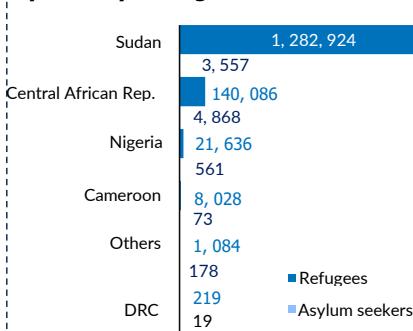

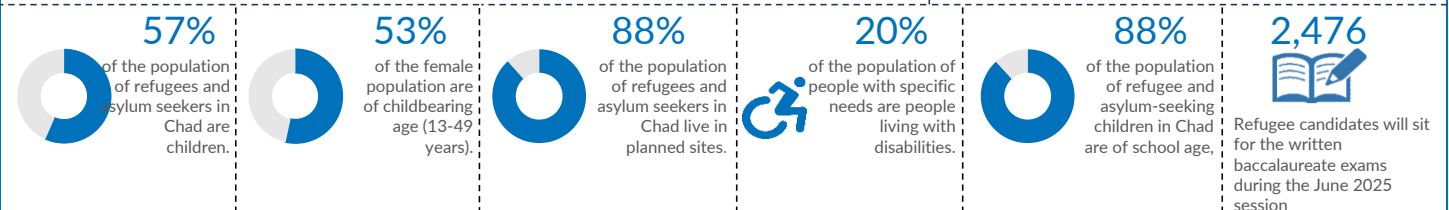
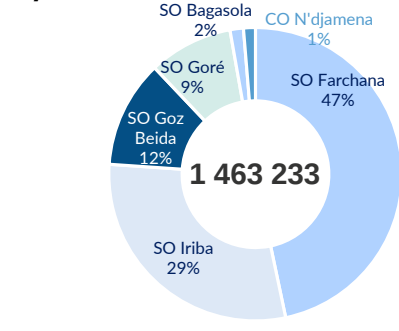
Age Cohort

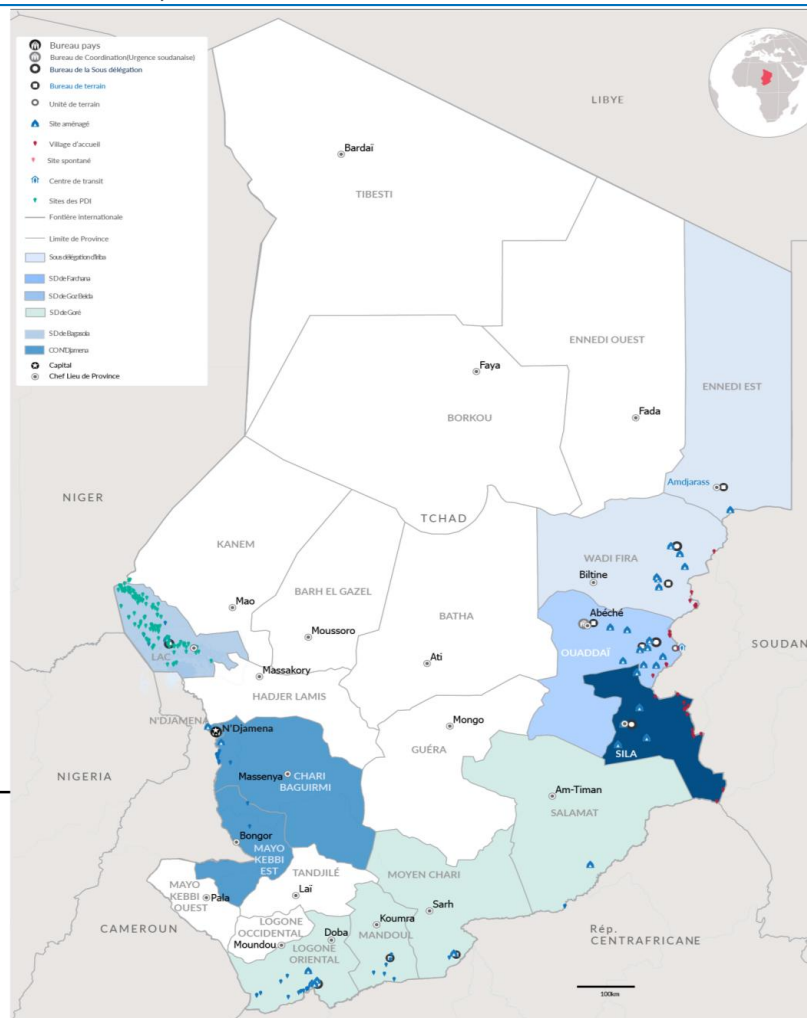
