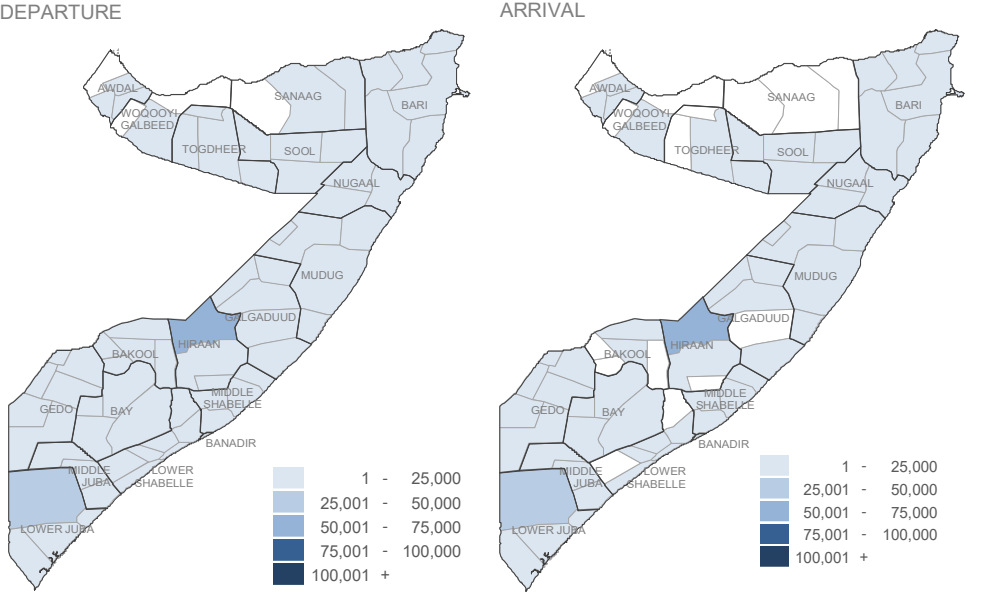
The UNHCR-led PSMN implemented in partnership with NRC reported **74,000** internal displacements in the month of May 2024. Out of these, 8,000 were caused by conflict or insecurity, **64,000** were due to floods and **2,000** were displaced due to other reasons

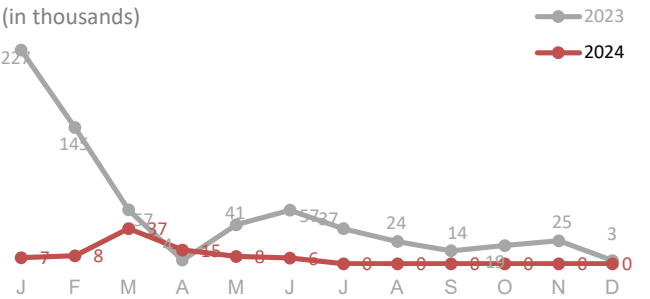

Major displacements arrival in May 2024 due to Conflict/Insecurity occurred in **Banadir (2,500)** and **Gedo (2,070)** regions.

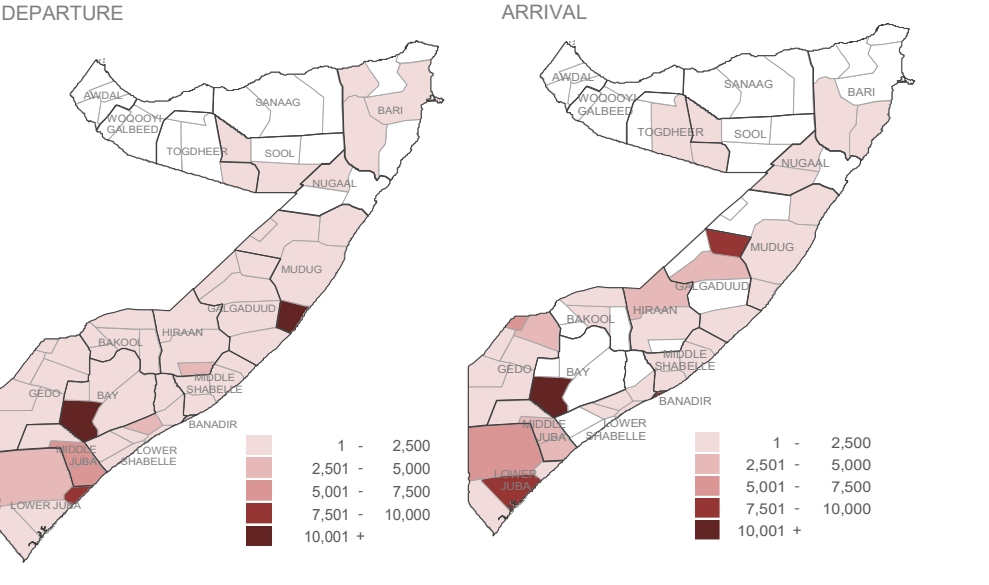
Major displacements departure in May due to Conflict/Insecurity occurred in **Lower Shabelle (1,760)** and **Middle Juba (1,450)**

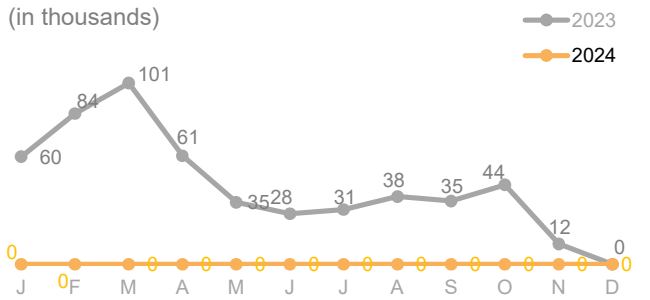

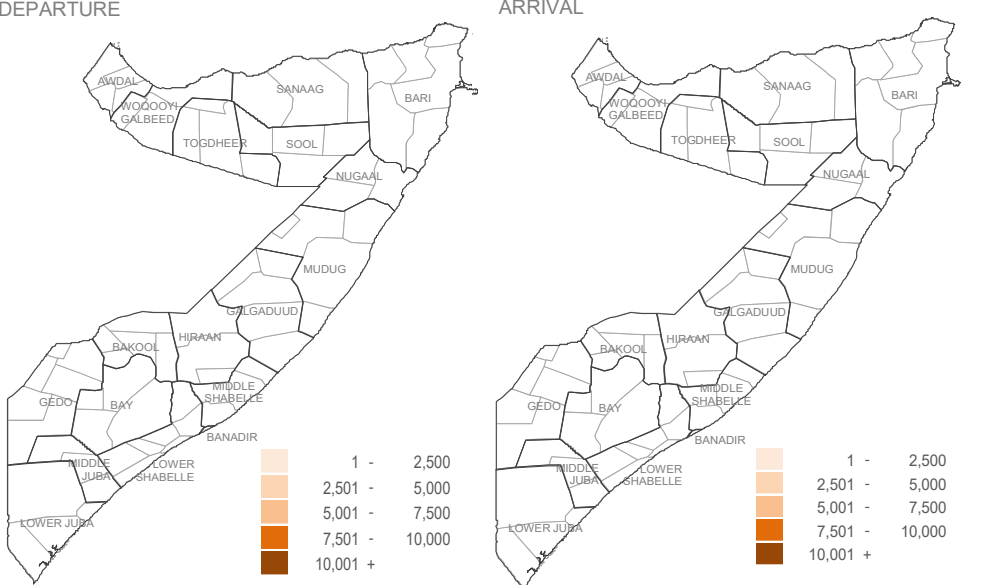

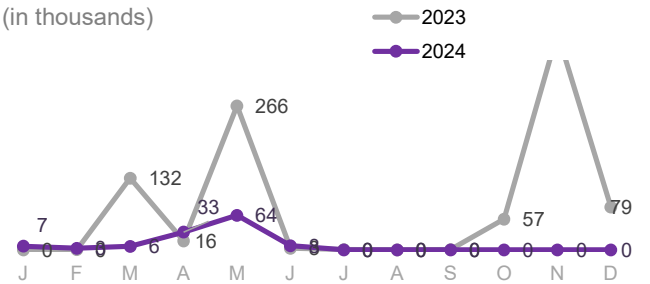

The highest displacements arrival in April due to floods were recorded in **Hiraan (50,700)** and **Gedo (3,170)** regions.

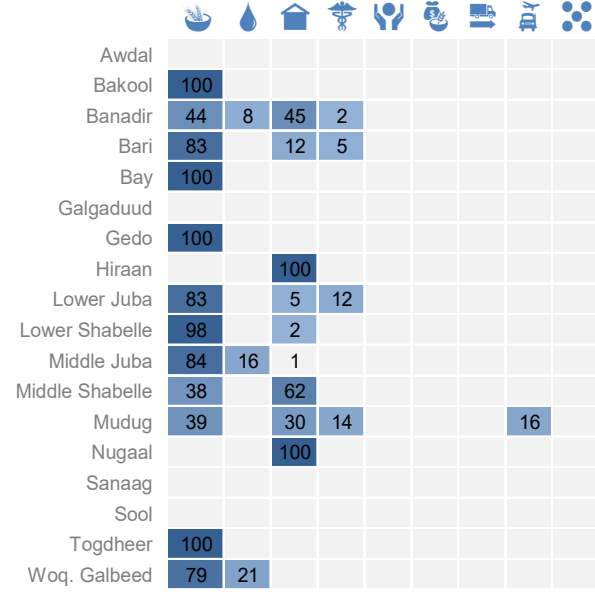
The highest displacements departure in May due to floods were recorded in **Hiraan (50,730)** and **Gedo (3,800)** regions.



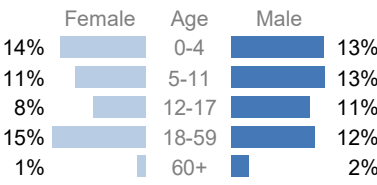

About PRMN

The PSMN (Protection & Solutions Monitoring Network) is a UNHCR-led project which identifies and reports on displacements (including returns) of populations in Somalia. The network also identifies and reports on protection risks and incidents underlying such movements. Only figures collected by PSMN are reported above. Not all displacements in Somalia are captured. This dashboard should be read in conjunction with the Notes on PSMN Methodology (<https://data2.unhcr.org/en/documents/details/53888>) which outline the approach and certain limitations. The figures shown are for numbers of individuals and are based on interviews with key informants and/or displaced households at destination (unless otherwise noted).
